### **PAIRINGS ANNOUNCED FOR 2013-14 CIF SOUTHERN SECTION-FORD BOYS BASKETBALL CHAMPIONSHIPS, PRESENTED BY FARMERS**

LOS ALAMITOS - A total of 361 entries, including top seeds Mater Dei, Long Beach Poly, El Toro, Canyon/Anaheim, Sonora, Santa Margarita, Santa Barbara, Buckley, Village Christian, Saddleback Valley Christian, Renaissance Academy and Trinity Classical Academy vie for championships in 12 single-elimination divisional playoffs beginning Wednesday, Feb. 19. The tournament will conclude with championship-final contests on March 7-8 at The Felix Events Center at Azusa Pacific University and Godinez High School as well as on March 8 at The Honda Center.

There were 273 teams, which qualified for the playoffs by finishing in the top half of their league standings. Another 88 teams qualified with at-large or freelance berths.
