INDIVIDUAL TENNIS TOURNAMENT: Each league will be assigned to one of the **five** scheduled sectional tournament sites. Each league may enter two players in singles and two doubles teams. ***League entries will be due to the CIF-SS Office through CIFSSHOME.org no later than Friday, November 6, 2015 at 12:00 noon.***

1. Refer to Article 32 (Playoffs) of the Blue Book for details regarding playoff information.
2. The Commissioner of Athletics shall secure the necessary officials, provide the balls, select a seeding procedure deemed appropriate and make up the draw.
3. Uniforms shall conform to the dress rules as established by the SCTA. Dress shall be appropriate tennis attire, **not to include advertising and pictures.** Finalists are to wear school issued uniforms.

4. **CONTINUOUS PLAY RULES:**

1. All serves must be taken prior to the start of the match.
2. Ninety (90) seconds allowed for changing sides (except first side change of each set)
3. As of January, 2001, two (2) minutes is allowable for side changes between sets. Continuous play rules shall now be utilized during the first side change of any set, therefore no coaching will be permitted.
4. No play stoppage of any kind allowed without specific permission. In compliance with USTA 18 & under rules, there is a 10 minute break between the 2nd and 3rd sets.
5. In all qualifying matches (prior to the round of 32) a USTA 10-point Match Tie-Breaker will be utilized in lieu of a 3rd set. Beginning with the round of 16, 2 out of 3 set match play will be utilized.
5. **SCORING:** Regular scoring. The USTA ten-point match tie-break system shall be used in all qualifying sectional tournaments: In lieu of a third set, a ten-point tie-break will be used (first to win ten points and be ahead by a margin of two points). Regular tie-break procedure will be in effect.
6. **TIEBREAK SYSTEM (6-6):** The CIF-SS will use the USTA 7 out of 12 tie-break system.

7. **USTA POINT PENALTY SYSTEM**

The USTA Point Penalty System will be in effect throughout the Individual Tennis Tournament. :

Violations shall be penalized as follows:

First Offense -	Point
Second Offense -	Game
Third Offense -	Default

Code Violations

Delay

- Not resuming play after natural loss of physical condition
- Not resuming play after an injury timeout or after treatment on a changeover
- Not playing within 25 seconds of having been directed to resume play

- Passage of 25 seconds after any time violation
- Leaving the court for an unauthorized reason

Conduct

- Visible or audible profanity or obscenity.
- Abuse of racket, balls, or equipment.
- Verbal or physical abuse of a player or official.
- Coaching (except during the 90 second changeover).
- Abusive conduct by a player or a person associated with a player.
- Retaliatory calls (obviously bad call made in retaliation for the opponent=s calls).
- Unsportsmanlike conduct.

8. TIME VIOLATIONS

- Delay between points or after warm-up.
- Violation of the 90-second changeover rule.
- Time Violation Penalties:
 - First offense - warning
 - Each additional violation - one point penalty

Note: The passage of 25 seconds after a time violation shall result in assessment of a **code** penalty.

9. COACHING: Coaching is permitted during the 90 seconds allowed for changing sides (except first side change of each set), providing it does not distract opposing players or delay the start of play at the end of the 90 seconds. Coaching is also permitted for 3 minutes prior to the start of the USTA 10-point match tie-breaker. Coaching is allowed by two designated high school coaches only.

10. PROTEST OF PLAYOFF CONTESTS: By action of the CIF-SS Council, protests of playoff contests will no longer be entertained following the conclusion of the contest. Coaches must resolve questions pertaining to possible misapplication of the rules in accordance with the USTA rules. No protest may be carried forth once the contest is completed.

Coaches are encouraged to carry USTA rulebooks with them for all playoff contests.

Schools will still have the opportunity to protest a contest in accordance with Southern Section rules, Rule 1111, as it pertains to use of ineligible player or violations of any CIF-SS rule in connection with the contest.

11. ENTRY FEE: There will be no entry fee assessed for this tournament.

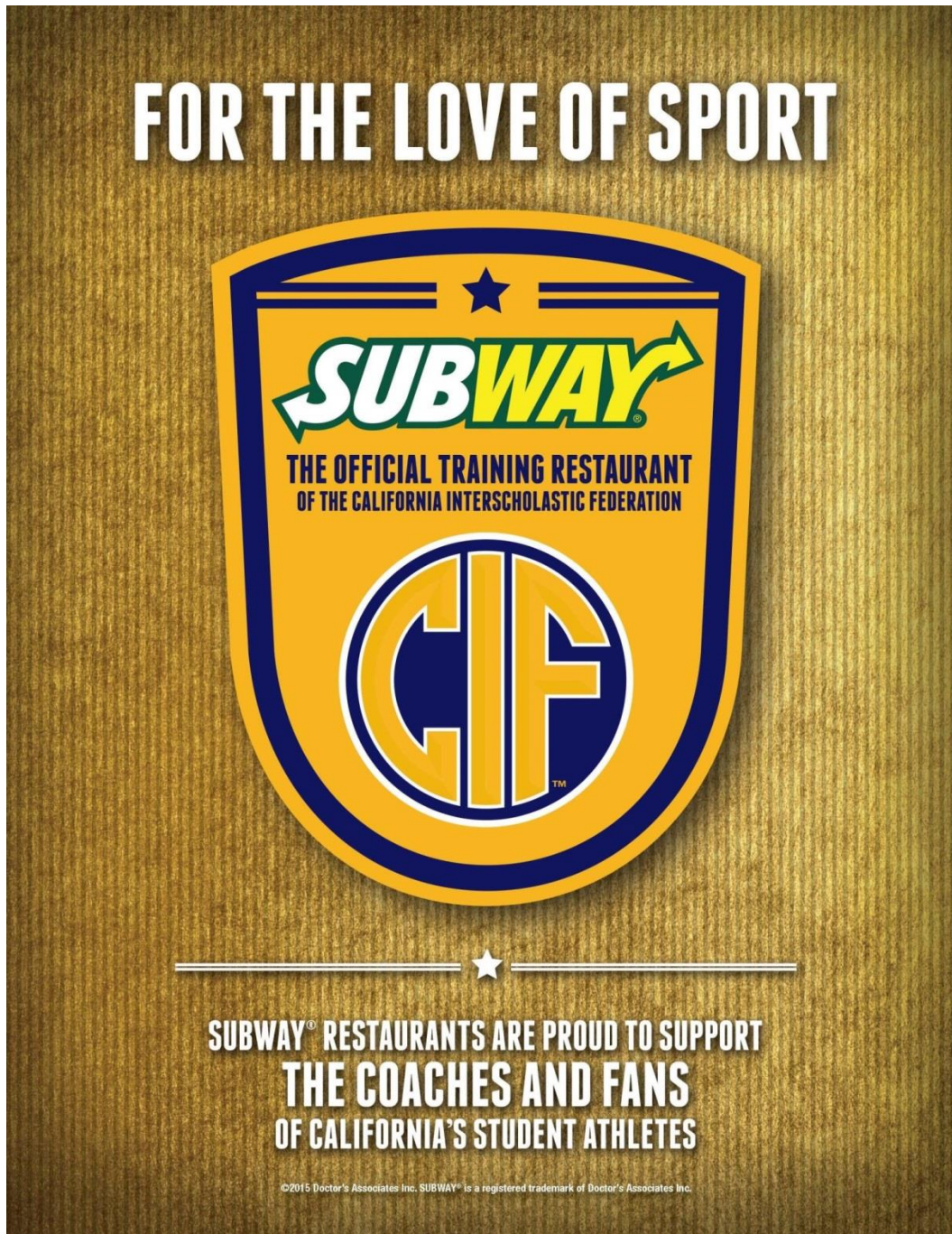
12. ELIGIBILITY FORM: It will be the responsibility of each school having entries in this tournament to submit an approved eligibility form covering their players. Eligibility forms are submitted through the team roster section of CIFSSHOMe.org.

13. ELIGIBILITY LIST:

The CIF Southern Section Eligibility List will be generated through the www.cifsshome.org site. As you input your team roster information, the eligibility list information will be input at that time.

ALL COACHES ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ASCERTAINING THAT ANY PLAYER(S) ENTERED HAVE NO CONFLICT WITH ANY OTHER EVENT OR ACTIVITY.

14. Please read carefully the enclosed Special Notice pertaining to supervision of athletes. If the coach is not in attendance, entrants will not be allowed to participate
15. **AWARDS:** Appropriate awards will be given to the winner and runner-up in both singles and doubles.
16. **SECTIONAL ENTRY INFORMATION** will be available on the CIF-SS web site (www.cifss.org) on TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 17, 2015 after 3:00 p.m.

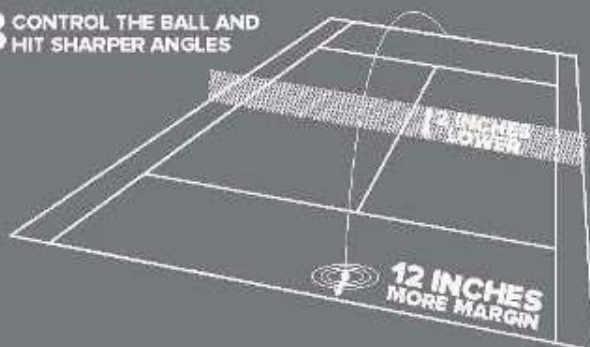

SPECIAL NOTICE

SUPERVISION OF ATHLETES

The Southern Section Office has experienced a problem which has perpetuated itself over the past few years as it pertains to proper supervision and entry of student-athletes in the post-season playoffs.

The situation relates only to individual sports, i.e. CROSS COUNTRY, INDIVIDUAL TENNIS, TRACK, SWIMMING, etc. and the official recognition and registration of entrants at the respective playoff sites.

State and Southern Section Rule 309 states:

No CIF team (i.e., individual) shall participate in inter-scholastic or approved competition with any other team unless the CIF team is under supervision as required by the California Administrative Code Title V and CIF By-Law #506A and #506B. (Additionally, refer to Rule 123.) The supervisor must remain in attendance at all times.

Those persons APPROVED FOR SUPERVISION PURPOSES are limited to:

- A. Certificated personnel
- B. Certified Coaches (certified credentialed coaches)
- C. Non-certificated temporary coaches (certified walk-on coaches.)

(It should be noted that schools representing the same DISTRICT may send one credentialed or certified supervisor for three or four athletes. These individuals have been recognized and are to continue to be recognized for registration and participation purposes in that the district has assigned the supervisory role for all students from its' member schools to this one individual.)

However, the concern is for those students who ARE NOT accompanied by a faculty representative and report to the playoff site by themselves or with a parent. ***GIVING PARENTS THE SUPERVISION AUTHORITY, WHETHER IN WRITING OR NOT, DOES NOT MEET THE STANDARDS SET FORTH IN THE ABOVE REGULATIONS. This also applies to parents who are the student's private coach but are not under contract to the member school.***

PLEASE NOTE, THIS RULE WAS REVIEWED BY BOTH THE STATE CIF OFFICE, IT'S GENERAL COUNSEL AND THE SOUTHERN SECTION EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE. IT HAS BEEN REAFFIRMED THAT THE INTERPRETATION STAND AS ABOVE AND THAT ANY STUDENT REPORTING FOR COMPETITION WHO IS NOT UNDER DIRECT SUPERVISION IN ACCORDANCE WITH STATE AND SOUTHERN SECTION RULE 309, IS TO BE DENIED ENTRY FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE COMPETITION.

As pointed out by the Southern Section and State CIF attorney, there are inherent liability problems when an individual competes in violation of said rule. Please review this rule with your staff in that it will be strictly enforced as per the above application.

CIF SOUTHERN SECTION PLAYOFF/CHAMPIONSHIP PLAYOFF REQUIREMENTS - ALL TEAMS AND HOST SITES 2015-16



ALL TEAMS - During season/Prior to playoffs:

Rosters & Scores:

- Complete schedules are to be submitted to CIFSSHOME prior to each season.
 - Update scores following every contest via MaxPreps>CIFSSHOME or direct to CIFSSHOME
- Additional directions on accessing CIFSSHOME are included in this document.

TV/Web/Radio Rights:

Any video broadcast on TV or webcast of a CIF-SS event (hosted by CIF-SS or involving two CIF-SS schools outside the section) require a contract and rights fee through the CIF-SS office prior to the contest. The only 'exceptions' are: A) A school self-produces a regular season webcast that is exclusively shown on either the school's official web site or on the NFHS Network. B) During the regular season, a school or district produces a delayed until 11pm TV broadcast exclusively airing on the school or school district owned cable TV channel. Third party web sites, such as iHigh, cube.com and others, require contracts and rights fees. Violation of this policy will result in the loss of one or more playoff host rights. This Blue Book rule has been in effect since 2007. All regular season rights fees collected are given to the 'host' schools in June.

During the regular season, schools may individually contract their own audio only broadcasts on web or radio. During playoffs, all audio only broadcasts require a rights fee and contract through the CIF-SS office.

'Official' Championship Souvenirs:

The exclusive vendor for CIF Southern Section Championships souvenirs (t-shirts, scarfs, pins, beanies, hats, etc...) is our long-time partner *CIF Tshirts*. These are the official items sold each year per sport. You are likely familiar with their annual shirts at the finals and in your playoff bulletins. You can order team and individual items through them at www.ciftshirts.com.

ALL TEAMS - Playoff requirements of all teams:

Official Ball Required:

Only the approved official ball in each ball sport may be played by either school during CIF-SS playoff contests. Violation of this rule will result in loss of your next home playoff game. The current Official Ball list for each sport is included and available at www.cifss.org in the 'Officials' drop down. This policy has been in effect since 2002.

Gatorade Only:

Only Gatorade jugs, cups, bottles, ice chests may be used or visible during any CIF-SS playoff contest. (No Powerade, Body Armor, etc). The only acceptable alternative is a plain-wrap or Igloo labeled products. This rule does not apply to the actual liquid distributed to athletes. This policy has been in effect since 1995.

TV/Web/Radio Rights:

For all playoff rounds in all sports, a contract and rights fee is required for any TV, webcast or radio broadcast. No exceptions.

CIF-SS on Souvenirs:

The 'CIF Southern Section', 'CIF-SS', 'Southern Section' and 'CIF' marks and logos are registered trademarks with the State of California. Schools may only use the CIF Southern Section marks on rings, patches, banners, apparel and other souvenirs by doing business with a CIF-SS licensed vendor. Schools creating items with CIF-SS registered marks from a non-licensed vendor will face sanction and/or will be required to purchase any unsold shirts/items at the Championship Final if similar non-licensed items appear at the contest. A list of the currently licensed vendors for these products is included and regularly updated on www.cifss.org.

Please note: The use of only "CIF" is strictly prohibited per the State CIF registered trademark. We are the "CIF Southern Section", not just the CIF. Only those teams in State regionals, bowl games and individual sport finals actually qualify to use CIF without Southern Section attached. Any such use must be approved in advance by the CIF State office.

Host Site Requirements:

Playoff Tickets:

(This pertains to revenue sports of basketball, football and volleyball): It is mandatory to sell tickets for admission to all CIF-SS playoffs and championship contests. Use of the CIF-SS provided tickets is desired, if possible logistically, for audit, cost and sponsorship reasons. A Ticket Board(s) is included. Refer to the Ticket Handlers and Financial Clerks memo included with your tickets for additional information.

CIF-SS/FORD Banner:

It is a requirement of each host school (including off-site) that the CIF-SS/Ford Championships banner be displayed at every playoff home game in football and the gymnasium sports post football season (or on the electronic signage where schools/venues do not display banners).

PA Announcements:

As host of a CIF-SS playoff contest, the CIF-SS announcements take precedence over the host school's messaging and must be read in entirety at each playoff contest. Home schools are the host of a CIF-SS event in the playoffs. For contractual requirements, please read all the provided PA's each contest.

Media Credential Access:

Accredited working media should be given admission to all playoff games by showing their CIF-SS Press or Photo credential.

PARTICIPATION CERTIFICATES:

Each member of a team participating in the CIF-SS playoffs can receive a Participation Certificate. These certificates will be downloaded and printed solely by your school. The certificate is in a 'Type-In' format and may be downloaded from the CIFSSHOME website under FORMS.

CUSTOM AWARDS/ RINGS/BANNERS/APPAREL SOUVENIRS USING CIF-SS:

Schools often seek to create custom shirts, patches, gym banners and championship rings that include both the school and CIF-SS marks/logos/names. Example: 'ACME BOYS BASKETBALL 2015 CIF-SS CHAMPIONS'. Schools may create these items using CIF-SS marks only through a CIF-SS licensed vendor.

CIF-SS 'registered' trademark: The "CIF Southern Section", "CIF-SS", "Southern Section" and "CIF" marks and logos are registered trademarks with the State of California. Schools may only use the CIF Southern Section marks on rings, patches, banners, apparel and other souvenirs by doing business with a CIF-SS licensed vendor. Schools creating items with CIF-SS registered marks from a non-licensed vendor will face sanction and/or will be required to purchase any unsold shirts/items at the Championship final if similar non-licensed items appear at the contest. A list of the currently licensed vendors for these products is included and regularly updated on www.cifss.org.

Please note: The use of only "CIF" is strictly prohibited per the State CIF registered trademarks. Only those teams in State regionals, bowl games and individual sport finals actually qualify to use CIF without Southern Section attached. Any such use must be approved in advance by the CIF State office.

Mandatory Playoff Use Requirement:

The mandatory “official” ball rule for all playoff rounds, excluding golf. The rule applies throughout the conduct of **all** CIF-SS **playoff** contests.

Playoff Ball Use Rule Enforcement:

Should a school fail to provide the correct game ball, the game will always be played. Teams/schools failing to utilize the correct official ball in CIF-SS playoffs will be reported by officials to CIF-SS and will not be allowed to host their next available home playoff game. Penalty does carry over to the next season if not enforceable this season due to elimination.

Note: NFHS stamp is required in all sports *except in golf and tennis*.

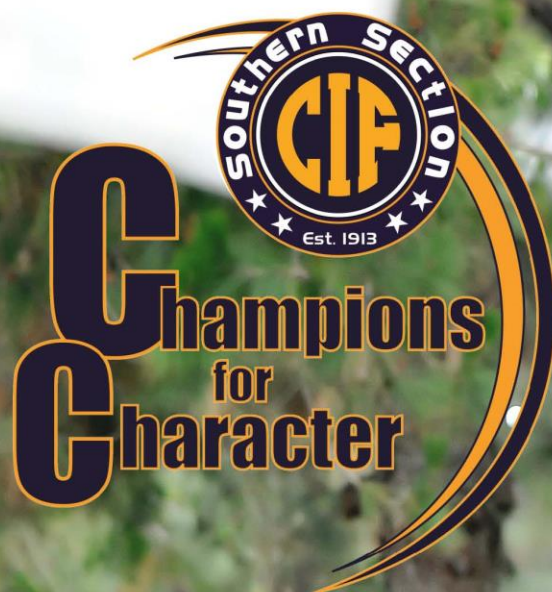
