### A. STATE FEDERATED COUNCIL NON-ACTION ITEMS

1. Proposed 2019-2020 State Budget - Non-Action STATE 584

(To Be Distributed at State Federated Council Meeting)

2. CIF State Executive Committee Nominations Non-Action STATE 585

No current Southern Section nominations therefore we will attend uninstructed.

3. Proposed Bylaw Revision 503.F - Non-Action STATE 586

Coaching Staff Payments

This bylaw revision is to better clarify when and how members of the schools' coaching staff may be paid and reimbursed for coaching and teaching. The revision also addresses the penalty for improper compensation.

4. Proposed Bylaw Revisions 22.B.9 & 503.L - Non-Action STATE 587

Emergency Action Plans and A.E.D.

This bylaw revision will now require as a condition of membership that schools have an Emergency Action Plan, at least one A.E.D. on campus available to athletic trainers and coaches as well as authorized persons at activities.

5. Proposed Bylaw Revision 2000.B -

Non-Action

**STATE 588** 

Varsity Football Age Requirement Medical Clearance

This proposal removed the requirement of having a licensed medical practitioner certify that the student can compete in the sport of Football at the varsity level.

6. Proposed Bylaw Revisions 211 and 303 –

Non-Action

**STATE 568** 

Continuation School

This proposal from the Commissioners Committee is proposing a revision to CIF Bylaws 211 and 303 which would allow athletic eligibility for students attending a Continuation High School. The change would grant a continuation school student athletic eligibility through a Multi-School Agreement provided the student's attendance at the continuation school is NOT a result of a disciplinary action.

### **B. SOUTHERN SECTION NON-ACTION ITEMS**

- 1. Proposed 2019-2020 CIF Southern Section Budget Non-Action SS 589 Mitch Carty presented the proposed budget noting the key changes in revenue in the 2018-2019 budget from 51% in sports playoff revenue down to 45% for the 2019-2020 school year. Mitch also noted that we will have an increase in sports broadcast rights fees. No change in ticket prices, no change in revenue playoff splits with member schools. Sports fees revenue will increase based on a proposed increase of \$15 per sport for the 2019-2020 school year. This will increase the current per sport fee from \$50 to \$65 per sport in 2019-2020. An additional increase of \$10 per sport will take place for the 2020-2021 school year to bring the total amount to \$75 per sport for 2020-2021. The budget power point will be posted for review for schools and leagues to discuss.
- 2. CIF Southern Section Executive Committee Nominations Non-Action SS 590 A list of candidates for the CIF Southern Section Executive Committee positions was presented as a first reading.
- 3. Officials Fees Proposal

  Bryce Sunderland addressed the Council and submitted the Officials Fees proposal for review.

  This proposal would increase official's fees across the board by \$1 per level for the next three years. Additional changes are also addressed in the sports of: swimming, track & field, volleyball and water polo.

Sunday for Cheer Only

This proposal requests a Sunday contact/participation exemption in the sport of Traditional Competitive Cheer only.

### 5. NEW BUSINESS

A. Transfer Rules Committee Update

Transfer Rules Committee Chairman Rich Shearer, Athletic Director from Citrus Hill High School, addressed the Council with a report from their initial meeting earlier that day. Rich asked that committee members stand and be recognized. Most of today's discussion was regarding the CIF defined valid change of residence, the new residence checklist and some of the difficulties that families will face attempting to verify the residence change. Another issue was raised regarding small schools that only have one level of participation. The current SOP bylaw hinders students who transfer schools without a valid change of residence and transfer under the SOP guidelines. These students have no choice in participating at the lower levels and thus are required to sit out half the season or not participate at all.

### 6. REPORTS

### A. Treasurer's Report

Dr. Jeff Jordan

Dr. Jordan reported that in the 2017-2018 school year revenue was at \$4,592,546 and expenses were \$4,476,750 for a net profit of \$115,797.

Dr. Jordan noted for the 2018-2019 school year that revenue is once again down, and expenses are slightly up but this is primarily only through the fall sport playoffs. Expenses during this time of the year are traditionally higher and will balance out during the year. Last, only four schools have yet to submit member dues with a total of 560-member schools who have paid.

### B. President's Report

Dr. Monica Colunga

Dr. Colunga addressed the Council expressing the need for member schools to do a better job communicating to fans, parents and students that behavior at athletic events should be appropriate for education-based athletics. She thanked the CIF-Southern Section staff for their efforts in hosting and running very successful fall championships. Last, she noted and applauded several principals that are working on making athletic trainers a full-time position on their campuses.

### C. Commissioner's Report

Rob Wigod

Commissioner Wigod updated the Council on the newly formed the Activities Director Advisory Committee and invited Todd Arrowsmith, Chairman, to address the Council and update highlights from their first meeting. Rob thanked the Transfer Rules Committee for today's work and the continued work ahead. Rob updated the Council on the Traditional Cheerleading Championships that took place on January 12, 2019. Winter sports championships are upcoming, and he reminded the Council when entries are due, and brackets will be released. Rob informed the Council that his next Message from the Commissioner will include an update from today's meeting specifically regarding the 2019-2020 budget. Rob thanked the following:
