2017 CIF SOUTHERN SECTION-FORD FOOTBALL CHAMPIONSHIPS, ON TAP FRIDAY AND SATURDAY; 13 DIVISIONAL TITLES TO BE AWARDED

LOS ALAMITOS -- Thirteen divisional winners will be crowned champions this weekend in the 2017 CIF Southern Section-Ford Football Championships, scheduled for sites spanning from the desert to the sea. Championship football competition among CIF-SS member schools dates back to 1914. This will be the 104th edition.

The 13 divisional finals are sponsored by the Southern California Ford Dealers, Fox Sports West, Spalding, NFHS Network, Huddle Tickets/GoFan, Gatorade, Rawlings, Kap 7, Russell Athletic, Max Preps, CIF T-Shirts, California School Employees Association, Varsity Spirit, Les Schwab Tires, California Correctional Peace Officers Association, The United States Marines, Nfinity, Krossover, All-American Games, Ruffneck, Raising Canes, HEAD Penn, HL Corporation, Gamebreaker, JL Custom Jackets and Patches, Southern California PGA and SCGA Junior.

<u>DIVISION 1- St. John Bosco vs. Mater Dei, Saturday December 2nd, at Cerritos College, 7:30 pm, Fox Sports West</u>

Two of the top teams in the state of California and the United States will face off in the Division 1 Final at Cerritos College.

St. John Bosco continues its impressive recent run of success by arriving at the schools fifth straight CIF-SS championship game. The Braves are 11-2, the runner-ups in the Trinity League and were the 3rd seed in the bracket losing only to St. Thomas Aquinas (FL) and Mater Dei. Coach Jason Negro once again has a well-balanced team on both sides of the ball. QB DJ Uiagalelei has thrown 2733 yards and 29 TDs while RB George Holani has rushed for 1098 yards and 13 TDs. Three receivers have more than five TD receptions. The Bosco defense has over 200 tackles and has caused double digit turnovers. The Braves look to win their 3rd CIF-SS title, having won also in 2013 and 2016, winning the state title both times as well.

Having fallen in the final one year ago, **Mater Dei** returns to the CIF-SS final, with a 13-0 record, champions of the Trinity League and top seed in the bracket. Coach Bruce Rollinson's Monarchs have been ranked at the top all season long and features a powerful team on both sides of the ball. The Monarchs have scored over 600 points and have yet to allow 200. QB J.T. Daniels has thrown for 3591

DIVISION 1 (Cont.): yards and 44 TDs while rushing for 479 yards as well. His top target is WR Amonra St. Brown who has over 1000 receiving yards and 18 receiving touchdowns. The defense has nearly forty turnovers and nearly fifty sacks. The Monarchs look to add to their storied history with their first championship since 1998.

This is a rematch of last year's Division 1 Final won by St. John Bosco 42-28.

<u>DIVISION 2- Oaks Christian at Valencia, Friday December 1st, 7:30pm, Fox Sports Prime Ticket</u> The ball could be flying in the Division 2 finale.

Oaks Christian arrives at the programs first CIF-SS final since 2011. The Lions are the 4th seed in the bracket, the top team out of the Marmonte League and bring an 11-2 record into the final. Coach Jim Benkert's Lions are balanced on both sides of the ball, scoring over 400 points and have allowed 234. RB Zach Charbonnet has rushed for 1746 yards and 21 TDs. On defense Kayvon Thibodeaux has been a part of 5 fumbles and has recorded 16 sacks and over 80 tackles. An interception return for touchdown in the closing seconds of the semifinal helped get Oaks Christian to this point. The Lions seek the programs 8th title since 2003.

Valencia of Valencia arrivers at the programs first title game since 2013 and 5th overall since the school opened in 1994. The Vikings are the 3rd seed in the bracket, were the champions of the Foothill League and hold a 12-1 record. Coach Larry Muir's team is on an 8 game winning streak and have scored 711 in the season. QB Connor Downs has passed for 3025 yards and 28TDs. RB Moises Haynes has rushed for 1586 yards and 19 TDs. On defense, Brian Seymour has 7.5 sacks to lead the team with over 34 sacks. The Vikings seek the school's first football championship.

<u>DIVISION 3- Rancho Verde at St. Francis, Friday December 1st 7:00 pm, tape delayed on</u> Fox Sports West at 8:00 pm

High powered offense could be the name of the game in the Division 3 final.

Rancho Verde arrives at the programs sixth championship game. The Mustangs were the champions of the Inland Valley League, the 4th seed in the bracket and bring an 11-2 record. Coach Jeff Steinberg's team features an high scoring offense that has scored 564 points and a tough defense that has just allowed 220 points, all contributing to a nine game winning streak. QB Brock White has thrown for 2734 yards and 35 TDs. RB Xavier Ugorji has over 1195 rushing yards and double digit rushing touchdowns. On defense Jaxon Turner has over 80 tackles and 7 combined turnovers. The Mustangs look to bring the school its 2nd CIF-SS title.

St. Francis has reached the championship round for the first time since 1964. The Golden Knights hold a 12-1 record and were the 2nd seed out of the Angelus League. Coach Jim Bonds has an explosive offense that has scored 575 points and a defense that has allowed 217 points. QB Darius Perrantes has thrown for over 2400 yards and over 20 TDs. RB's Kevin Armstead and Elijah Washington have both rushed for double digits touchdowns. Armstead has also contributed to over ten turnovers on defense. St. Francis seeks the 3rd title in program history, both previous ones coming in the 1960's.

DIVISION 4- Cajon at Downey, Saturday December 2nd, 7:00 pm, Fox Sports Prep Zone

Points could be aplenty in the Division 4 final.

Cajon makes its first title game appearance since its 1987 triumph. The Cowboys are 12-1, the second seed in the bracket and were the champions of the Citrus Belt League. Coach Nick Rogers's team is on an 11 game winning streak led by a defense that has 213 points. QB Jayden Daniels has thrown for 4348 yards and 55 touchdowns. WR Darren Jones has caught over 20 touchdowns with 1799 receiving yards. Jonathan Perkins leads the defense with over 140 tackles, 7 sacks and has been a part of half a dozen turnovers. The Cowboys seek their second CIF crown.

DIVISION 4 (Cont.):

Downey makes its first appearance in a championship game since 2014. The Vikings bring a 11-2 record, were the second team out of the San Gabriel Valley League and knocked out back to back league champions to arrive at this point. Coach Jack Williams has a team that is on a seven game winning streak and has scored more than 550 points all season. QB Kijjon Foots has passed for over 2922 yards and 25 TDs while RB Baraq Ross has rushed for 2110 yards and 28 TDs. Malcom Perry leads the defense with over 100 total tackles and two interceptions. Downey seeks its 4th overall title and first since 2012.

DIVISION 5-Paraclete at Moorpark, Friday December 1st, 7:00 pm, Fox Sports Prep Zone

Defense could be the name of the game in the Division 5 finale.

Paraclete continues its two decade run of success with a second straight finals appearance following a CIF-SS and state title a year ago. The Spirts are 12-1, the champions of the Gold Coast League and are the top seed in the bracket. Coach Dean Herrington has continued his winning ways at Paraclete and his team has scored 555 points and allowed 202. QB Brevin White has passed for nearly 3000 yards and has over 40 touchdowns. WR Melquen Stovall has over 1000 receiving yards and over 15 touchdowns. The defense has nearly 30 combined sacks led by Flavio Carlos with 6. Coach Herrington looks to add to his own personal resume and the Spirits seek their 10th CIF title.

Moorpark returns to the title game for the first time since 2009. The Musketeers are the second seed out of the Camino League, have beaten two league champions during the playoffs and bring a 11-2 record. Coach Ryan Huisenga's team is led by a stout defense that has yet to allow 200 points this season. QB Blake Sturgill leads an offense that has scored over 450 points this season and the Musketeer defense has recorded three shutouts this year. Moorpark seeks the programs second CIF title and first since 1997.

<u>DIVISION 6- Bishop Diego vs. Golden Valley, at Canyon High School, Friday December 1st, 7:00 pm,</u> <u>Fox Sports Prep Zone</u>

The Division 6 finale will crown a first-time champion.

Bishop Diego makes its 3rd ever appearance in the championship game and first since 2007. The Cardinals hold a 12-1 record, are the top seed in the bracket and were the 2nd team out of the Tri-Valley League. Coach Tom Crawford's team has potent offense but is led by a defense that has allowed 162 points this season. RB John Harris has rushed for 1811 yards and 25 touchdowns. The defense is led by Alex Borgeson who has over 130 tackles and 6 sacks to help pace the Cardinals total of 16 sacks. Bishop Diego seeks to bring the school back its first ever football championship.

Golden Valley makes its inaugural appearance in the title game. The Grizzlies are 8-5, and were an At-Large team out of the Foothill League. Coach Don Kelley's team is a well-balanced squad and is riding a 4 game winning streak. The Grizzlies' offense is led by the ground game which nearly has 30 rushing touchdowns. On defense, Derrese Morganfield has over 100 tackles, and the defense has over 25 sacks, half of which belong to Cameron Ravenell. Golden Valley looks to win its first ever championship.

<u>DIVISION 7- El Modena at Don Lugo, Saturday December 2nd, 7:00pm, Fox Sports Prep Zone</u> Points could be hard to come by in the Division 7 final.

El Modena makes its first finals appearance since 1984. The Vanguards are 11-2, the second seed in the bracket and were the champions of the North Hills League. Coach Matt Mitchell's team has scored over 400 points and yet to allow 200 all season. QB A.J. Esperanza has thrown for over 2200 yards and nearly 30 TDs. WRs Justin Simpson and Ryan Smith each have double digit touchdown receptions. Josh Smith has over 70 tackles on defense. The Vanguards look to bring home the school's first football title.

DIVISION 7 (Cont.):

Don Lugo makes its first finals appearance since 1979. The Conquistadors are 11-2, the second team out of the Mt. Baldy League and are on a six game winning streak. Coach Greg Gano is also returning to the championship round and has a team that has only allowed 234 points. RB Khoury Bethley has rushed for over 1450 yards and 20 TDs. Bethley and Alex Navarro both have more than 5 of the teams more than 20 sacks. Don Lugo looks to bring home a first CIF title for the program and a fourth in the long career of Coach Gano.

<u>DIVISION 8- Grace Brethren at Antelope Valley, Friday December 1st, 7:00pm, Fox Sports Prep Zone</u> Teams with successful pasts will battle in the Division 8 finale.

Grace Brethren makes another appearance in a championship game. The Lancers are 11-2, the 3rd seed in the bracket and are the champions of the Tri-Valley League. Coach Josh Henderson's team is on a nine game winning streak and led by a defense that has allowed 212 points this year. QB Michael Zele has thrown for 1586 yards and 20 TDs. RB Lontrelle Diggs has rushed for 1513 yards and 24 TDs. Justin Skidmore and Josh Henderson both have over 100 total tackles to lead the defense. The Lancers seek to bring the school its 3rd CIF title.

Antelope Valley returns to the championship round for the first time since 1995. The Antelopes were the fourth seed in the bracket, tied for first in the Golden League and bring an 11-2 record into the game. Coach Jermaine Lewis's team is stingy on defense and has 242 points this year. QB Caden Hinton has thrown for 2531 yards and 26 TDs. RB Jermaine Marshall has 1566 rushing yards and 25 TDs. The defense is led by Bradley Brown who has double digit sacks and over 40 tackles. The Antelopes look to bring home the programs 6th CIF title and first since 1994.

<u>DIVISION 9- Aquinas at Burroughs/Ridgecrest, Friday December 1st, 7:00pm, Fox Sports Prep Zone</u> The top seeds in the bracket face off for the Division 9 title.

Aquinas returns to the championship game after falling short a year ago. The Falcons are a perfect 13-0, the champions of the Ambassador League and are the top seed in the bracket. Coach Jordan Brusig's has a high scoring offense that has produced 687 points and a defense that allowed 99 all year. RB Branden Rankins has rushed for nearly 2000 yards and nearly 30 TDs while QB Salieu Ceesay has passed for over 1600 yards. The Falcon defense has also forced more than 30 turnovers. Aquinas looks to finish the job this year and bring the school its 3rd CIF title.

Burroughs of Ridgecrest makes its first championship appearance since winning it all in 2005. The Burros were the second seed out of the Mojave River League, the 2nd overall seed in the bracket and hold an 11-2 record. Coach Todd Mather's team is a on a six game winning streak and has a defense that has barely allowed 200 points. QB Austin Griffin has passed for 2592 yards and 31 TDs. Half of those have been caught by WR Bryson Pippin who has over 1042 receiving yards. Brock Mather paces the defense with over 120 tackles and 9.5 sacks. The Burros look to bring back a 2nd CIF title.

<u>DIVISION 10- Dos Pueblos at Quartz Hill, Saturday December 2nd, 7:00pm, Fox Sports Prep Zone</u> Teams with identical records will meet in the Division 10 final.

Dos Pueblos makes its second ever championship game appearance and first since 2001. The Chargers are the second seed in the bracket, the champions of the Channel League and hold a 12-1 record. Coach Nate Mendoza runs a team that is on a 12 game winning streak and has allowed 173 points this year. RB Eric Lope has run for over 900 yards and over 15 rushing TDs. On defense Justin Padilla has been a part of six turnovers and has thirteen of the Chargers more than 30 total sacks. Dos Pueblos looks to bring the school back its first football title.

Quartz Hill returns to the championship game after falling one point short a year ago. The Rebels are 12-1, tied for first in the Golden League and beat two league champions to return to this game. Coach James Vondra's squad is led by a defense that has allowed 208 points this year. QB Matthew Tago has passed for 2759 yards and 37 TDs. WR Davon Jones has double digit touchdown receptions and over 850 receiving yards. The Rebels defense has 38 sacks and four players have more than five each. Quartz Hill seeks the schools 2nd CIF title.

<u>DIVISION 11- Katella vs Covina at Covina District Field, Friday December 1st, 7:00pm,</u> <u>Fox Sports Prep Zone</u>

Passing could be the key in the Division 11 final.

Katella makes the programs first ever appearance in a CIF final. The Knights are 12-1, the champions of the Orange League and bring a 12 game winning streak into the contest. Coach Fred DiPalma's team is led by its defense which has allowed 221 points on the season while a high powered offense is responsible for 450 points on the year. The Knights look to bring Katella its first ever CIF football title.

Covina returns to the championship round for the first time since its 1995 victory. The Colts were the 4th seed in the bracket, the co-champions of the Valle Vista League and hold an 11-2 record. Coach Joe Brown's team is balanced, on a six game winning streak and has scored 513 points this season. QB Nin Burns II has passed for over 2200 yards and nearly 30 TDs. WR Tristen Sprague has caught half of those touchdown passes and has nearly 900 receiving yards. Ailoua Tauvao has over 100 tackles on the year and has an interception. The Colts, who were a multiple title winner in the Southern Sections' early years look to bring Covina a 6th CIF title.

<u>DIVISION 12- Big Bear at Santa Maria, Saturday December 2nd, 7:45 pm, Fox Sports Prep Zone</u> The ball will be moving on the ground in the Division 12 finale.

Big Bear returns to the championship round for the first time since its 2006 victory. The Bears are 12-1, were the 3rd seed in the bracket and are the champions of the Cross Valley League. Coach Dave Griffiths has a team that is on a 12 game winning streak and has allowed 207 points all season. QB/RB Chase Dowty and RB Jesus Castro have both rushed for over 1000 yards and double digit touchdowns. The Bears defense have forced double digit interceptions and over 20 sacks. Big Bear seeks the 3rd CIF title in school history.

Santa Maria makes its fifth ever championship appearance and first since 1988. The Saints are 9-4, top champions of the Northern League and have defeated two league winners in these playoffs. Coach Dan Ellington's team is on a seven game winning streak and is balanced on both sides of the ball. QB Blake Truhitte has thrown for 2115 yards and 25 TDs. He also has 1874 yards rushing and 28 rushing TDs. Gabriel Bravo and Gerardo Zul both have double digit sacks to lead the Saints mark of 57 total sacks. Santa Maria looks to bring the school back its first CIF title.

<u>DIVISION 13- Silver Valley at Orange, Saturday December 2nd, 7:00pm, Fox Sports Prep Zone</u> A first ever championship awaits the winner of the Division 13 final.

Silver Valley arrives in the championship round for the first time in school history. The Trojans are 9-3, the second team out of the Cross Valley League and defeated two league champions during the playoffs. Coach John Stewart leads a team that is well balanced on both sides of the ball. RB EJ Ane has rushed for over 2600 yards and over 30 TDs. Anthony Brown has contributed more than 15 TDs on the ground. Joseph Thomas anchors the defense with over 110 tackles and he has been a part of four turnovers. The Trojans seek the programs first CIF championship.

CIF-SS FOOTBALL CHAMPIONSHIP BLOGGING POLICY

Each Credential Holder (including television, Internet, new media, and print publications) has the privilege to blog during competition through the Credential Entity. However, the blog may not produce in any form a "real-time" description of the event. Real-time is defined by the CIF-SS as a continuous play-by-play account or live, extended live/real-time statistics, or detailed description of an event. Live-video/digital images or live audio are not permitted. Each of the aforementioned descriptions is exclusive to the CIF-SS Web site and/or any other Web site designated by the CIF-SS and its rights holders. Periodic updates of scores, statistics or other brief descriptions of the competition throughout the event are acceptable. Credential Holder agrees that the determination of whether a blog is posting a real-time description shall be in the CIF-SS' sole discretion. If the CIF-SS deems that a Credential Holder is producing a real-time description of the contest, the CIF-SS reserves all actions against Credential Holder, including but not limited to the revocation of the credential.

If media intend to blog at a CIF-SS championship event, the media entity must indicate so through the credentialing process. Any media entity posting a blog during a CIF-SS championship must submit a direct link to the blog to www.cifss.org. In return, all media entities entering a blog must post the CIF-SS logo/link on their site. All blogs must be free of charge to readers. All must adhere to the conditions and limitations of this CIF-SS Blogging Policy. Video "blogging" of a CIF-SS event may not exceed more than 15 total minutes in duration and cannot include consecutive game action. The CIF-SS and its designated championship personnel shall be the final authority on whether a Credential Holder or Credential Entity is following the CIF-SS Blogging Policy.
