All playoff ball adoptions agreements with the CIF Southern Section now run through June 30, 2021

Mandatory Playoff Use Requirement:

The mandatory "official" ball rule for all playoff rounds, excluding golf. The rule applies throughout the conduct of <u>all CIF-SS playoff</u> contests.

Playoff Ball Use Rule Enforcement:

Should a school fail to provide the correct game ball, the game will always be played. Teams/schools failing to utilize the correct official ball in CIF-SS playoffs will be reported by officials to CIF-SS and will not be allowed to host their next available home playoff game. Penalty will carry over to the next season if not enforceable this season due to elimination.

Note: NFHS stamp is required in all sports except in golf and tennis.

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1. SCHEDULES &SCORES

ALL SCHEDULES & SCORES MUST BE UPDATED IN CIFSSHOME (<u>www.cifsshome.org</u>) NO LATER THAN FEBRUARY 6, 2020

Attention Athletic Directors/Coaches: It is very important that you enter your entire season schedule into CIFSSHome (www.cifsshome.org) as well as update the scores immediately following your contests.

2. END OF COMPETITION

All league competition for entries must end on or before <u>Thursday</u>, <u>February 6</u>, <u>2020</u>. Any contest(s) played after the completion of league play and/or submission of league entries will not impact the seeding or ranking of a team or teams that were involved in those events.

3. PAIRINGS

First round pairings in all divisions will be announced **Saturday**, **February 8**. Pairings will be available on the CIF-SS website (www.cifss.org):

Boys' and Girls' Divisions......10:00 a.m.

4. PLAYOFF PAIRINGS

The initial step in the pairing process is to place the top four teams (identified by the sport specific Advisory Committee using the final "Top Ten Poll") into their assigned position within a playoff bracket. Provided no league-mates appear within the same quarter AND provided the 1st and 2nd place teams from the same leagues are separated into opposite halves of the bracket, the seeding process can continue with teams being placed in their assigned positions. Throughout this process, a 2nd place league entry may not be seeded higher than their 1st place league-mate. When there are "byes" in the draw, all league champions will receive a 1st round "bye" before any others, regardless of overall seed within the division. Additionally, when possible, 3rd, 4th, 5th and/or "at large" entries will receive "wild card" games prior to any 1st or 2nd place teams regardless of overall seed.

5. DETERMINATION OF SITES

To decide who shall be the host team AFTER the first round of competition will be the sole responsibility of the Commissioner. In cases where two teams are paired after the first round of the playoffs, the team having the fewest number of host games in playoff competition shall be designated as the host team. When both teams have had an equal number of host playoff contests, the Commissioner shall toss a coin to decide the host team. When a school has been designated as the host school for a playoff contest it shall (1) act in that capacity unless excused by the Commissioner, and (2) be considered the host team regardless of where the game is being played. **SPECIAL NOTE:** *Teams receiving a bye in the first round shall automatically be the host team in the next round of the playoffs.*

6. TIME OF GAME

All playoff game times (except for the championship finals) are set for 3:00pm or 5:00pm. The HOME TEAM has the option of these two times based on availability of the field and/or if the field has lights. If an alternate time is necessary mutual consent to the game time change is required by the two schools. All game times are to be confirmed between the opponents and then MUST be communicated to the Southern Section office and officials immediately for confirmation. ALL game times, location change, or date change must be sent via e-mail to the CIF-SS office.

7. PRE-FLIPS

For ALL Rounds we will be conducting pre-flips to give the teams involved immediate notice of their next game location. When the pairings are released on Saturday, February 8th the draw will indicate home and away teams. **Coin flips schedule for games played on the following dates listed below:**

8. OFFICIALS

Officials for all playoff contests will be coordinated by the CIF-SS on the basis of merit of the particular official's work during the regular season. In all playoff games, the officials shall receive \$80.00 in the two-person system and \$85.00/\$74.00 in the three- person system.

9. PRE-GAME ARRANGEMENTS

- (a) The host school is responsible for:
 - 1) Securing an adequate site for use in all playoff contests.
 - 2) Making arrangements for contrasting uniform jerseys.
 - 3) Contacting the visitors prior to game day to establish any necessary ground rules should the field or equipment not meet National Federation standards.
 - 4) Providing official Spalding **TF 5000 NFHS, TF-SC5 NFHS or TF-SC3 NFHS game ball to be used,** directions to the school, locker room arrangements, visitor parking or any other special circumstances relative to the contest.
- (b) GOALS MUST MEET SPECIFICATIONS OF NATIONAL FEDERATION RULE 1 SECTION 4
- (c) **NOISEMAKERS PROHIBITED** No noisemakers (horns, bells, victory bells, sirens, chimes, musical instruments other than those in the band, etc will be permitted inside the gymnasium, stadium or playing fields at any CIF Southern Section contest (non-league, league, tournament or playoff). Cheering devices such as wooden blocks, or other similar objects, are prohibited. Megaphones shall be used only by uniformed cheerleaders for the purpose of directing and controlling rooting sections. The improper use of any of the above listed devices by supporters of a team would subject that team to possible forfeiture of the contest.

10. <u>TEAM ROSTER</u>

As per National Federation Rule 3-1-3, each coach <u>shall</u> submit a roster, bench personnel and coach names to the officials at least five minutes prior to the start of the contest. The game shall not begin until this is complete.

11. UNIFORMS

THE VISITING TEAM SHALL WEAR SOLID WHITE JERSEYS AND SOLID WHITE SOCKS, AND THE HOME TEAM SHALL WEAR DARK JERSEYS AND DARK SOCKS.

ALL UNIFORMS MUST BE NUMBERED PER NATIONAL FEDERATION RULE 4-1-h-1.

12. SQUAD SIZE

Shall be restricted to 20 players, the CIF-SS will only provide awards up to the number of 20 per team.

- **13. INCLEMENT WEATHER** Whenever there is a situation involving inclement weather during the Soccer Championship Playoff Events, we feel it necessary to review with you the policies regarding rainouts, games called due to weather, etc. Here is the relevant information...
 - 1) In instances where games cannot be started due to inclement weather, teams will postpone that day's scheduled games until the next available date. Weekday games will be postponed until the next day, Saturday games will be postponed until the following Monday.
 - 2) If games are started and then must be called due to inclement weather, the following NFHS rules apply:
 - A) The head referee shall declare it an official game if one complete half or more of the game has been played. If less than one-half of the game has been played, the game must be rescheduled from the start.

We ask that you please communicate with our office immediately on any changes to your scheduled games.

14. <u>TIE BREAKING PROCEDURES</u>

The following tie breaking procedures will be in effect for all playoff games:

(A) Play will consist of two ten-minute "Golden Goal" (or sudden victory). If a tie still exists, the National Federation Rules pertaining to kicks from the mark will be followed:

<u>PLEASE NOTE:</u> ONE COACH FROM EACH TEAM SHALL BE ALLOWED ON THE FIELD WITH THEIR PLAYERS DURING KICKS FROM THE MARK.

- 1) All coaches, officials and team captains shall assemble at the halfway line to review the procedure as outlined below:
 - a. The head referee shall choose the goal at which all kicks shall be taken.
 - b. Each coach will select any five players, including the goalkeeper, on or off of the field (except those who may have been disqualified) to take the kicks from the mark.
 - c. A coin toss shall be held. The team winning the toss shall have the choice of kicking first or second.
 - d. Teams will alternate kickers. There is no follow-up on the kick.
 - e. Following five kicks for each team, the team scoring the greatest number of these kicks shall be declared the winner.
 - f. Add one goal to the winning team score and credit the team with a victory.
- 2) If the score remains tied after each team has had five kicks from the mark:
 - a. Each coach will select five different players than the first five who already have kicked to take the kicks in a sudden victory situation, wherein if one team scores and other team does not score, the game is ended without more kicks being taken.
 - b. If the score remains tied, continue the sudden victory kicks with the coach selecting any five players to take the next set of alternating kicks. If a tie still remains, repeat 2a.

15. MEDIA

Any radio broadcast or telecast, whether delayed or live, of any playoff soccer game, must be approved by the CIF-SS Office.

16. AUDIO AND VIDEO REPRODUCTION EQUIPMENT

The CIF Southern Section Office retains the right of all audio and video reproduction of any CIF-SS playoff contest. Permission for ANY audio or video reproduction equipment at CIF-SS soccer playoffs must be secured in advance from the Commissioner's office for which a fee will be charged.

17. CREDENTIALS

For 2019-2020 the only type of media pass to be honored at CIF-SS soccer playoff games where there is an admission charge is the CIF-SS Media Pass for press and photographer's, issued by the Commissioner's Office. This MEDIA pass will be honored at all championship games. The 2019-2020 CIF-SS Courtesy Cards will be honored at all CIF-SS soccer playoff games as well as the championship finals.

18. <u>ADMISSION REGULATIONS TO PLAYOFF CONTESTS</u>

Due to the inability of schools to secure a playing site which is enclosed, there will be no admission charge at playoff contests. If two competing schools wish to conduct an admission charge, the principals of those schools must receive permission from the CIF-SS Office in advance of the scheduled contest. If granted, the two schools then have the responsibility of conveying this information to their respective followings. In the event the competing schools agree and admission is charged, the following financial regulations will be in effect:

- (a) ADMISSION PRICES The admission prices shall be no higher than \$10.00 for adults, \$5.00 for students and children under 12. Schools may agree to a lower price structure.
- (b) HOST SCHOOL The designated host school is responsible for all costs incurred in hosting the contest. These would include officials, supervision, stadium rental, etc.
- (c) VISITING SCHOOL The designated visiting school is responsible for all costs incurred in team traveling, such as bus, meals, etc.
- (d) GATE SPLIT When admission is charged for rounds prior to the finals, the gate is to be handled as a gross gate and split 50-50 between the competing schools (please refer to Article I, Section 143 of the Blue Book).
- (e) **FINALS** The admission price for <u>Friday</u>, <u>February 28, 2020 & Saturday</u>, <u>February 29, 2020</u> will be:

\$10.00 General Admission

\$5.00 Student with High School I.D. & Children under 13

A SEPARATE TICKET WILL NEED TO BE PURCHASED FOR EACH DAY

*The CIF Southern Section Girls and Boys Division 1 - 7 Championships will take place on Saturday, February 29th @ 5:00pm. One team will be designated as the "Home" team and will be responsible for securing a site for the section championship. The host school must secure a Football Stadium like field. They may use their home site as long as it meets the facility requirements and can provide for the anticipated crowd. A date and/or time change may be adjusted if the two opponents can mutually agree on the adjustment and upon approval from the CIF-SS office.

In addition, selected divisions will be played at Warren High School on Saturday, February 29, 2020. **Specific sites** & times for each division will be posted at www.cifss.org no later than Monday, February 24th @ 10:00 a.m.

19. PROTESTS

By action of the CIF-SS Council at its March, 1983 meeting, protests of playoff contests involving National Federation Rules will no longer be entertained following the conclusion of the contest. Coaches may direct questions to the game officials as they pertain to a possible misapplication of the rules in accordance with the National Federation Rules governing that sport. No protest may be carried forth once the contest is completed. Coaches are encouraged to carry National Federation Rule books with them for all playoff contests. Schools will still have the opportunity to protest a contest in accordance with Southern Section rules, Rule 1112, as it pertains to use of ineligible players or violations of any CIF-SS rule in connection with the contest.

20. REMINDER

ANY PLAYER OR COACH RECEIVING A RED OR YELLOW/RED CARD <u>MAY NOT PLAY, COACH OR</u> <u>BE ATTENDANCE AT</u> THE TEAM'S NEXT CONTEST.

21. CHAMPIONSHIP FINALS MANDATORY MEETING

If your soccer team advances to the CIF Southern Section championship finals on Friday, February 28th or Saturday, February 29th, a <u>school administrator and coach</u> will be required to attend a meeting at the CIF-SS office on Tuesday, February 25th at a 9:00 a.m. or 11:00 a.m. meeting. At this time, you will be advised on packet pickup at the gate, team arrival and entrance gate, team bus parking, rooter bus parking, on-line ticket sales and post-game awards ceremony. Please review the Championship bulletin prior to calling our office. Uniform information and squad size will be addressed in the bulletin which must be adhered to.

SOCCER GAME MANAGEMENT AND CROWD CONTROL

New procedure could result in loss of home playoff contest.

With the 2020 Soccer Playoffs about to begin, administrators should review supervisory and crowd control procedures for the winter soccer season. Review this information with your principal and athletic director. These are the National Federation minimum requirements for crowd control.

As a review:

NATIONAL FEDERATION RULES **REQUIRE** THAT SPECTATORS BE CONFINED TO AN AREA **AT LEAST** 10 FEET FROM THE TOUCH LINE, TEAMS, OFFICIALS AND GOAL LINE
(Rule 1, Section 6 in the NFHS Soccer Rules Book)

** The **CONFINED AREA** must be marked with a barrier of some kind.

No one shall be permitted directly behind the goal line unless seated in bleachers.

<u>Home School Supervision</u> – Faculty supervisors should be individuals who are as familiar as possible with the members of the student body in order to facilitate identification of students whenever necessary.

<u>Visiting School Supervision</u> – The visiting school should assign a sufficient number of supervisors such that adequate crowd control can be accomplished.

All playoff games will be conducted under 2019-20 NATIONAL FEDERATION SOCCER RULES except where superseded by this bulletin or the Blue Book.

Rosters & Scores:

• Complete schedules are to be submitted to CIFSSHOME prior to each season.

• Update scores following every contest direct to CIFSSHOME

Additional directions on accessing CIFSSHOME are included in this document.

TV/Web/Radio Rights:

Any TV or streaming webcast (video or audio) or radio transmission of a CIF-SS playoff or championship event requires a contract and rights fees through the CIF-SS office prior to the contest. The only 'exceptions' are: Games broadcast via Fox Sports West, Fox Sports Prepzone or the NFHS Network.

'Official' Championship Souvenirs:

Souvenirs: The exclusive vendor for CIF Southern Section Championship souvenirs (t-shirts, scarfs, pins, beanies, hats, etc...) is our long-time partner *CIF T-shirts*. These are the official items sold each year per sport. You are likely familiar with their annual shirts at the finals. You can order team and individual items through them at **www.ciftshirts.com**.

Official Ball Required:

Only the approved official ball in each ball sport may be played by either school during CIF-SS playoff contests. Violation of this rule will result in loss of your next home playoff game. The current Official Ball list for each sport is included and available at www.cifss.org in the "Resources" drop down. This policy has been in effect since 2002.

Gatorade Only:

Only Gatorade jugs, cups, bottles, ice chests may be used or visible during any CIF-SS playoff contest. (No Powerade, Body Armor, etc). The only acceptable alternative is a plain-wrap or Igloo labeled products. This rule does not apply to the actual liquid distributed to athletes. This policy has been in effect since 1995.

CIF-SS on Souvenirs:

Playoff Tickets: (This pertains to revenue sports of basketball, football and volleyball): It is

mandatory to sell tickets for admission to all CIF-SS playoffs and championship contests. Use of the CIF-SS provided tickets is desired, if possible logistically, for audit, cost and sponsorship reasons. A Ticket Board(s) is included. Refer to the Ticket Handlers and Financial Clerks memo included with your tickets for additional

information.

CIF-SS/FORD Banner: It is a requirement of each host school (including off-site) that the CIF-SS/Ford

Championships banner be displayed at every playoff home game in football and the

gymnasium sports post football season (or on the electronic signage where

schools/venues do not display banners).

Gatorade: It is a requirement of each school use only Gatorade product/jugs/cups/squeeze

bottles during CIF-SS championship events. No other competitive product shall be

used. Water can be placed in Gatorade merchandise.

PA Announcements: As a host of a CIF-SS playoff contest, the CIF-SS announcements take precedence

over the host school's messaging and must be read in entirety at each playoff contest. Home schools are the host of a CIF-SS event in the playoffs. For contractual requirements, please read all the provided PA's each contest.

Media Credential Access: Accredited working media should be given admission to all playoff games by

showing their CIF-SS Press or Photo credential.
