Special Bulletin

The Executive Committee of the C.I.F., Southern Section, at a meeting on Saturday, November 20, 1943, directed that a copy of the ruling given below be sent at once to all our member schools.

Each principal is asked to immediately place one copy of this Bulletin with his Director of Athletics.

Ruling

"Any basketball workout, practice or scrimmage, had with a group or team from off the campus of any school (whether the game is at home or away) shall count as one of the fifteen games allowed to teams of C.I.F., Southern Section, schools for the season of 1943-1944."

We quote below a paragraph from a letter received today from Mr. Verne S. Landreth of the State Office of Education.

"In the transportation committee report made to the Federated Council meeting held in Fresno July 31, it was stated that "Under present regulations in Section 7706W the maximum amount of occupational travel that is allowable is 720 miles per month." A representative of the Office of Price Administration informs us that in order to bring this report up-to-date in accordance with present regulations, this statement should be restated as follows: "Under present regulations in Section 7704B the maximum amount of occupational travel that is allowable is 480 miles per month."
