

MEETING OF THE SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA INTERSCHOLASTIC FEDERATION

February 16, 1920.

A meeting of the Southern California Interscholastic Federation was held at the Y.M.C.A., Los Angeles, California at 4:00 P.M., February 16, 1920, with the following representatives present:-

The date of the Southern California Track Meet is changed to April 10 and will be held at Pomona College Field under the auspices of Pomona High School. Seth F. Van Patten, Manager of the meet is instructed to select school men to act as officials for the meet in so far as possible. The javelin and hand grenade throws are to be eliminated as events beginning with this year.

The Southern Council will hold a pentathlon meet at Los Angeles High School Field in May (probably May 8) consisting of the following events:- 100 yard dash, 120 yard hurdles, 880 yard run, high jump and shot put. Each school may be allowed three entries, and a perpetual trophy to the winner together with individual medals will be awarded to the first four placing. Kinter Hamilton of Harvard Military School is appointed to manage the meet.

On and after July 1, 1920, the following rulings of the Council will be eliminated and stricken from the rulings affecting the eligibility of student athletes, viz:-

(A) A motion passed that the first semester of the school year 1918-19 shall not count as residence for any athlete, provided however, that any student who desires to count the first semester of 1918-19 in order to establish residence or scholarship standing may so choose. (Minutes Feb.12, 1919.)

(B) That all pupils absent on account of military duty shall be eligible upon their return to school as soon as scholastic requirements have been met, provided all other conditions of eligibility are complied with. (Minutes Oct.13, 1918.)

Messrs. Green and Brunton were appointed a committee to investigate reported troubles in the City League with respect to schools in the League.

The books of the Council are to be audited and the secretary is instructed to draw an order on the treasurer to cover the expense incurred.

Eligibility of life guards as members of water polo teams is to be a matter for discussion for the next meeting.

Delbert Brunton of Orange High School is appointed manager of Baseball for the season 1920, and a member of the Los Angeles High School faculty will manage tennis for the Season.

The report of the Football Manager for the season 1919 will be heard at the next meeting.

All athletes coming to the Southern California Track Meet from schools over 75 miles distant will receive one cent per mile toward their traveling expenses.

The State Track Meet will be held in Bakersfield April 24, 1920. The meeting adjourned to meet at the call of the President.
