A meeting of the California Interscholastic Federation, Southern Section was held at the Y. M. C. A., Los Angeles, California at 3 P.M. November 20, 1919 with the following representatives present:-

The minutes of September 30, 1919 were read and approved.

L. L. Beeman of San Bernardino, Citrus League was elected president for 1919-20

The secretary was instructed to draw an order on the treasurer for \$7.50, dues to A. A. U. for 1919-20.

A motion passed that the quotation from minutes of Feb. 12, 1919 as shown below, be referred to the various leagues for discussion and instruction of representatives of the Council, viz; "A motion passed that the first semester of school year 1918-19 shall not count as residence for any athlete, provided, however, that any student who desires to count the first semester of 1918-19 in order to establish residence or scholarship standing may do so."

Citrus and Central Leagues were instructed to present one team to complete in semi finals vs Fullerton Nov. 24. The Council recommends that Leagues form basket ball schedules for four classes, viz; 110, 130, 145 and unlimited weights and no player may play in any two classes during one week.

Delbert Brunton was appointed to present plan for play off of all sports in semi final and final games.
