Upon motion, the Secretary was instructed to draw an order on the Treasurer for one hundred dollars (\$100), to pay dues to the California Interscholastic Federation for year 1919-20.

Any student who has returned from any branch of the service, honorably discharged or on furlough, who entered school prior to October 1st, 1919, shall be eligible for athletic competitions, subject to scholastic, age, post graduate and residence regulations of the present semester.
