Program Criteria

What is this award & who sponsors it?

The CIF Southern Section-FORD Academic Awards give recognition to all Southern Section teams who meet the criteria and <u>one</u> senior male and <u>one</u> senior female athlete from each school who have excelled in academics as well as participating on an athletic team at their school.

Who qualifies for the Academic Award Team Championship Awards Program?

Which Teams Qualify?: 2 winners from the following teams will be honored in the following sports (Fall 2017, Winter 2018 & Spring 2018):


Baseball Boys Soccer Girl's Track and Field **Boys Basketball Girls Soccer Boys Volleyball** Girls Basketball Softball Girls Volleyball **Boys Cross Country Bovs Swimming Bovs' Water Polo** Girls Cross Country **Girls Swimming Girls Water Polo** Football **Boys Tennis Boys Wrestling Boys Golf Girls Tennis Girls Wrestling** Girls Golf Boy's Track and Field

- The following team sports <u>are not eligible for team consideration</u> because less than 20% of CIF-SS schools field the sports of: Badminton, Gymnastics, Field Hockey, Girls Lacrosse, or Boys Lacrosse.
- A team must consist of a minimum of five athletes.
- Team Enrollment Divisions: Awards will be given to two schools in each sport based on enrollment. There are two enrollment categories: schools with 1500 student enrollment and above and schools with 1499 student enrollment and below. Enrollment category is based on enrollment for grades 9th 12th.
- <u>Team GPA Requirements:</u>
 - The compiled grade point average in <u>all courses that receive a grade for the entire varsity</u> team must be **at least a 3.0 on a 4.0 non-weighted scale** to be considered.
 - Use 4.0 <u>non-weighted</u> Scale Only: A=4, B=3, C=2, D=1, F=0, F/Incomplete=0
 - EXAMPLE: Courses=7 Points= 27 (This can be 6 A's(24) and 1 B (3) which=27 points)
 - DO NOT enter their GPA
 - ONLY use grades from the 2017-18 school year's first semester (or two completed semesters if on a tri-semester / quarter system) must be used for computation.


Guidelines for Submitting on CIFSSHOME.ORG:

TEAM & INDIVIDUAL

- **A.)** Log in @ <u>www.cifsshome.org</u> (If you do not have a log in & password, check with your Athletic Director).
- **B.)** Once you are logged in On the left panel, click on: **Forms** then **Academic Awards**. Page Header will open to **Academic Awards Team** (box in the middle of the page will show **Team** or you may choose **Individual** to enter your Male or Female Athlete of the Year)
- C.) Click on: Add New
- D.) Page Header will read: Add/Edit Academic Awards Team
- E.) Sport: Choose the sport you are submitting from the drop down menu
- F.) If you choose *Import from Roster Page* this will populate the current roster names you have in CIFSSHome for each team sport. If information is being submitted by your Registrar, you will have to make sure the Permission Module/Allow Access box is checked so they are a User on CIFSSHome for Academic Awards. There is also a **PRINT** button if you would like to keep a hard copy for your records.
- G.) If you choose Import from Excel File, save and rename the Sample File. Complete the requested information including the total Number of Courses and total Number of Points for each team member SAVE the completed document and then click "Browse for File". Next click "Import Team". The team GPA will be automatically calculated. After importing, click "Save" at the bottom of the page.
 - o The number of **courses** is how many classes the student completed in the first semester (or two completed semesters if on a tri-semester / quarter system of the 2016-2017 year).
 - o The number of points is based on a Non-Weighted scale: A=4, B=3, C=2, D=1, F=0, F/Incomplete=0
 - **EXAMPLE**: Courses=7 Points= 24 (This can be five A's (20), one B (3) & one D (1) which= 24 points)
 - DO NOT enter their GPA
 - o There should **not** be any ½ points. All points should be whole numbers.
 - o If your grading system has A- or A+ it is still 4 points. The + and do not make a difference.



H.) After you submit a team and click save, you should be able to see the calculated GPA back on your team page. *If you do not see your team and GPA, something is not input correctly, please feel free to call Jackie Gibson (562)-493-9500*



Who Qualifies for the Senior Male and Senior Female Student Academic Athlete-of-the-Year Award?

- Athlete of the Year GPA Qualifications The student must be a senior during the 2017-18 school year and possess a minimum cumulative 3.5 GPA on a non-weighted 4.0 scale in all classes that receive a grade during 3 years of their high school career (sophomore, junior and first semester (or first two completed semesters if the school is on a tri-semester system) of their senior year to qualify.
- <u>Athlete-of-the-Year Extra Curricular Activities Qualifications</u> The student must letter in at least one of the following approved Southern Section varsity sports and participate in one of the following approved extra-curricular activities:
 - Approved Varsity Sports Badminton (coed), Baseball, Basketball, Cross Country, Field Hockey (girls only), Football, Golf, Gymnastics (girls only), Lacrosse, Soccer, Softball, Swimming, Tennis, Track & Field, Volleyball, Water Polo, Wrestling.
 - o **Approved Extra-Curricular Activities -** Band, Choral Group, Drama, Forensics, Organized Community Groups, Pep Squad, Service Organization, Student Council and Tutoring.
- **TO QUALIFY:** Participation is required in both the varsity sport and extra-curricular activity during the applicant's Senior Year.
- <u>NOTE</u>: EACH SCHOOL MAY SUBMIT **ONLY ONE SENIOR MALE AND ONE SENIOR FEMALE** AS ITS SELECTION FOR THE "ATHLETE OF THE YEAR" AWARDS PROGRAM.
- THE AWARD WILL BE AWARDED TO THE STUDENT(S) YOU SUBMIT. There is not an overall MALE and FEMALE winner competition with all schools.

What Recognition Do Winners Receive?

FIRST PLACE TEAMS in each sport and enrollment category (so two teams per sport) will be invited to participate in a pre-game ceremony and receive two tickets to the <u>Angels vs. Baltimore Orioles Tuesday, May 1, 2018</u>, as guests of the Southern Section and the Anaheim Angels. The head coach and one representative from each team will be involved in a pre-game ceremony on the field and will receive a banner for their school commemorating their achievement.

Group ticket information will be sent to the winner's for those schools wishing to bring their winning team members to celebrate this achievement. We do take group photos outside the stadium for those teams attending.

- Runner-up through Honorable Mention teams, as well as Senior Male and Senior Female Athletes-of-the-Year, will receive certificates that can be downloaded by your school from the CIF-SSHome website no later than April 1, 2018 to fill out on your own for presentation to your student athletes.
