A meeting of the C. I. F. Southern Section was held in the Y.M.C.A. December 16, 1920 at 3:30 P.M.

Mr. Malcolm reported that Fullerton wished to protest the 1919-1920 football team of Long Beach on the grounds that Philip Tieman of Long Beach was over 21 years of age. Proof:

Philip Tieman had registered at Long Beach High as being born April 15, 1900 and that he had registered at the University of Southern California as being born April 16, 1898.

The President appointed Mr. Green, Mr. Malcolm and Mr. Moore a committee of three to investigate.

It was agreed that we should have a full squad of 40 to represent us at the State Track Meet.

The squad to be filled as follows:

Team # 1 to take 4th place men up to 10.

Team # 2 to have second right to take 4th place men up to 10 if that number is needed to fill the squad. Teams # 3, #4, # 5 to take 4th place men if such men are needed to make up the required 40.

It was agreed to issue a pass, next year, to each member of the Football officials' Association, to all football games in this section. The list of members to be certified to by the Football Manager, Secretary and President of the Association.

It was agreed to adjourn to meet January 6, 1921 at 3:30 P.M. at which time we would discuss the status of Long Beach.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
