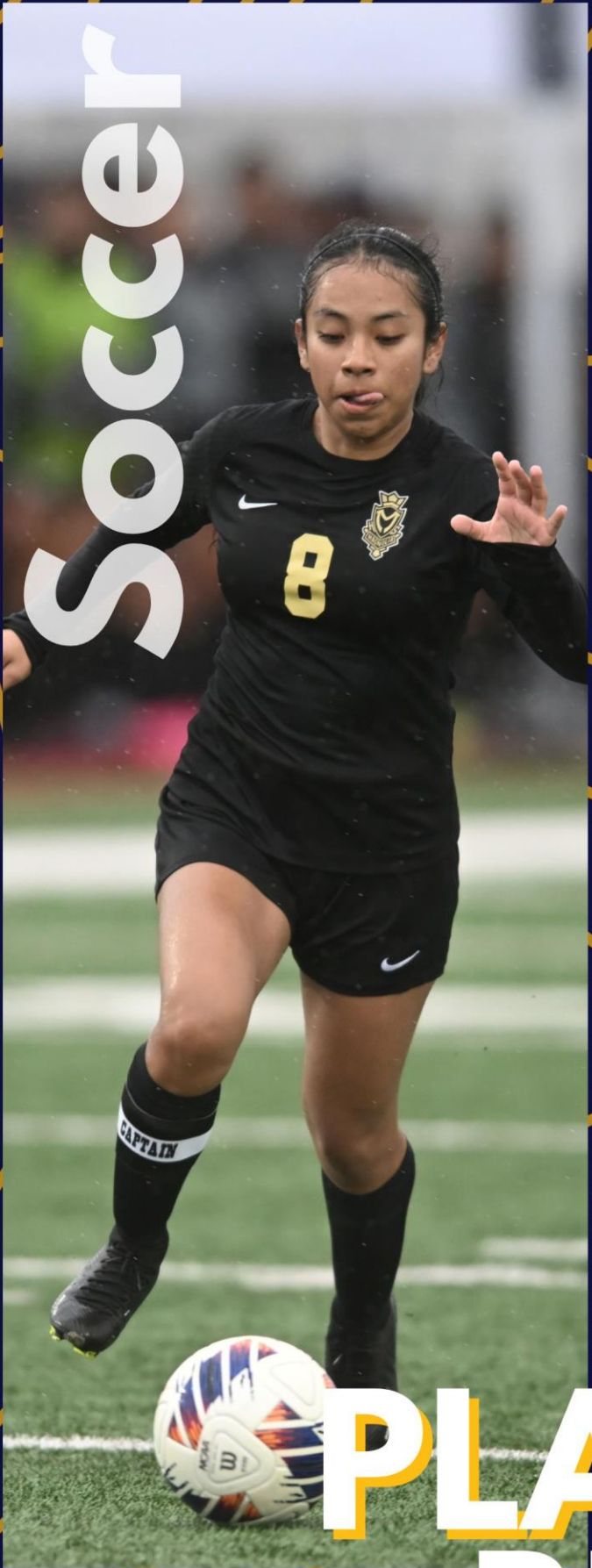

PLAYOFF RULES

All playoff games will be conducted under 2023-24 NATIONAL FEDERATION SOCCER RULES except where superseded by this bulletin or the Southern Section Blue Book.

The following bulletin is designed to assist your school in planning should you qualify for a berth in the post-season championship tournament conducted by the CIF Southern Section.

DATES / TIMES / LOCATIONS

All playoff game times (except for the championship finals) are set for 3:00 pm or 5:00 pm.

The HOME TEAM has the option of these two times based on availability of the field and/or if the field has lights. If an alternate time, other than the two times listed above, is necessary mutual consent to the game time change is required by the two schools.

All game times are to be confirmed between the opponents and then communicated to the Southern Section office and officials immediately for confirmation.

Attention Athletic Directors/Coaches: It is very important that you enter your entire season schedule into CIFSSHOMES (www.cifsshomes.org) as well as update the scores immediately following your contests.

Log in @ www.cifsshomes.org (If you do not have a log in & password as a coach, check with your Athletic Director). Once you are logged in:

- On the left panel, click on "Teams", select **Soccer, Boys or Soccer, Girls**

To Add a game:

- On the left panel, click on "Events", select "Add Event", choose Game under "Event Type", choose date of game under "Event Date", choose **Soccer, Boys or Soccer, Girls** under "Sport", choose Varsity under "Level", type the opposing school name in "Add Opponent", choose the type of game under "Select Game Type", click on Home, Away or Neutral under "Location", choose "Start Time" Click on "Save" to add one game or "Save & Duplicate" for multiple games.

- To Submit your score:

Mandatory Playoff Use Requirement:

The mandatory “official” ball rule for all playoff rounds, excluding golf. The rule applies throughout the conduct of **all** CIF-SS **playoff** contests.

***Items in red are used in the final game for the CIF-SS Championships. Any model listed is compliant in CIF-SS post season play.**

Playoff Ball Use Rule Enforcement:

Should a school fail to provide the correct game ball, the game will always be played. Teams/schools failing to utilize the correct official ball in CIF-SS playoffs will be reported by officials to CIF-SS and will not be allowed to host their next available home playoff game. Penalty will carry over to the next season if not enforceable this season due to elimination.

Note: NFHS stamp is required in all sports *except in golf, tennis and beach volleyball*.

1. **SCHEDULES & SCORES**

ALL SCHEDULES & SCORES MUST BE UPDATED IN CIFSSHOMES (www.cifsshome.org) NO LATER THAN THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 1, 2024.

Attention Athletic Directors/Coaches: It is very important that you enter your entire season schedule into CIFSSHome (www.cifsshome.org) as well as update the scores immediately following your contests.

2. **END OF COMPETITION**

All league competition for entries must end on or before **THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 1, 2024**. Any contest(s) played after the completion of league play and/or submission of league entries will not impact the seeding or ranking of a team or teams that were involved in those events.

3. **PAIRINGS**

First round pairings in all divisions will be announced **SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 3RD**. Pairings will be available on the CIF-SS website (www.cifss.org):

Boys and Girls Divisions 10:00 a.m.

4. **PLAYOFF PAIRINGS – Division 1 through 7**

The initial step in the pairing process is to place the top four teams (identified by the sport specific Advisory Committee using the final “Top Ten Poll”) into their assigned position within a playoff bracket. Provided no league-mates appear within the same quarter AND provided the 1st and 2nd place teams from the same leagues are separated into opposite halves of the bracket, the seeding process can continue with teams being placed in their assigned positions. Throughout this process, a 2nd place league entry may not be seeded higher than their 1st place league-mate. When there are “byes” in the draw, all league champions will receive a 1st round “bye” before any others, regardless of overall seed within the division. Additionally, when possible, 3rd, 4th, 5th and/or “at large” entries will receive “wild card” games prior to any 1st or 2nd place teams regardless of overall seed.

5. **PLAYOFF PAIRINGS – OPEN Division**

The teams selected for the Open Division will be straight seeded #1 - #8. In this format it is possible for two league mates to play in the opening round. Teams selected for the Open Division will not have an option to decline.

Selection for the Open Division will be based on the following:

- Strength of schedule
- Overall Record
- Strength at end of season (including roster additions/eligibility changes/winning & losing streaks/etc.)
- Head-to-Head vs. other Open Division and Division 1 Entries
- Overall Record vs. other Open Division and Division 1 Entries
- Victory vs. Quality opponents
- Quality loss
- In Season Massey Ratings

6. **DETERMINATION OF SITES**

To decide who shall be the host team AFTER the first round of competition will be the sole responsibility of the Commissioner. In cases where two teams are paired after the first round of the playoffs, the team having the fewest number of host games in playoff competition shall be designated as the host team. When both teams have had an equal number of host playoff contests, the Commissioner shall toss a coin to decide the host team. When a school has been designated as the host school for a playoff contest it shall (1) act in that capacity unless excused by the Commissioner, and (2) be considered the host team regardless of where the game is being played. **SPECIAL NOTE: Teams receiving a bye in the first round shall automatically be the host team in the next round of the playoffs.**

7. **TIME OF GAME**

All playoff game times (except for the championship finals) are **set for 3:00 pm or 5:00 pm**. The HOME TEAM has the option of these two times based on availability of the field and/or if the field has lights. If an alternate time, other than the two times listed above, is necessary mutual consent to the game time change is required by the two schools. All game times are to be confirmed between the opponents and then **MUST** be communicated to the Southern Section office and officials immediately for confirmation.

ALL game times, location change, or date change must be sent via e-mail to the CIF-SS office.

The e-mail must include the following information:

- **Division**
- **Gender**
- **The visiting school's Athletic Director has been included in the e-mail**
- **Teams in the Contest**
- **New game time / location / date**

8. **PRE-FLIPS**

For ALL Rounds we will be conducting pre-flips to give the teams involved immediate notice of their next game location. When the pairings are released on **Saturday, February 3rd** the draw will indicate home and away teams. **Coin flips schedule for games played on the following dates listed below:**

9. **OFFICIALS**

Officials for all playoff contests will be coordinated by the CIF-SS on the basis of merit of the particular official's work during the regular season. In all playoff games (excluding the finals), the officials shall receive **\$91.00** in the two-person system and **\$87.00/\$84.00** in the three-person system.

10. **OFFICIAL GAME CLOCK TIME**

Will be kept by the official on the field until the championship final at which time a clock will be used.

11. **PRE-GAME ARRANGEMENTS**

(a) The host school is responsible for:

- 1) Securing an adequate site for use in all playoff contests.
- 2) Making arrangements for contrasting uniform jerseys.
- 3) Contacting the visitors prior to game day to establish any necessary ground rules should the field or equipment not meet National Federation standards.
- 4) Providing official **Wilson NCAA Veza Match Ball** or **NCAA Vivido Match Ball** be used, directions to the school, locker room arrangements, visitor parking or any other special circumstances relative to the contest.

(b) **GOALS MUST MEET SPECIFICATIONS OF NATIONAL FEDERATION RULE 1 SECTION 4**

(c) **NOISEMAKERS PROHIBITED** No noisemakers (horns, bells, victory bells, sirens, chimes, musical instruments other than those in the band, etc will be permitted inside the gymnasium, stadium or playing fields at any CIF Southern Section contest (non-league, league, tournament or playoff). Cheering devices such as wooden blocks, or other similar objects, are prohibited. Megaphones shall be used only by uniformed cheerleaders for the purpose of directing and controlling rooting sections. The improper use of any of the above listed devices by supporters of a team would subject that team to possible forfeiture of the contest. The use of music is allowed by the home team during pre-game, half-time and when the ball is "dead" as long as it does not interfere with the safety of the contest as determined by the game official.

(d) **ANNOUNCER**

A game announcer is permitted for introduction of line-ups, substitutions, goal scorers, etc. but not play-by-play as this becomes a potential safety issue for the players and officials.

12. **TEAM ROSTER**

As per National Federation Rule 3-1-3, each coach shall submit a roster, bench personnel and coach names to the officials at least five minutes prior to the start of the contest. The game shall not begin until this is complete.

13. **UNIFORMS**

THE VISITING TEAM SHALL WEAR SOLID WHITE JERSEYS AND SOLID WHITE SOCKS, AND THE HOME TEAM SHALL WEAR DARK JERSEYS AND DARK SOCKS.

ALL UNIFORMS MUST BE NUMBERED PER NATIONAL FEDERATION RULE 4-1-h-1.

14. **SQUAD SIZE**

The squad size must be restricted to the Varsity team only. This is a Varsity event and should not include Frosh or Junior Varsity players. The CIF-SS will only provide awards up to the number of 22 per team.

15. **INCLEMENT WEATHER** – Whenever there is a situation involving inclement weather during the Soccer Championship Playoff Events, we feel it necessary to review with you the policies regarding rainouts, games called due to weather, etc. Here is the relevant information...

1) In instances where games cannot be started due to inclement weather, teams will postpone that day's scheduled games until the next available date. Weekday games will be postponed until the next day, Saturday games will be postponed until the following Monday.

2) If games are started and then must be called due to inclement weather, the following NFHS rules apply:

A) The head referee shall declare it an official game if one complete half or more of the game has been played. If less than one-half of the game has been played, the game must be rescheduled from the start.

We ask that you please communicate with our office immediately on any changes to your scheduled games.

16. **TIE BREAKING PROCEDURES**

The following tie breaking procedures will be in effect for all playoff games:

(A) Play will consist of two ten-minute "Golden Goal" (or sudden victory) periods. If a team scores during the first ten-minute period, the contests is complete. If a tie still exists after the second ten-minute period, the National Federation Rules pertaining to kicks from the mark will be followed:

PLEASE NOTE: ONE COACH FROM EACH TEAM SHALL BE ALLOWED ON THE FIELD WITH THEIR PLAYERS DURING KICKS FROM THE MARK.

1) All coaches, officials and team captains shall assemble at the halfway line to review the procedure as outlined below:

- a. The head referee shall choose the goal at which all kicks shall be taken.
- b. Each coach will select any five players, including the goalkeeper, on or off of the field (except those who may have been disqualified) to take the kicks from the mark.
- c. A coin toss shall be held. The team winning the toss shall have the choice of kicking first or second.
- d. Teams will alternate kickers. There is no follow-up on the kick.
- e. Following five kicks for each team, the team scoring the greatest number of these kicks shall be declared the winner.
- f. Add one goal to the winning team score and credit the team with a victory.

2) If the score remains tied after each team has had five kicks from the mark:

- a. Each coach will select five different players than the first five who already have kicked to take the kicks in a sudden victory situation, wherein if one team scores and other team does not score, the game is ended without more kicks being taken.
- b. If the score remains tied, continue the sudden victory kicks with the coach selecting

any five players to take the next set of alternating kicks. If a tie still remains, repeat 2a.

17. MEDIA

Any radio broadcast or telecast, whether delayed or live, of any playoff soccer game, must be approved by the CIF-SS Office.

18. AUDIO AND VIDEO REPRODUCTION EQUIPMENT

The CIF Southern Section Office retains the right of all audio and video reproduction of any CIF-SS playoff contest. Permission for ANY audio or video reproduction equipment at CIF-SS soccer playoffs must be secured in advance from the Commissioner's office for which a fee will be charged.

19. CREDENTIALS

Each school and/ or school district will determine if media credentials and/or courtesy cards will be honored based on the guidelines established by the CDPH, local county health department regulations, school districts, and individual schools/private schools.

20. ADMISSION REGULATIONS TO PLAYOFF CONTESTS

Due to the inability of schools to secure a playing site which is enclosed, there will be no admission charge at playoff contests. If two competing schools wish to conduct an admission charge, the principals of those schools must receive permission from the CIF-SS Office in advance of the scheduled contest. If granted, the two schools then have the responsibility of conveying this information to their respective followings.

In the event the competing schools agree, and admission is charged, the following financial regulations will be in effect:

- (a) **ADMISSION PRICES** - The admission prices shall be no higher than \$10.00 for adults, \$5.00 for students and children under 12. Schools may agree to a lower price structure.
- (b) **HOST SCHOOL** - The designated host school is responsible for all costs incurred in hosting the contest. These would include officials, supervision, stadium rental, etc.
- (c) **VISITING SCHOOL** - The designated visiting school is responsible for all costs incurred in team traveling, such as bus, meals, etc.
- (d) **GATE SPLIT** - When admission is charged for rounds prior to the finals, the gate is to be handled as a gross gate and split 50-50 between the competing schools (please refer to Article I, Section 143 of the Blue Book).
- (e) **FINALS** - The admission price for **Friday, February 23 or Saturday, February 24, 2024** will be:
\$12.00 General Admission
\$5.00 Student with High School I.D. & Children under 13

Through the CIF-SS partnership with GoFan, ALL CHAMPIONSHIP TICKETS will be available online for digital purchase and presented electronically at the event gate for entry.

*The CIF Southern Section Girls and Boys Open Division Championships will take place on Friday, February 23rd at Veterans Stadium, Long Beach (4:30pm and 7:00pm).

Divisions 1 - 7 Championships will take place on February 24th. Two "neutral" sites will be used along with designated "home" sites to conduct the remaining 14 championship matches. The "neutral" sites will be Veterans Stadium, Long Beach and Fred Kelley Stadium, Orange. The teams/games selected to these sites will be determined after the semi-finals have been complete on Saturday, February 17th.

Teams/games not selected for one of the "neutral" sites will be assigned to a "home" team following the normal coin flip process. The "home" team will be responsible for securing a site for the section championship. The host school must secure a football stadium like field (no park fields). They may use their home site if it meets the facility requirements and can provide for the anticipated crowd. A date and/or time change may be adjusted if the two opponents can mutually agree on the adjustment **and upon approval from the CIF-SS office.**

21. PROTESTS

By action of the CIF-SS Council at its March 1983 meeting, protests of playoff contests involving National Federation Rules will no longer be entertained following the conclusion of the contest. Coaches may direct questions to the game officials as they pertain to a possible misapplication of the rules in accordance with the National Federation Rules governing that sport. No protest may be carried forth once the contest is completed. Coaches are encouraged to carry National Federation Rule books with them for all playoff contests. Schools may still protest a contest in accordance with Southern Section rules, Rule 1112, as it pertains to use of ineligible players or violations of any CIF-SS rule in connection with the contest.

22. CHAMPIONSHIP FINALS MANDATORY MEETING

If your soccer team advances to the CIF Southern Section championship finals, a school administrator and coach will be required to attend a meeting on Tuesday, February 20th in the CIF-SS office (9:00am & 11:00am) regarding the Championship game, on-line ticket sales, post-game awards ceremony and packet pickup. Please review the Championship Bulletin (posted by February 14) prior to calling our office. Uniform information and squad size will be addressed in the bulletin which must be adhered to.

23. OPEN DIVISION PLAYOFF FORMAT

The Open Division teams will compete in a "Champions League" style format for the 2023-2024 playoffs.

1. Home and away format (same opponent two games in a row)
2. Cumulative score from both games used to determine winner who will advance.
3. Lower seed hosts the first game (#8 host #1)
4. Higher seed hosts the second game (#1 host #8)
5. First game may end in a tie after the conclusion of 80 minutes plus stoppage time.
6. If cumulative score is tied at the end of the second contest, traditional CIF Southern Section tie breaker of overtime and penalty kicks will be applied to determine a winner.
7. Round 1 & Round 2 (Girls) Feb. 8th and Feb. 10
Quarter-Final & Semi-Finals (Girls) Feb. 14th and Feb. 17th
Final (Girls) Feb. 23rd (single contest)
8. Round 1 & Round 2 (Boys) Feb. 7th and Feb. 9
Quarter-Final & Semi-Final (Boys) Feb. 13th and Feb. 16th
Finals (Boys) Feb. 23rd (single contest)

SOCCER GAME MANAGEMENT AND CROWD CONTROL

New procedure could result in loss of home playoff contest.

With the 2023-2024 Soccer Playoffs about to begin, administrators should review supervisory and crowd control procedures for the winter soccer season. Review this information with your principal and athletic director. These are the National Federation minimum requirements for crowd control.

As a review:

NATIONAL FEDERATION RULES **REQUIRE** THAT SPECTATORS BE CONFINED TO AN AREA **AT LEAST** 10 FEET FROM THE TOUCH LINE, TEAMS, OFFICIALS AND GOAL LINE

(Rule 1, Section 6 in the NFHS Soccer Rules Book)

IT IS HIGHLY RECOMMENDED THAT THERE BE NO OTHER ACTIVITIES TAKING PLACE ON THE FIELD OR IN THE STADIUM WHILE YOUR PLAYOFF SOCCER MATCH IS TAKING PLACE. SPORTS PRACTICES BOTH SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY AND/OR OTHER SIMULTANEOUS ACTIVITIES ON THE FIELD IS HIGHLY DISCOURAGED AS IT BRINGS LIABILITY AND RISK TO ALL INVOLVED.

IF THE GAME OFFICIAL(S) DETERMINES THE FIELD IS UNSAFE (DUE TO SIMULTANEOUS ACTIVITY), THEY CAN ORDER ALL OTHER ACTIVITIES TO CEASE PRIOR TO THE CONTESTS BEING PLAYED.

**** The CONFINED AREA must be marked with a barrier of some kind.**

No one shall be permitted directly behind the goal line unless seated in bleachers.

Home School Supervision – Faculty supervisors should be individuals who are as familiar as possible with the members of the student body to facilitate identification of students whenever necessary.

Visiting School Supervision – The visiting school should assign enough supervisors such that adequate crowd control can be accomplished.

Rosters & Scores:

- Complete schedules are to be submitted to CIFSSHOME prior to each season.
 - Update scores following every contest direct to CIFSSHOME
- Additional directions on accessing CIFSSHOME are included in this document.

TV/Web/Radio Rights:

Any TV or streaming webcast (video or audio) or radio transmission of a CIF-SS playoff or championship event requires a contract and rights fees through the CIF-SS office prior to the contest. The only 'exceptions' are: Games broadcast via The NFHS Network, Bally Sports West or Bally Sports SoCal.

'Official' Championship Souvenirs:

The exclusive vendor for CIF Southern Section Championship souvenirs (t-shirts, scarfs, pins, beanies, hats, etc...) is our long-time partner *CIF T-shirts*. These are the official items sold each year per sport. You are likely familiar with their annual shirts at the finals. You can order team and individual items through them at www.ciftshirts.com.

Official Ball Required:

Only the approved official ball in each ball sport may be played by either school during CIF-SS playoff contests. Violation of this rule will result in loss of your next home playoff game. The current Official Ball list for each sport is included and available at www.cifss.org in the "Resources" drop down. This policy has been in effect since 2002.

Gatorade Only:

Only Gatorade jugs, cups, bottles, ice chests may be used or visible during any CIF-SS playoff contest. (No Powerade, Body Armor, etc). The only acceptable alternative is a plain-wrap or Igloo labeled products. This rule does not apply to the actual liquid distributed to athletes. This policy has been in effect since 1995.

CIF-SS on Souvenirs:

The 'CIF Southern Section', 'CIF-SS', 'Southern Section' and 'CIF' marks and logos are registered trademarks with the State of California. Schools may only use the CIF Southern Section marks on rings, patches and banners, by doing business with a CIF-SS licensed vendor. **Schools may only use the CIF Southern Section marks on apparel and other souvenir items exclusively through ciftshirts.com. Schools creating items with CIF-SS registered marks from a non-licensed vendor will face sanction and/or will be required to purchase any unsold shirts/items at the Championship Final.** A list of the currently licensed vendors for these products is included and regularly updated on www.cifss.org.

Please note: The use of only "CIF" is strictly prohibited per the State CIF registered trademark. The "CIF", is not just the CIF Southern Section. Only those teams in State regionals, bowl games and individual sport finals actually qualify to use CIF without Southern Section attached. Any such use must be approved in advance by the CIF State office.

Host Site Requirements:

- Playoff Tickets:** (This pertains to revenue sports of basketball, football and volleyball): It is mandatory to sell tickets for admission to all CIF-SS playoffs and championship contests. Through the CIF-SS partnership with GoFan, all playoff tickets will be made available online for digital purchase and presented electronically at the event gate for entry. Patrons can purchase in advance via gofan.co, via private links made available by the participating schools or via QR code at the entry gate of the playoff event. All playoff revenue will be sent directly to CIF-SS. Both the host and visiting schools will be required to submit a financial/expense report following each playoff game in an effort to receive reimbursement for game expenses and revenue share split in the case of a profit game.
- CIF-SS/FORD Banner:** It is a requirement of each host school (including off-site) that the CIF-SS/Ford Championship banner be displayed at every playoff home game in football and the gymnasium sports post football season (or on the electronic signage where schools/venues do not display banners). If you need a banner please contact jackieg@cifss.org
- Gatorade:** It is a requirement of each school use only Gatorade product/jugs/cups/squeeze bottles during CIF-SS championship events. No other competitive product shall be used. Water can be placed in Gatorade merchandise.
- PA Announcements:** As a host of a CIF-SS playoff contest, the CIF-SS announcements take precedence over the host school's messaging and must be read in entirety at each playoff contest. Home schools are the host of a CIF-SS event in the playoffs. For contractual requirements, please read all the provided PA's each contest. PA's for each sport can be found on cifss.org under the designated sports page.
- Media Credential Access:** Accredited working media should be given admission to all playoff games by showing their CIF-SS Media credential.

CUSTOM AWARDS/ RINGS/ BANNERS/ APPAREL SOUVENIRS USING CIF-SS:

Subject: CIF STATE SOCCER REGIONAL CRITERIA

The CIF Southern Section is allotted 20 entries per gender into the State CIF Regional Soccer Tournament. The breakdown of those 20 entries per gender are as follows:

Division Open: (4) Total Entries. Teams that reach the semi-finals are automatic qualifiers.

Division 1: (4) Total Entries. Teams that reach the semi-finals are automatic qualifiers.

Division 2 – 7: (12) Total Entries. Teams that reach the championship final are automatic qualifiers.

If the championship or runner-up team elects not to compete in the event, they must notify Mike Middlebrook via e-mail no later than Monday, February 26, 2024. mikem@cifss.org

The 20 teams that are submitted to the State Regional event will be listed and entered based on the division in which they competed in during the Southern Section Championships. For example, the Division 3 Runner-up will be submitted and entered for the Regional before the Division 5 Champion. Teams may be moved to a different State Regional Division than the one in which they competed in during the Southern Section playoffs. There are no enrollment parameters in any division. The State CIF Seeding Committee has the authority to adjust when necessary due to travel considerations or when a repeat match-up of a final or semi-final occurs, but every effort is made to keep the schools in the order they are submitted.

ENTRIES – SEEDING PROCEDURES

The CIF SoCal Regional Soccer Championships will be conducted using eight-team (8) brackets in each of the five (5) divisions for both boys and girls.

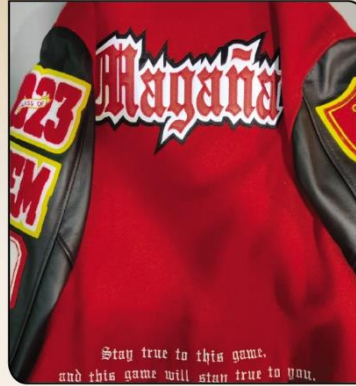

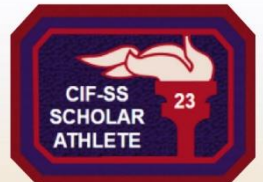
