A motion was passed to the effect that pupils eligible for athletics during the first semester of 1918-19 are to be allowed to play on their respective football teams even though the semester may have ended before the end of the season, without establishing a precedent.

Upon motion the proposed constitution was adopted. The secretary was instructed to have five hundred copies of the constitution printed in booklet form and send copies to all schools of Southern California.

Upon motion the treasurer was instructed to pay the annual dues of the A. A. U., amounting to \$7.50.

The meeting adjourned to meet at the call of the secretary.
