The draw for the Ojai Valley Tennis Tournament will be available at www.ojaitourney.org on Tuesday, April 18, 2017 at 12:00 pm. Tournament dates: April 27-29, 2017. Play starts on Thursday, April 27, 2017 at 7:30 am.

Coaches are reminded that the tournament registration locations are the same as last year and you must check-in regardless of weather conditions (rain or shine). CIF Coaches can check-in Wednesday evening (April 26, 2017) between 6:00 pm and 7:30 pm **or** Thursday morning (April 27, 2017) between 6:30 am and 8:00 am at the media office across the street at Libby Park. Players cards **and** coaches wristbands **MUST** be picked up at the time of registration. A coach wristband is needed for admission to venues where a fee is charged for entry.

Coaches representing the school at Ojai must be approved for supervision purposes. Those persons are limited to:

- A. Certificated Personnel
- B. Certified Coaches (certified credentialed coaches)
- C. Non-Certificated Temporary Coaches (certified walk-on coaches)

**High school coaches must pick up all materials -
(students/parents/spectators may not pick up materials)
Do not jeopardize your athlete's participation . . .
Pick up materials yourself!**

If your school is unable to fulfill its singles or doubles commitment with the student-athletes entered, the next alternate school will take their place. You may not substitute other players for those submitted on your entries. Please notify the CIF-SS office as soon as possible of any withdrawals. There are no refunds for withdrawn entries.

CONSISTENT WITH OJAI VALLEY TENNIS TOURNAMENT POLICY, NO ALTERNATES WILL BE PLACED AFTER TUESDAY, APRIL 18th AT 12:00 P.M. PLEASE DO NOT HAVE YOUR PLAYERS SHOW UP EXPECTING TO FILL CANCELLATIONS AND/OR FORFEITS AT THE TOURNAMENT. IF AN OPENING DOES OCCUR AFTER TUESDAY APRIL 18th, IT WILL NOT BE FILLED.

SUBJECT: 2017 OJAI VALLEY TENNIS TOURNAMENT – IMPORTANT REMINDERS

The 2017 Ojai Valley Tennis Tournament will be held on APRIL 27, 28, 29, and 30. As it has been for the past 48 years, the CIF Southern Section will be responsible for all entries to the **SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA BOYS INTERSCHOLASTIC CHAMPIONSHIPS** that take place during the tournament in Ojai on **April 27, 28 and 29**. Southern Section schools will be allowed 47 singles entries and 47 doubles teams. The CIF-SS Boys Tennis Coaches Advisory Committee screened and selected the Southern Section entries for the Ojai Tournament.



IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR THOSE WHO WILL BE PARTICIPATING:

• **PLAYERS CARDS**

Since this event is a CIF-SS sanctioned event all high school rules are in effect. Please be aware that school coaches must accompany athletes to this competition. Therefore, **COACHES WILL BE THE ONLY INDIVIDUALS** allowed to pick up player cards on Wednesday night or Thursday morning. **Coaches checking in athletes from other schools in their district must have a letter of approval from the principal of that school.**

• **ALTERNATES**

An alternate list will be developed from entries submitted. All changes will be made prior to April 27. No changes will be made the day of the tournament. **PLEASE NOTE: If your school is unable to fulfill its singles or doubles commitment with the persons entered, the next alternate school will take their place. Schools may not substitute other players for those submitted on entry blanks. Please notify the CIF-SS office as soon as possible of any withdrawals.**

• **PARTICIPANTS**

The CIF-SS Office is responsible only for the entry of eligible high school boys interested in competing in the 19 and under age group division of the Ojai Valley Tennis Tournament. Athletes entering the Southern California Interscholastic Championships may not enter any other event in or outside of the tournament.

- **OJAI VALLEY TENNIS TOURNAMENT SANCTIONING**

We wish to call to your attention that the CIF Southern Section is sanctioning the Southern California Interscholastic Championship Griggs Cup Event as part of the upcoming Ojai Tennis Tournament.

The CIF Southern Section DOES NOT sanction the divisions listed below:

- 18 and under Girls Singles and Doubles
- 16 and under Boys Singles and Doubles
- 16 and under Girls Singles and Doubles
- 14 and under Boys Singles and Doubles
- 14 and under Girls Singles and Doubles

We bring this to your attention because although boys and girls from your school are entitled to enter these divisions of the tournament, they must do so **unattached**. The high school coach may not coach the students nor may official recognition or certification be given on the part of the school. Additionally, schools may not pay student's fees, furnish transportation or permit the use of school uniforms or equipment for students competing as unattached athletes.

- **CHECK-IN LOCATION AT TOURNAMENT**

The check-in /registration location is at the media center at Libbey Park. The media center is located on Ojai Street at the corner of Signal Street. Check in is on Wednesday, April 26, 2017 between 6:00 p.m. and 7:30 p.m. or on Thursday, April 27th between 6:30 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. Please look for the CIF registration table.

SPECIAL NOTICE

SUPERVISION OF ATHLETES

The Southern Section Office has experienced a problem which has perpetuated itself over the past few years as it pertains to proper supervision and entry of student-athletes in the post-season playoffs.

The situation relates only to individual sports, i.e. CROSS COUNTRY, INDIVIDUAL TENNIS, TRACK, SWIMMING, etc. and the official recognition and registration of entrants at the respective playoff sites.

State and Southern Section Rule 309 states:

No CIF team (i.e., individual) shall participate in inter-scholastic or approved competition with any other team unless the CIF team is under supervision as required by the California Administrative Code Title V and CIF By-Law #506A and #506B. (Additionally, refer to Rule 123.) The supervisor must remain in attendance at all times.

Those persons APPROVED FOR SUPERVISION PURPOSES are limited to:

A. Certificated personnel

B. Certified Coaches (certified credentialed coaches)

C. Non-certificated temporary coaches (certified walk-on coaches)

(It should be noted that schools representing the same DISTRICT may send one credentialed or certified supervisor for three or four athletes. These individuals have been recognized and are to continue to be recognized for registration and participation purposes in that the district has assigned the supervisory role for all students from its' member schools to this one individual.)

However, the concern is for those students who ARE NOT accompanied by a faculty representative and report to the playoff site by themselves or with a parent. ***GIVING PARENTS THE SUPERVISION AUTHORITY, WHETHER IN WRITING OR NOT, DOES NOT MEET THE STANDARDS SET FORTH IN THE ABOVE REGULATIONS. This also applies to parents who are the student's private coach but are not under contract to the member school.***

PLEASE NOTE, THIS RULE WAS REVIEWED BY BOTH THE STATE CIF OFFICE, IT'S GENERAL COUNSEL AND THE SOUTHERN SECTION EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE. IT HAS BEEN REAFFIRMED THAT THE INTERPRETATION STAND AS ABOVE AND THAT ANY STUDENT REPORTING FOR COMPETITION WHO IS NOT UNDER DIRECT SUPERVISION IN ACCORDANCE WITH STATE AND SOUTHERN SECTION RULE 309, IS TO BE DENIED ENTRY FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE COMPETITION.

As pointed out by the Southern Section and State CIF attorney, there are inherent liability problems when an individual competes in violation of said rule. Please review this rule with your staff in that it will be strictly enforced as per the above application.
