


Current Team Uniform Requirements Front





Home team shall wear white jerseys and socks Visiting team shall wear dark jerseys and socks

Current Team Uniform Requirements Back





Both socks shall be the same color, with the home team wearing solid white socks and the visiting team wearing socks of a single dominant color, but not necessarily the color of the jersey



Required Equipment Rule 4-1-1b



EFFECTIVE 2013 FALL SEASON



The home team shall wear *solid white jerseys and solid white socks* and the visiting team shall wear dark jerseys and socks.

Required Equipment Rule 4-1-1i1



EFFECTIVE 2012 FALL SEASON



All team jerseys must have a different Arabic number, including goalkeeper jerseys.



Required Equipment Rule 4-1-1i2

Only those names, patches, emblems, logos or insignias referencing the school are permitted on the team uniform, except as in 4-1-1 (d), (f) and (g).

(d.) A manufacturer's logo/trademark appearing on both sides of the socks is legal.

(f.) One manufacturer's logo/trademark or reference is permitted on the outside of each item which may not exceed 2¹/₄ square inches and may not exceed 2¹/₄ inches in any dimension.

(g.) An American flag, not to exceed 2 by 3 inches, and either a commemorative or memorial patch, not to exceed 4 square inches and with written state association approval, may be worn on the jersey provided neither the flag nor the patch interferes with the visibility of the number.

The player's name may also appear on the team uniform.

SHINGUARD

SHIPPING PACKAGE

Shinguards must meet the NOCSAE specifications. The NOCSAE seal and the appropriate height range needs to appear directly on the shinguard OR on a label attached to the shinguard.

Required Equipment Rule 4-1-1





Beginning with the 2012 fall season, the <u>front</u> of the shinguard must be permanently marked with the NOCSAE seal and the height standards for that guard.
