

MEETING OF THE SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA INTERSCHOLASTIC FEDERATION

September 28, 1916.

A meeting of the Southern California Interscholastic Federation was held at L. A. High School, 4:30 P. M., Sept. 28, 1916, with the following members present:

Upon motion E. P. McMath was unanimously elected president for the year 1916-17. The election of vice-president and other officials except as noted below, was postponed until a later meeting. W. C. Wilson was appointed temporary secretary.

After a lengthy discussion a motion to the effect that the present sectioning for the football season be continued for this year, and that a member of the council be appointed to help in the organizing of the schedule of the teams in the L. A. Co. City Section, including Pasadena, Long Beach, Whittier and Santa Ana, and that a committee of three be appointed to report on sections for other sports at the next meeting, was passed.

S. H. Upjohn was appointed on the arrangement of schedule and W. C. Wilson, H. J. Moore, and S. H. Upjohn a committee to report on sections at the next meeting.

Upon motion the principal and vice-principal of the L. A. High School were authorized to appoint a financial secretary for the council.

Upon motion the vice-principal of the Pasadena High School was authorized to appoint a recording secretary for the council.

After a discussion of the conditions upon which reinstatements of pupils would be considered, the following motion was passed to wit:
