COMPLIMENTARY TICKETS

Each school participating in the CIF-SS Soccer Championships will receive an allotment of 10 complimentary digital general admission tickets for each match in which they compete, via a unique promo code. The promo code will be entered by the intended comp recipient upon checkout to purchase the ticket at \$0. If additional tickets are desired, they must be purchased by the school at the prevailing rate. Drivers of team and roter buses must be provided with tickets by the school; they will not be admitted without a ticket. It's up to each participating school to decide how the complimentary tickets are distributed.

The CIF Southern Section office will send to each school 10 digital comp tickets. This distribution will be done via GoFan sent to the **Athletic Director's email** found in CIFSSHome. Once the school's Athletic Director receives the email, it may only be distributed one (1) additional time.

PARTICIPANTS' TICKETS

Players, Coaches, trainers, and stat personnel in uniform listed on your roster will be admitted through the participant entrance. **If the name is not on the roster, they will not be permitted onto the field.** All players and staff personnel are required to sit on your team bench for the duration of your game. Team bench seats are limited, and any player or staff overflow must sit in the bleachers.

Teams, Coaches, and bench personnel must arrive and enter the facility together.

If members of your team are arriving separately, please have them wait outside the venue until all team members are present before entering.

All schools will be provided a packet which includes the following passes:

- (4) Credential for school administration/faculty supervisors
- (2) Credentials for Media (High School Photo/Press)

FACULTY SUPERVISION

Supervisors for the game must report to the stadium before the start time to help preserve the integrity of their school's rooting section. All seating at Veterans Stadium is open for general admission seating. Each school is to submit the name of the two (2) faculty supervisors in charge, in the event he/she must be paged over the public-address system. Please submit the names of the Athletic Director, Administrator, and faculty supervisors **via e-mail to Chelsea Olson at chelseao@cifss.org no later than 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, February 26. Near the end of the game, with approximately five (5) minutes remaining in the contest, we ask that the faculty supervisors position themselves facing the stands to assist with crowd control and behavior.**

ANNOUNCER

A game announcer will be provided for the introduction of line-ups, substitutions, goal scorers, etc., but not play-by-play, as this becomes a potential safety issue for the players and officials. The announcer will also direct the post-game awards ceremony immediately after the contest.

At the conclusion of the contest, teams will be directed to line up at midfield for the presentation of the Runner-Up and Championship trophies. Each trophy will be presented to the school's designated recipient. No individual names will be announced.

PROGRAMS

The 2026 CIF Southern Section Soccer Championship Finals programs will be available online at www.cifss.org by Wednesday afternoon once all team information has been submitted.

SITE INFORMATION

VETERANS MEMORIAL STADIUM (Long Beach City College)

5000 E Lew Davis St, Long Beach, CA 90808.

Entry into the lot will be from Faculty Ave.

PARKING

Veterans Stadium will have staff collecting a **\$5.00** parking fee at the entrance on Faculty Ave. This is the only entrance for general admission parking. Participant buses will drop the team off on the Long Beach City College campus. The empty buses will park in the designated area in the Veterans Stadium parking lot for free. (see map below)

COOLERS/FOOD/DRINKS

Only sealed, unopened water bottles are allowed into the venue.

NO HYDROFLASKS, ICE CHESTS, COOLERS OR OUTSIDE FOOD
WILL BE ALLOWED INTO
ANY CHAMPIONSHIP FACILITIES

A snack bar and limited food trucks **WILL** be available.

NO RE-ENTRY ALLOWED

No re-entry is allowed for spectators into the venue without the purchase of an additional ticket. Spectators should bring all their jackets, blankets, umbrellas, etc., when entering the stadium. This venue has stadium seating, so no chairs will be allowed into the stadium.

PETS

No pets will be allowed into the venue unless they are documented service animals.

SOCCER WARM-UP FIELDS

The teams scheduled to play at 10:30 AM will warm up on the stadium field. All teams playing in subsequent games will warm up on the Multi-Purpose Soccer Fields. Warm-up fields will be open **90 minutes** prior to the game start time.

TEAM ROOMS

Team rooms (for games 2, 3, and 4) prior to your scheduled match time ARE available at Long Beach City College across the street near the warm-up fields. Please do not leave any items in the team room, as you will not return to this area. A Soccer Committee member will take the team to their respective team rooms upon arrival.

CHEERING SECTION

Fan/Student cheering sections are encouraged to cheer and support their own team and should display proper sportsmanship with respect to the opposing team and the game officials. They are expected to follow the following guidelines, and failure to do so may lead to removal from the contest and/or forfeiture of the contest.

It is the expectation that cheering section behavior will be monitored by the assigned school staff of the school they represent. All improper behavior/language should be addressed and corrected immediately by school staff supervisors. The walkway areas between the front row of the bleachers and the safety rail must remain clear. All spectators must be in the stands and clear of the railing.

NOISEMAKERS PROHIBITED

No noisemakers (horns, bells, victory bells, thunder sticks, sirens, chimes, cow bells, wooden blocks, musical instruments other than those in the band etc.) will be permitted at any CIF Southern Section soccer game.

Cheering devices, such as wooden blocks or similar objects, are prohibited. Megaphones shall be used only by uniformed cheerleaders for the purpose of directing and controlling rooting sections.

The improper use of any of the above-listed devices or any other artificial noisemaker by supporters of a team would subject that team to possible forfeiture of the contest. The use of music is **not** allowed by either team during pre-game.

BODY PAINT

Face Painting is acceptable from the neck up only and shall not include any inappropriate letters and symbols. Assigned school staff shall monitor their cheering sections with regard to face painting.

BANNERS AND POSTERS

Posters and banners are an excellent way of creating good sportsmanship between competing schools. Only those posters and banners exhibiting this concept will be permitted. If you choose to place signs and banners, you may only use blue painter's tape to attach them to the walls, railings, or bleachers. Your school will also be responsible for the removal of these signs once your contest is complete.

GAME INFORMATION

UNIFORM

Per NFHS rule, the designated visiting team shall wear solid white jerseys with solid white socks, and the home team shall wear dark jerseys and dark socks. In addition, both teams are **REQUIRED** to bring both home and away uniforms if a change is necessary. Dressing room facilities will be available, however schools are advised to come dressed.

ALL UNIFORMS MUST BE NUMBERED PER NATIONAL FEDERATION RULE 4, Section 1, Article 1 – 6 in the NFHS Rules Book.

TEAM ROSTER

As per National Federation Rule 3, Section 1, Article 3, each coach **must** submit a roster, bench personnel, and coach names to the officials at least five minutes prior to the start of the contest. The game shall not begin until this is complete.

Upon arrival, the teams should submit (5) copies of their complete updated roster in numerical order. All players will have their names announced prior to the contest based on the supplied roster.

SQUAD SIZE

The CIF Southern Section will provide awards up to a total of 22 per team. The squad size of the team should include only the regular-season rostered varsity team. All team members, including the coaching staff, must be seated during the contest. If the bench provided is not large enough, the extra players must sit on the ground.

WARM-UP BALLS

Each team is responsible for supplying its own warm-up/practice balls.

GAME BALLS

The game ball will be the **Wilson NCAA Vivido Match** soccer ball. CIF Southern Section will supply three championship game balls.

WARM-UP PROCEDURE

Regardless of the scheduled time of the contest, each team will be guaranteed 10 minutes of warm-up time on the championship field. Warm-up fields located on the Long Beach City College campus, across the campus adjacent to Veterans Stadium, will be available **90 minutes** prior to your scheduled contest time.

PRE-GAME CEREMONY

At the conclusion of the warm-up on the championship field (5:00 minutes on the clock before the scheduled start), the center official will call both teams to line up, single file at midfield for team introductions and the national anthem. Team members will line up and be announced in numerical order, starting with the designated visiting team, followed by the designated home team. Once the rosters have been announced, the National Anthem will be played. Following the National Anthem, teams will shake hands and then return to their respective bench for last-minute instructions before taking the field and the start of the contest.

OFFICIALS

The officials for the championship games will be assigned and paid for by the CIF Southern Section office. Each site will have a five-member, neutral crew. One of the five will be the official timekeeper, one will be assigned to the bench area (same side), and the remaining three will be on the field of play.

OFFICIAL TIMER

The CIF Southern Section will provide the official timer and scorer. The official game time will be displayed on the scoreboard, and the contest will end when the clock reaches 00:00. No additional time will be added at the conclusion of each half. The center official, if necessary, will stop the clock during the contest for injuries or unnecessary delays. The center official will indicate to the official timer when to stop and start the clock.

TRAINER

The CIF Southern Section will provide a trainer for all games. Schools, please provide your own supplies. Schools may provide their own trainer who will enter the field with the team and remain on the field for the duration of the contest.

OVERTIME PROCEDURES

No contest will end in a tie.

The tie-breaking procedure is as follows:

- After regulation time has been completed, there will be a two (2) minute break prior to the start of overtime.
- Two, ten-minute “Golden Goal” (or sudden victory) periods will be played with 2 minutes between each half. If a team scores during the first overtime period, the contest is over.
- If a tie score still exists, the game will be decided by kicks from the mark, as outlined in the NFHS rules book.

PROTESTS

BY ACTION OF THE CIF-SS COUNCIL, PROTESTS OF PLAYOFF CONTESTS INVOLVING NATIONAL FEDERATION RULES WILL NOT BE ENTERTAINED FOLLOWING THE CONCLUSION OF THE CONTEST.

Coaches may direct questions to the game officials as they pertain to a possible misapplication of the rules in accordance with the National Federation rules governing that sport. No protest may be carried forth once the contest is completed.

AWARDS CEREMONY

THE AWARDS WILL BE PRESENTED IMMEDIATELY AT THE CONCLUSION OF THE CONTEST.

Teams will line up at midfield following the contest in numerical order. **The CIF-SS will only provide 22 awards per team (see attached flyer to order additional Championship t-shirts and awards if needed).**

Immediately after the game, both teams should shake hands, then go on their side of the midfield line until called by the public-address announcer. The same pre-game announcing procedure will be followed.

All teams will accept awards as follows:

- A. The announcer will announce the administration from the Runner-Up. The administration will present the Runner-Up plaque to the head coach.
- B. Announcer will announce the administration from the Championship team. The administration will present the Championship plaque to the head coach.
- C. Teams return to the bench after the awards ceremony and clear out the area for the next contest.

Players and team members are not to leave the field until the conclusion of the awards presentation. Do not let your athletes leave the field at the conclusion of the contest to celebrate.

Do not allow team members to dump water jugs on the coaching staff or players. Remember, there is a contest immediately after, and cleanup can cause unnecessary delays.

MEDIA AND CREDENTIALS INFORMATION

PRESS INTERVIEWS

The Press may conduct interviews after the awards ceremony. If the press requests athletes for an interview, ***please have a coach or administrator present during the interview.***

BROADCASTS

The CIF Southern Section Office retains the right to all audio and video reproduction of any CIF-SS playoff contest. Permission for ANY audio or video reproduction equipment at CIF-SS soccer playoffs must be secured in advance from the Commissioner's Office, for which a fee will be charged.

COURTESY CARDS / PRESS CREDENTIALS

CIF-Southern Section press credentials issued by the Commissioner's Office, the State CIF Courtesy Card, and the State CIF Life Pass are the only credentials that MAY be honored for admission to the Southern Section Soccer Championships.

CHAMPIONSHIP FINANCIALS

RESPONSIBILITY

The principal of each school participating in the CIF Southern Section Soccer Championships shall be responsible for seeing that prescribed procedures pertaining to playoff regulations, as outlined in this bulletin, are followed. If the principal so desires, this responsibility may be delegated to a member of his staff.

FINANCIAL REPORT

The CIF-SS Blue Book requires the host school charge admission to the CIF Southern Section Soccer Championships. See financial policy Article 10, Section 120-149, CIF-SS Blue Book, page 46-49.

Playoff financial reporting via www.cifsshome.org has changed as schools will no longer be reporting ticket revenue. CIF-Southern Section will assume this responsibility, as all ticket sales will be reported on the day following each event from the GoFan captured sales report. However, host and visiting schools will maintain the responsibility of reporting game expenses via www.cifsshome.org upon approval of the submitted expense reports.

TRAVEL AND GAME EXPENSES

Travel expenses will be set at the allowable maximum of \$1.50 per mile round-trip. for either chartered or school transportation. The maximum allowance for private automobile transportation (limit of 4 cars) would be \$0.50 per mile, per car, round trip. Distances obtained from MapQuest shall be used when available for computing expenses. This subsidy is in concert with the CIF-SS council action, which established the amount and has encouraged schools to utilize vans and/or private automobiles, when possible, to keep travel allowances at a minimum for the participating schools. Where excessive travel is necessary, arrangements for any meal allowances must be approved in advance with the CIF Southern Section office.

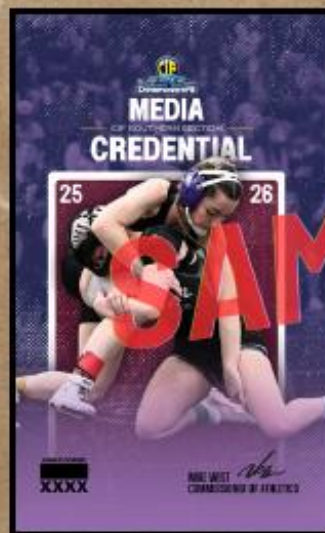

CIF SOUTHERN SECTION PLAYOFF/CHAMPIONSHIP REQUIREMENTS - ALL TEAMS AND HOST SITES 2024-2025



Rosters & Scores:

- Complete schedules are to be submitted to CIFSSHOME prior to each season.
 - Update scores following every contest direct to CIFSSHOME
- Additional directions on accessing CIFSSHOME are included in this document.

TV/Web/Radio Rights:

Any TV or streaming webcast (video or audio) or radio transmission of a CIF-SS playoff or championship event requires a contract and rights fees through the CIF-SS office prior to the contest. The only 'exceptions' are: Games broadcast via The NFHS Network, Bally Sports West or Bally Sports SoCal.

'Official' Championship

Souvenirs: The exclusive vendor for CIF Southern Section Championship souvenirs (t-shirts, scarfs, pins, beanies, hats, etc...) is our long-time partner *CIF T-shirts*. These are the official items sold each year per sport. You are likely familiar with their annual shirts at the finals. You can order team and individual items through them at www.ciftshirts.com.

Official Ball Required:

Only the approved official ball in each ball sport may be played by either school during CIF-SS playoff contests. Violation of this rule will result in loss of your next home playoff game. The current Official Ball list for each sport is included and available at www.cifss.org in the "Resources" drop down. This policy has been in effect since 2002.

Gatorade Only:

Only Gatorade jugs, cups, bottles, ice chests may be used or visible during any CIF-SS playoff contest. (No Powerade, Body Armor, etc). The only acceptable alternative is a plain-wrap or Igloo labeled products. This rule does not apply to the actual liquid distributed to athletes. This policy has been in effect since 1995.

CIF-SS on Souvenirs:

The 'CIF Southern Section', 'CIF-SS', 'Southern Section' and 'CIF' marks and logos are registered trademarks with the State of California. Schools may only use the CIF Southern Section marks on rings, patches and banners, by doing business with a CIF-SS licensed vendor. **Schools may only use the CIF Southern Section marks on apparel and other souvenir items exclusively through ciftshirts.com. Schools creating items with CIF-SS registered marks from a non-licensed vendor will face sanction and/or will be required to purchase any unsold shirts/items at the Championship Final.** A list of the currently licensed vendors for these products is included and regularly updated on www.cifss.org.

Please note: The use of only "CIF" is strictly prohibited per the State CIF registered trademark. The "CIF", is not just the CIF Southern Section. Only those teams in State regionals, bowl games and individual sport finals actually qualify to use CIF without Southern Section attached. Any such use must be approved in advance by the CIF State office.

Host Site Requirements:

- Playoff Tickets:** (This pertains to revenue sports of basketball, football and volleyball): It is mandatory to sell tickets for admission to all CIF-SS playoffs and championship contests. Through the CIF-SS partnership with GoFan, all playoff tickets will be made available online for digital purchase and presented electronically at the event gate for entry. Patrons can purchase in advance via gofan.co, via private links made available by the participating schools or via QR code at the entry gate of the playoff event. All playoff revenue will be sent directly to CIF-SS. Both the host and visiting schools will be required to submit a financial/expense report following each playoff game in an effort to receive reimbursement for game expenses and revenue share split in the case of a profit game.
- CIF-SS/FORD Banner:** It is a requirement of each host school (including off-site) that the CIF-SS/Ford Championship banner be displayed at every playoff home game in football and the gymnasium sports post football season (or on the electronic signage where schools/venues do not display banners). If you need a banner please contact jackieg@cifss.org
- Gatorade:** It is a requirement of each school use only Gatorade product/jugs/cups/squeeze bottles during CIF-SS championship events. No other competitive product shall be used. Water can be placed in Gatorade merchandise.
- PA Announcements:** As a host of a CIF-SS playoff contest, the CIF-SS announcements take precedence over the host school's messaging and must be read in entirety at each playoff contest. Home schools are the host of a CIF-SS event in the playoffs. For contractual requirements, please read all the provided PA's each contest. PA's for each sport can be found on cifss.org under the designated sports page.
- Media Credential Access:** Accredited working media should be given admission to all playoff games by showing their CIF-SS Media credential.

These certificates will be downloaded and printed solely by your school. The certificate is in a 'Type-In' format and may be downloaded from the CIFSSHOME website under AWARDS.

CUSTOM AWARDS/ RINGS/BANNERS/APPAREL SOUVENIRS USING CIF-SS:

Schools often seek to create custom patches, gym banners and championship rings that include both the school and CIF-SS marks/logos/names. Example: 'ACME BOYS BASKETBALL 2022 CIF-SS CHAMPIONS'. Schools may create these items using CIF-SS marks only through a CIF-SS licensed vendor.

CIF-SS 'registered' trademark: The "CIF Southern Section", "CIF-SS", "Southern Section" and "CIF" marks and logos are registered trademarks with the State of California. Schools may only use the CIF Southern Section marks on rings, patches and banners by doing business with a CIF-SS licensed vendor. Schools creating items with CIF-SS registered marks from a non-licensed vendor will face sanction and/or will be required to purchase any unsold shirts/items at the Championship final if similar non-licensed items appear at the contest. A list of the currently licensed vendors for these products is included and regularly updated on www.cifss.org.

Please note: The use of only "CIF" is strictly prohibited per the State CIF registered trademarks. Only those teams in State regionals, bowl games and individual sport finals actually qualify to use CIF without Southern Section attached. Any such use must be approved in advance by the CIF State office.

CIF-SS vendors who are licensed to create custom items for schools that include CIF-SS:
