Council of Interscholastic Federation

Southern Section

Fourth Meeting

April 16, 1924.

The Council of the California Interscholastic Federation Southern Section met as ordered in meeting of March 22, at the Casa Del Ray, Santa Cruz, at 1:30 P.M. in connection with the Principals' Convention.

President Monroe called the meeting to order and ordered Roll Call.

A. The question came up as to our ability to transact business and the chair ruled that as every one had been informed that we were going to meet and as a quorum was present we could transact business. The chair was sustained.

B. The chair ruled that a season of a sport, starts with the first league scheduled game and ends with the last scheduled game of the league.

1. After considerable discussion it was moved, seconded and carried that the question of holding the Southern California Track Meet be left in the hands of the Manager, the Secretary, and the President, with full power to act.

2. It was moved by Malcolm and seconded by Green, that the leagues stand as they are for next year, unless three-fourths of a league requests a change. Roll Call was ordered and motion lost.

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3. It was moved by Green and seconded by Smith, that any school may petition the council for a change in leagues, but the school must present with the petition a solution of the problem, approved by each of the interested leagues. Roll was ordered and motion carried.

4. It was agreed to have the Secretary send postal cards to each school in order to obtain a vote on this question.

Shall we change the rules so as to require a passing grade for last semester and for this semester in four (4) instead of three (3) units of work?

5. It was agreed to request Manager Van Patten to have a man at each of the field "pits" to announce the man and distance with each "try".

6. Each member of the council is requested to read over with care our book of rules and report any change which ought to be made.

7. Secretary was requested to remind the Managers that they are to hand in suggested changes soon.
