

MEETING OF THE SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA INTERSCHOLASTIC FEDERATION

December 20, 1916.

A meeting of the C. I. F., Southern Section, was held at Polytechnic High School, December 20, 1916, with the following members present:

Upon motion the following appointments were authorized:

Vice-Principal W. L. Richer of Polytechnic High School was appointed Manager of Water-polo and Swimming. The President was authorized to appoint a Manager for Soccer-Football, who should help promote the sport among the schools in addition to forming a league. Seth F. VanPatten of Los Angeles High School was appointed Manager for track.

A motion was passed setting May 19 as closing date for Baseball in the various leagues.

Upon motion the 3rd Saturday of February is set aside each year to consider applications for reinstatement. All such applications for reinstatement during the second semester must be filed with the Secretary prior thereto.

E. W. Oliver was appointed to certify to eligibility of Championship Football players if they should play for the State Championship.

After a reading of the application of the Riverside County Athletic League for membership in the Council, a motion was passed accepting the same.

The Secretary was authorized to draw an order on the Treasurer for \$15.00 to be applied on bills in connection with managing the football season.

The Secretary as instructed to write L.L. Beeman concerning the case of Miss Mildred McKim, and state that cases of professionalism shall be referred to the A. A. U. for their consideration.

The resignation of E. H. McMath was accepted with regrets.

Delbert Brunton of Orange High School was elected President to fill the unexpired term.

The President declared the meeting adjourned.
