NOTE: Only CIF-SS Courtesy Cards, CIF-SS Media Credentials, CIF-SS Life Passes, CIF State Courtesy Cards and CIF State Life Passes will be accepted at this event.

COMPLIMENTARY TICKETS

Each school participating in the CIF-SS Championships will receive an allotment of five (5) general admission complimentary tickets via GoFan. If additional tickets are desired, they must be purchased at the prevailing rate by the school. Bus drivers of the team and/or rooster buses must be provided with tickets by the school; they will not be admitted without a ticket. It's the discretion of each participating school how the complimentary tickets are distributed.

To receive a school's allotment of complimentary tickets a school administrator will need to send to Erin Courtemarche in our financial department at erinc@cifss.org the name and email recipient of the person who will accept the tickets from GoFan electronically. GoFan will then send directly to the email address provided for distribution.

PARTICIPANTS' TICKETS

Players, coaches, trainers, stat personnel in uniform listed on your roster will be admitted through the pass gate at the Main Entrance. All players and staff personnel are required to sit on your team bench for the duration of your game. There is **MAX number of 24 varsity players that will fit in the championship program.**

Teams, Coaches, bench personal (including stats and trainers) must arrive and enter the facility together.

All schools will be provided a packet which includes the following passes:

4 - Credentials for designated Faculty Supervisors (Athletic Director, Principal, Etc.)

1 - Credential for High School Photo/Press

FACULTY SUPERVISION:

Each school will provide a **minimum of three (3) faculty supervisors** for its respective student section who will be responsible for maintaining the integrity of their students. Faculty supervisors for these sections will be given an identification badge which will admit them through the Pass Gate and will also serve as the admittance to the field/stadium. NO FACULTY SUPERVISOR WILL BE ADMITTED WITHOUT THIS BADGE. Each school is to submit the name of the faculty moderator in charge, in the event he/she must be paged over the public address system. This name must be submitted to the CIF-SS Office by **8:00 AM, FRIDAY, May 10** if it was not provided at the Lacrosse Finals Meeting in the CIFSS office. Faculty members for each game are requested to remain on duty until the start of the next game to allow for a smooth transition in the student sections. All faculty supervisors must report 45 min prior to the game. The faculty person in charge will report to Thom Simmons, CIF-SS Event Coordinator, for proper assignment of school seating areas.

PEP BAND:

There will be 22 seats (21 plus 1 moderator) provided for each school's pep band. As with the student section, each school will be responsible for reserving these seats and maintaining the integrity of this section. Please note, **NO ELECTRIC AMPLIFICATION WILL BE PERMITTED AS PART OF THE PEP BAND.** Bands will be required to check-in at the Pass Gate/Will Call Table and must be accompanied by an adult director for entrance.

CHEERLEADERS/DANCE TEAM:

We will not cap the number of cheer team or dance team members. We only require that they arrive together and all in uniform. We will allow one adult supervisor per team entrance as well with these groups.

LOCKER ROOMS:

Locker rooms will be available at Fred Kelly Stadium. Schools are urged to make certain valuables are properly secured. All equipment brought into the locker room must be taken out and stored by your team bench area following halftime to make room for the next school to occupy that area for their game.

RADIO-TV:

Approval for radio and/or television broadcasts of any game at Fred Kelly Stadium must be secured from CIF-SS via email at TaylorM@cifss.org. All 2024 Lacrosse Championship games will be streamed on the NFHS Network.

PRESS CREDENTIALS:

Any media outlets contacting member schools for press credentials should be referred to Thom Simmons or Taylor Martinez at the CIF Southern Section Office.

OFFICIAL TIMER, SCOREKEEPER:

Fred Kelly Stadium will provide the official timer and clock operator. The Official Scorebook will be the Home Team's book. Please note, there will be NO room available at the scorer's and press table for stat people, etc.

PRACTICE:

There will be a practice/warm-up area for both competing schools on the east side of the school by the softball fields. Your team host will escort you to that area. (PLEASE SEE INCLUDED MAP)

BANNER/POSTER/BALLOONS:

Banners, posters, balloons, or noisemakers (horns, bells, victory bells, sirens, chimes, musical instruments other than those in the band, etc.) are **NOT** permitted inside the stadium.

CHEERING SECTION/BODY DECORATION:

Fan/Student cheering sections are encouraged to cheer and support their own team and should display proper sportsmanship with respect to the opposing team and the game officials. They are expected to follow the following guidelines and failure to do so may lead to removal from the contest and/or forfeiture of the contest.

1. No noisemakers (horns, bells, victory bells, sirens, chimes, wooden blocks, balloons, thunder sticks, etc.). Megaphones may only be used by the school's uniformed cheer squads.
2. Cheering devices such as rally towels, pom poms and pennants are acceptable when used within the bounds of good sportsmanship.
3. Face painting is acceptable from the neck up only and shall not include any inappropriate letters or symbols. Assigned school staff shall monitor their cheering sections regarding face painting.
4. It is the expectation that cheering section behavior will be monitored by the assigned school staff of the school that they represent. All improper behavior/language should be addressed and corrected immediately by school staff supervisors.
5. Rules are subject to specific event and/or venue limitations and by the judgement of lacrosse event management.

OUTSIDE FOOD:

Food and drink from the outside are not permitted within the stadium. Please ***DO NOT*** bring refreshments or goodies for your teams for after the game.

TAILGATING:

Tailgating in ANY lots on the premise of the stadium is strictly prohibited. Orange police will be patrolling the lot and violators will be asked to immediately leave the premises.

MEDICAL PERSONNEL:

The CIF Southern Section will provide medical personnel for each game, but competing schools are encouraged to bring their own team doctor and/or trainer. Pre-taping of players is each school's responsibility.

COLOR OF JERSEYS:

The host school will wear white or light jerseys and the visiting school will wear dark jerseys.

AWARDS:

CIF-SS regulations provide for twenty (20) individual patches and t-shirts to be provided to athletes of the championship boys team in each playoff division. CIF-SS regulations provide for twenty (24) individual patches and t-shirts to be provided to athletes of the championship girls team in each playoff division. Runner-up teams will receive twenty (20) individual patches for boys and twenty-four (24) for the girls. The championship and runner-up team in each division will each receive a CIF-SS permanent plaque which will be retained by the school. Team and individual awards will be presented immediately following each championship contest. Please refer to pages in this bulletin for additional information regarding awards, souvenirs, and vendors.

HALFTIME PERFORMANCE:

In reference to halftime performances, each school will be limited to five (5) minutes each with the visiting team performing first. No mechanical noisemakers are permitted at any time or battery-powered megaphones to direct the respective student section.

GAME BALL:

The **Champion Sports NOCSAE Balls** (White **LBWNOCSAE** and Yellow **LBYNOCSAE**) will be used as the official game ball. The game ball will be provided by the CIF Southern Section.

INTRODUCTIONS:

The alternates/starting lineup from each team will be introduced, starting with the visiting team. Your team host will ask to be provided your starters prior to the game to provide to the PA announcer for that purpose. At that time, they will also request you provide someone to go over pronunciations with the PA announcer.

FILMING:

Schools desiring to film/video tape their games will do so from the assigned area. Please contact press box host upon arrival for proper assignment. Schools are asked to bring proper extension cords (at least 100 feet).

AUDIO AND VIDEO REPRODUCTION EQUIPMENT:

The CIF Southern Section Office retains the right for all audio and video reproduction of any CIF-SS playoff contest. Permission for ANY audio or video reproduction equipment at CIF-SS lacrosse playoffs must be secured in advance from the Commissioner's Office for which a fee will be charged.

NATIONAL ANTHEM: The National Anthem will be played/performed prior to the first game of the day. If the home school has a singer, they would like to do the anthem they will have first choice. If they do not, the visiting school may select somebody. If neither school has a performer, we will do a taped version. All national anthem singers must be identified, and their names sent to Thom Simmons at the CIF-SS Office no later than 1:00 p.m. Thursday afternoon.
