COMPLIMENTARY TICKETS

Each school participating in the CIF-Southern Section Volleyball Playoffs will receive an allotment of 10 digital general admission tickets for each match in which they compete, via a unique promo code. The promo code will be entered by the intended comp recipient upon checkout to purchase the ticket at \$0. If additional tickets are desired, the school must purchase them at the prevailing rate. Drivers of team and roter buses must be provided with tickets by the school; they will not be admitted without a ticket. It's each participating school's discretion how the complimentary tickets are distributed.

The CIF Southern Section office will send 10 digital comp tickets to each school. This distribution will be done via GoFan, sent to the **[Athletic Director's email](#)** found in CIFSSHome. Once the school's Athletic Director receives the email, it may only be distributed one (1) additional time.

PARTICIPANTS' TICKETS

Players, Coaches, trainers, and stat personnel in uniform listed on your roster will be admitted through the participant entrance. All players and staff personnel are required to sit on your team bench for the duration of your game.

Team bench seats are limited, and any staff overflow must sit behind the bench if available or in the bleachers.

Teams, Coaches, and bench personnel must arrive and enter the facility together. If members of your team arrive separately, we ask that you have them wait outside the venue until all members are present before entering.

All schools will be provided with a packet that includes the following passes:

- 2 - Credentials for the School Administrators (Athletic Director, Principal)
- 2 - Credentials for designated Faculty Supervisors
- 2 - Credentials for High School Photo/Press

FACULTY SUPERVISION

Near the end of the contest, we ask that the Athletic Director and Principal move onto the gym floor to assist with the post-game awards. The faculty supervisors must position themselves facing the stands to assist with crowd control and the behavior of the spectators/students. No students or spectators are to enter the court area. Each school is to submit the names of the faculty supervisors in case he/she must be paged over the public-address system. Please submit the names of the Athletic Director, Administrator, and faculty supervisors **via e-mail to Chelsea Olson @ chelseao@cifss.org no later than 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, May 14th.**

CHEERLEADERS & BAND

Pep squads and pep bands of no more than 12 members will be admitted free of charge through the spectator entrance and must be in full uniform and/or carrying an instrument and accompanied by an adult supervisor. Pep squad members must arrive and enter the facility together. If pep squad members are arriving separately, we ask that you have them wait outside the venue until all members are present before entering.

CHEERING SECTION

Fan/Student cheering sections are encouraged to cheer and support their own team and to display proper sportsmanship toward the opposing team and the game officials. They are expected to follow the following guidelines, and failure to do so may lead to removal from the contest and/or forfeiture of the contest. It is expected that cheering section behavior will be monitored by the assigned school staff of the school they represent. All improper behavior/language should be addressed and corrected immediately by school staff supervisors. The walkway areas between the front row of the bleachers and the safety rail must remain clear. All spectators must be in the stands and clear of the railing.

NOISEMAKERS PROHIBITED

No noisemakers (horns, bells, victory bells, thunder sticks, sirens, chimes, cow bells, wooden blocks, musical instruments other than those in the band, etc.) will be permitted inside the gym at any CIF Southern Section volleyball game.

The improper use of any of the above-listed devices or any other artificial noisemaker by supporters of a team would subject that team to possible forfeiture of the contest. The use of music is **not** allowed by either team during pre-game. Any music played will be controlled by the PA announcer.

BODY PAINT

Face Painting is acceptable only from the neck up and shall not include any inappropriate letters or symbols. Assigned school staff shall monitor their cheering sections regarding face painting. Students/Spectators with body paint on any place other than their face will be asked to leave the facility.

BANNERS AND POSTERS

Posters and banners are an excellent way of creating good sportsmanship between competing schools. Only those posters and banners exhibiting this concept will be permitted. If you choose to place signs and banners you may only use blue painter's tape to attach to the walls or bleachers. Your school will also be responsible for the removal of these signs once your contest is complete.

COOLERS/FOOD/DRINKS

NO HYDROFLASKS, OUTSIDE FOOD OR DRINKS, ICE CHESTS, OR COOLERS WILL BE ALLOWED INTO ANY CHAMPIONSHIP FACILITIES. A snack bar WILL be available. **Only sealed, unopened water bottles are allowed into the gym.**

PETS

No pets will be allowed inside the gym unless they are documented service animals.

TEAM ROOMS

Team rooms prior to your scheduled match time ARE available at Cerritos College. Please do not leave any items in the team room. A Girls Volleyball Committee member will greet your team upon arrival and escort your team to their respective team rooms.

PARKING

Cross Streets:

Cerritos College is located at the corner of Alondra Blvd and Studebaker Road in the City of Norwalk. The Administration Building faces North on Alondra Blvd.

From Downtown Los Angeles:

Take I-5 South to I-605 South, exit I-605 at Alondra Blvd, turn left on Alondra Blvd, take Alondra Blvd East. The college will be on the right just past Studebaker Road.

From South Bay Area:

Take I-105 East to I-605 South, exit I-605 at Alondra Blvd, turn left on Alondra Blvd, take Alondra Blvd East.

From Orange County:

Take I-405 North to I-605 North, exit I-605 at Alondra Blvd, turn right on Alondra Blvd, take Alondra Blvd East.

From Riverside: Take I-91 West to I-605 South, exit at Alondra Blvd, turn right on Alondra Blvd, take Alondra Blvd East.

Volleyball Championships @ Cerritos College



GAME INFORMATION

GAME BALL

The MIKASA VFC1000 Series will be the game ball for the championships. If both coaches agree, the MIKASA V200W-USAN will be used. The CIF-Southern Section will supply the Championship balls. Teams will need to bring their own warm-up balls, which will then be placed in the ball carts that the CIF Southern Section will provide. **Do not bring a ball cart.**

SQUAD SIZE

The CIF-Southern Section will only provide **18** awards per team. The team's squad size should include only the regular-season rostered varsity team. All team members, including the coaching staff, must be seated during the contest.

UNIFORMS

The designated home team will wear white or light jerseys for the championship match.

The designated visiting team shall wear dark-colored jerseys for the championship match.

ATHLETIC TRAINER

The CIF-Southern Section will provide an athletic trainer at the event. Schools, however, may elect to bring their own trainer. If a school elects to use the provided trainer, they will need to bring any taping supplies, pre-wrap, etc. that will be needed. Injury ice will be available if needed.

USE OF CERRITOS COLLEGE

Teams competing in the championships are NOT allowed to work out or practice at the college noted above.

REFRESHMENTS

Schools may bring their own water supply to their designated bench. If you do so, the water must be in a Gatorade or generic (no label) cooler only. We will also provide water at each team bench.

WARM-UP SCHEDULE

Prior to the timed warmup, a conference shall be conducted between the head coach and captains from each team. Once the meeting ends, teams are guaranteed a minimum of 17 minutes: 5 minutes for shared ball handling and then 6 minutes on, 6 minutes off (serving is included within your 6 minutes). The serving team will be called to take the first 6 minutes, make sure your entire team, including all coaches, are off the court while the opponent is on the main court. After the 12 minutes of warmups, teams will return to their bench and then to the end line and prepare for the final 3 minutes of introductions and the National Anthem. **NOTE: If the game court is available earlier, teams are welcome to share the court or mutually agree to equal time alone.**

ANNOUNCER

A game announcer is required for the introduction of line-ups, substitutions, etc., but not play-by-play, as this becomes a potential safety issue for the players and officials. The announcer will also direct the post-game awards ceremony immediately after the contest.

At the conclusion of the contest, teams will be directed to line up on the court for the presentation of the Runner-Up and Championship trophies. Each trophy will be presented to the school's designated recipient.

The CIF-SS Office will provide the game announcer script.

Pre-Match:

At the conclusion of the player warm-ups, teams will be called to their respective baseline.

The following sequence will be utilized when giving team introductions:

- A. Announcer calls the designated visiting team first. Announcer will call non-starters in numerical order and then the starting lineup in numerical order.
- B. Announcer will then call the designated home team. Announcer will call non-starters in numerical order and then the starting lineup in numerical order.
- C. National Anthem will be played. Teams then return to the bench.

Post-Match:

At the conclusion of the contest, teams will be directed to line up on the baseline for the presentation of the Runner-Up and Championship trophies. Each trophy will be presented to the school's designated recipient.

The following sequence will be utilized when giving team introductions:

- A. Announcer calls the runner-up team first. The announcer will call non-starters in numerical order and then the starting lineup in numerical order.
- B. Announcer will then call the championship team. The announcer will call non-starters in numerical order and then the starting lineup in numerical order.

OFFICIALS

The CIF-Southern Section office will supply officials for the championship matches. The officials are neutral, representing the Commissioner, and have been selected because of demonstrated ability. The officials are under the guidelines of NFHS Rules and Regulations. An official scorebook will be kept by our Scorekeeper; no changes can or will be made by unauthorized personnel.

PROTESTS

BY ACTION OF THE CIF-SS COUNCIL, PROTESTS OF PLAYOFF CONTESTS INVOLVING NATIONAL FEDERATION RULES WILL NO LONGER BE ENTERTAINED FOLLOWING THE CONCLUSION OF THE CONTEST.

Coaches may direct questions to the game officials as they pertain to a possible misapplication of the rules in accordance with the National Federation rules governing that sport. No protest may be carried forth once the contest is completed.

AWARDS CEREMONY

THE AWARDS WILL BE PRESENTED IMMEDIATELY AT THE CONCLUSION OF THE CONTEST. Teams will line up on the court end line following the contest in numerical order. **The CIF-SS will only provide 18 awards per team (see attached flyer to order additional Championship t-shirts and awards if needed).** Immediately after the game, both teams should shake hands, then go to their respective side of the court until called by the public-address announcer. The same pre-game announcing procedure will be followed.

All teams will accept awards as follows:

- A. Announcer announces name of each player.
- B. Player receives medal or patch, shakes hands, and then returns to the team.
- C. The coach's name will be announced, and he/she will go forward and accept the team trophy.
- D. Teams return to the bench after the awards ceremony and clear out the area for the next contest.

PRESS INTERVIEWS

The Press may conduct interviews after the awards ceremony. If the press requests athletes for an interview, **please have a coach or administrator present during the interview.**

BROADCASTS

The CIF Southern Section Office retains the right to all audio and video reproductions of any CIF-SS playoff contest. Permission for ANY audio or video reproduction equipment at CIF-SS volleyball playoffs must be secured in advance from the Commissioner's Office, for which a fee will be charged.

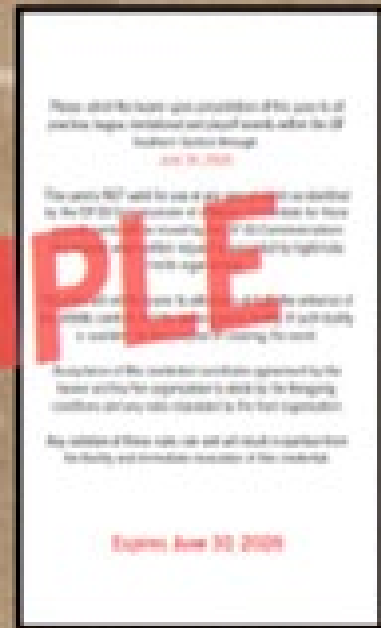

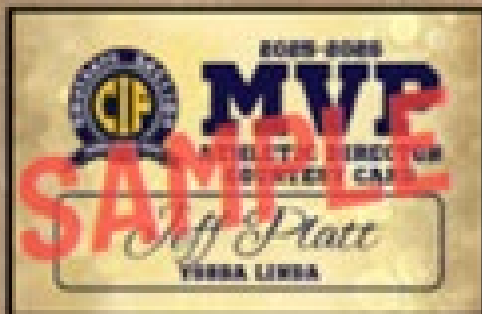

CHAMPIONSHIP FINANCIALS

FINANCIAL REPORT

The CIF-SS Blue Book requires the host school charge admission to the CIF Southern Section Boys Volleyball Championships. See financial policy Article 10, Section 140-149, CIF-SS Blue Book, page 48-49.

Playoff financial reporting via www.cifsshome.org has changed as schools will no longer be reporting ticket revenue. CIF-Southern Section will assume this responsibility as all ticket sales will be reported on the day following each event from the GoFan captured sales report. However, host and visiting schools will maintain the responsibility of reporting game expenses via www.cifsshome.org upon approval of the submitted expense reports.

TRAVEL AND GAME EXPENSES

Travel expenses will be set at the allowable maximum of \$1.50 per mile round trip for either chartered or school transportation. The maximum allowance for private automobile transportation (limit of 4 cars) would be \$0.50 per mile, per car, round trip. Distances obtained from Map Quest shall be used when available for computing expenses. This subsidy is in concert with the CIF-SS council action which established the amount and has encouraged schools to utilize vans and/or private automobiles when possible to keep travel allowances at a minimum for the participating schools. Where excessive travel is necessary, arrangements for any meal allowances must be approved in advance with the CIF Southern Section Office.

Rosters & Scores:

- Complete schedules are to be submitted to CIFSSHOME prior to each season.
 - Update scores following every contest direct to CIFSSHOME
- Additional directions on accessing CIFSSHOME are included in this document.

TV/Web/Radio Rights:

Any TV or streaming webcast (video or audio) or radio transmission of a CIF-SS playoff or championship event requires a contract and rights fees through the CIF-SS office prior to the contest. The only 'exceptions' are: Games broadcast via The NFHS Network, Spectrum Sports Net, Spectrum.

'Official' Championship

Souvenirs: The exclusive vendor for CIF Southern Section Championship souvenirs (t-shirts, scarfs, pins, beanies, hats, etc...) is our long-time partner *CIF T-shirts*. These are the official items sold each year per sport. You are likely familiar with their annual shirts at the finals. You can order team and individual items through them at www.ciftshirts.com.

Official Ball Required:

Only the approved official ball in each ball sport may be played by either school during CIF-SS playoff contests. Violation of this rule will result in loss of your next home playoff game. The current Official Ball list for each sport is included and available at www.cifss.org in the "Resources" drop down. This policy has been in effect since 2002.

Gatorade Only:

Only Gatorade jugs, cups, bottles, ice chests may be used or visible during any CIF-SS playoff contest. (No Powerade, Body Armor, etc). The only acceptable alternative is a plain-wrap or Igloo labeled products. This rule does not apply to the actual liquid distributed to athletes. This policy has been in effect since 1995.

CIF-SS on Souvenirs:

The 'CIF Southern Section', 'CIF-SS', 'Southern Section' and 'CIF' marks and logos are registered trademarks with the State of California. Schools may only use the CIF Southern Section marks on rings, patches and banners, by doing business with a CIF-SS licensed vendor. **Schools may only use the CIF Southern Section marks on apparel and other souvenir items exclusively through ciftshirts.com. Schools creating items with CIF-SS registered marks from a non-licensed vendor will face sanction and/or will be required to purchase any unsold shirts/items at the Championship Final.** A list of the currently licensed vendors for these products is included and regularly updated on www.cifss.org.

Please note: The use of only "CIF" is strictly prohibited per the State CIF registered trademark. The "CIF", is not just the CIF Southern Section. Only those teams in State regionals, bowl games and individual sport finals actually qualify to use CIF without Southern Section attached. Any such use must be approved in advance by the CIF State office.

Host Site Requirements:

- Playoff Tickets:** (This pertains to revenue sports of basketball, football and volleyball): It is mandatory to sell tickets for admission to all CIF-SS playoffs and championship contests. Through the CIF-SS partnership with GoFan, all playoff tickets will be made available online for digital purchase and presented electronically at the event gate for entry. Patrons can purchase in advance via gofan.co, via private links made available by the participating schools or via QR code at the entry gate of the playoff event. All playoff revenue will be sent directly to CIF-SS. Both the host and visiting schools will be required to submit a financial/expense report following each playoff game in an effort to receive reimbursement for game expenses and revenue share split in the case of a profit game.
- CIF-SS/FORD Banner:** It is a requirement of each host school (including off-site) that the CIF-SS/Ford Championship banner be displayed at every playoff home game in football and the gymnasium sports post football season (or on the electronic signage where schools/venues do not display banners). If you need a banner please contact jackieg@cifss.org
- Gatorade:** It is a requirement of each school use only Gatorade product/jugs/cups/squeeze bottles during CIF-SS championship events. No other competitive product shall be used. Water can be placed in Gatorade merchandise.
- PA Announcements:** As a host of a CIF-SS playoff contest, the CIF-SS announcements take precedence over the host school's messaging and must be read in entirety at each playoff contest. Home schools are the host of a CIF-SS event in the playoffs. For contractual requirements, please read all the provided PA's each contest. PA's for each sport can be found on cifss.org under the designated sports page.
- Media Credential Access:** Accredited working media should be given admission to all playoff games by showing their CIF-SS Media credential.

These certificates will be downloaded and printed solely by your school. The certificate is in a 'Type-In' format and may be downloaded from the CIFSSHOME website under AWARDS.

CUSTOM AWARDS/ RINGS/BANNERS/APPAREL SOUVENIRS USING CIF-SS:

Schools often seek to create custom patches, gym banners and championship rings that include both the school and CIF-SS marks/logos/names. Example: 'ACME BOYS BASKETBALL 2022 CIF-SS CHAMPIONS'. Schools may create these items using CIF-SS marks only through a CIF-SS licensed vendor.

CIF-SS 'registered' trademark: The “CIF Southern Section”, “CIF-SS”, “Southern Section” and “CIF” marks and logos are registered trademarks with the State of California. Schools may only use the CIF Southern Section marks on rings, patches and banners by doing business with a CIF-SS licensed vendor. Schools creating items with CIF-SS registered marks from a non-licensed vendor will face sanction and/or will be required to purchase any unsold shirts/items at the Championship final if similar non-licensed items appear at the contest. A list of the currently licensed vendors for these products is included and regularly updated on www.cifss.org.

Please note: The use of only “CIF” is strictly prohibited per the State CIF registered trademarks. Only those teams in State regionals, bowl games and individual sport finals actually qualify to use CIF without Southern Section attached. Any such use must be approved in advance by the CIF State office.
