3. Proposed Bylaw 503.M Revision – Ejection Policy Non-Action STATE 602  
This revision would implement a statewide policy to standardize the penalties for game ejections and to set expectations for the behavior of student-athletes, coaches, parents and spectators.

The 2020-2021 Southern Section Proposed Budget was presented by Commissioner Wigod and CFO Mitch Carty. Commissioner Wigod reviewed the dues increase that was presented and passed in 2018-2019 and then followed up by showing how our reliance on ticket revenue has decreased while our income from rights fees and sports revenue has increased to a more balanced level. Mr. Carty then presented the budget for the 2020-2021 year that included a 1% COLA for administrative staff, 2% COLA for non-administrative staff and a projected balanced budget at the conclusion of the fiscal year.

Tom has had contact with over 400 potential new officials: 96/football, 96/basketball, 76/soccer were the ones with the largest increase. Mr. Wigod and Carter Paysinger will be attending the CIF Football Summit to be held in Sacramento on February 6. The mission is to look at how we can best promote and improve football safety. Commissioner Wigod finished by asking the Council to promote and support the Champions for Character Golf Tournament that funds our student-athlete scholarships. Finally, May 1 is the deadline for nominations for the Hall of Fame and Distinguished Service awards.

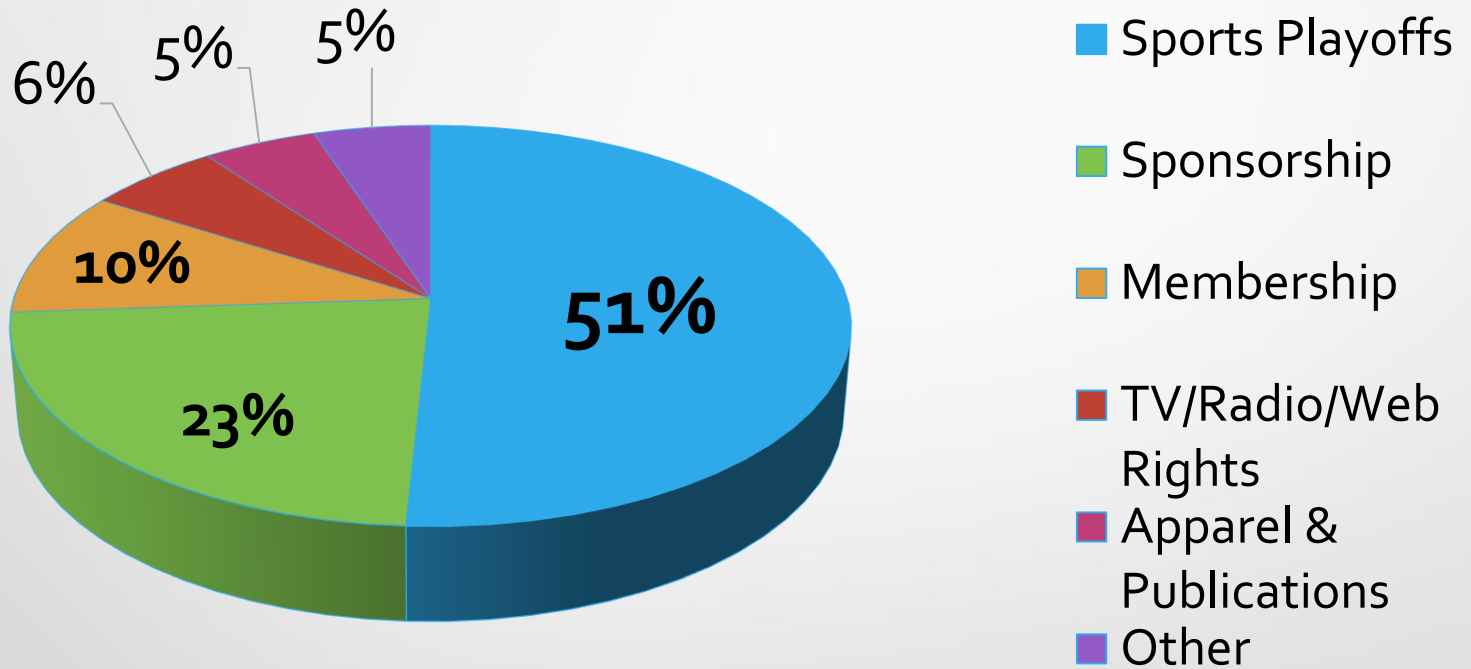

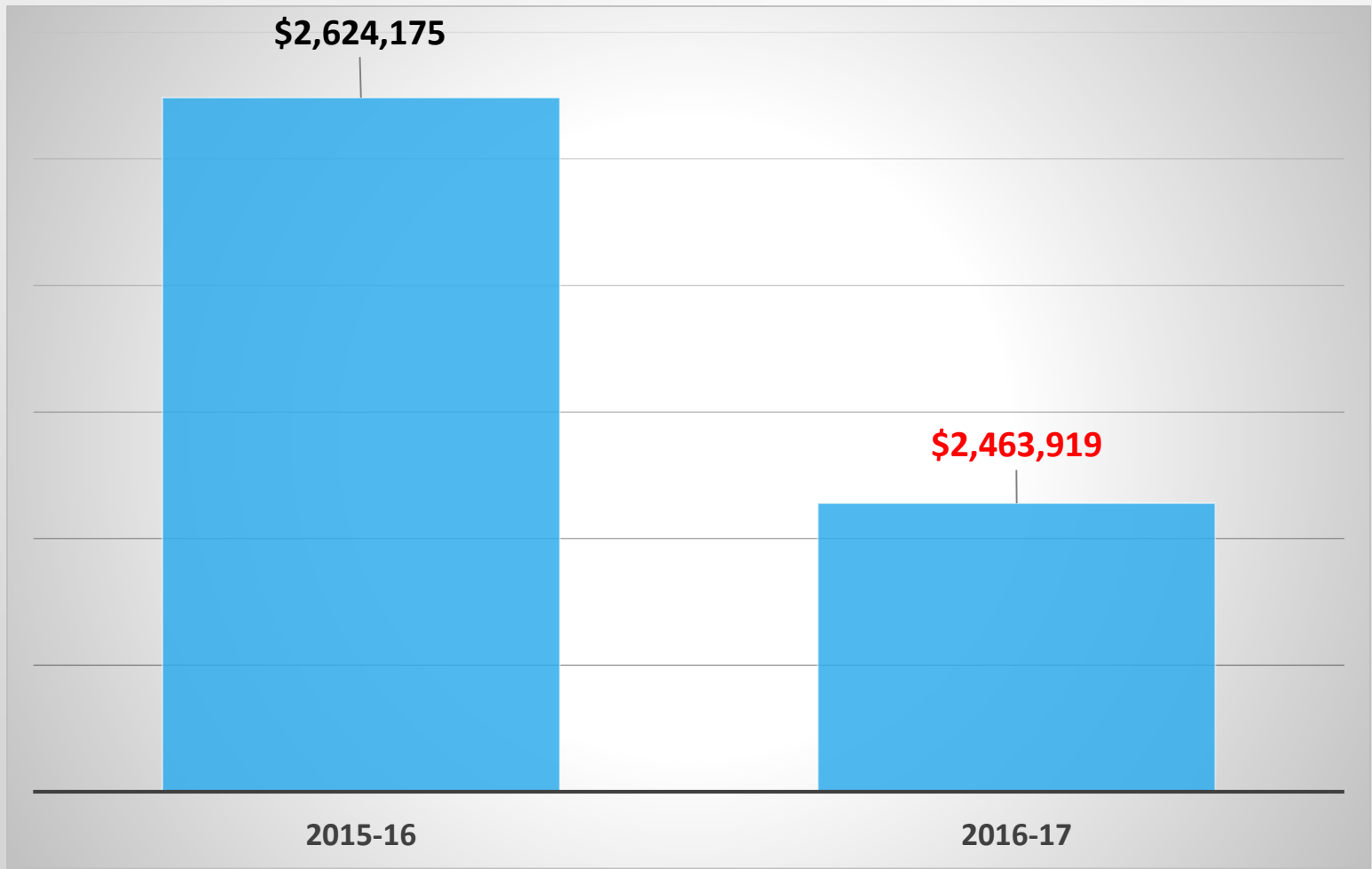

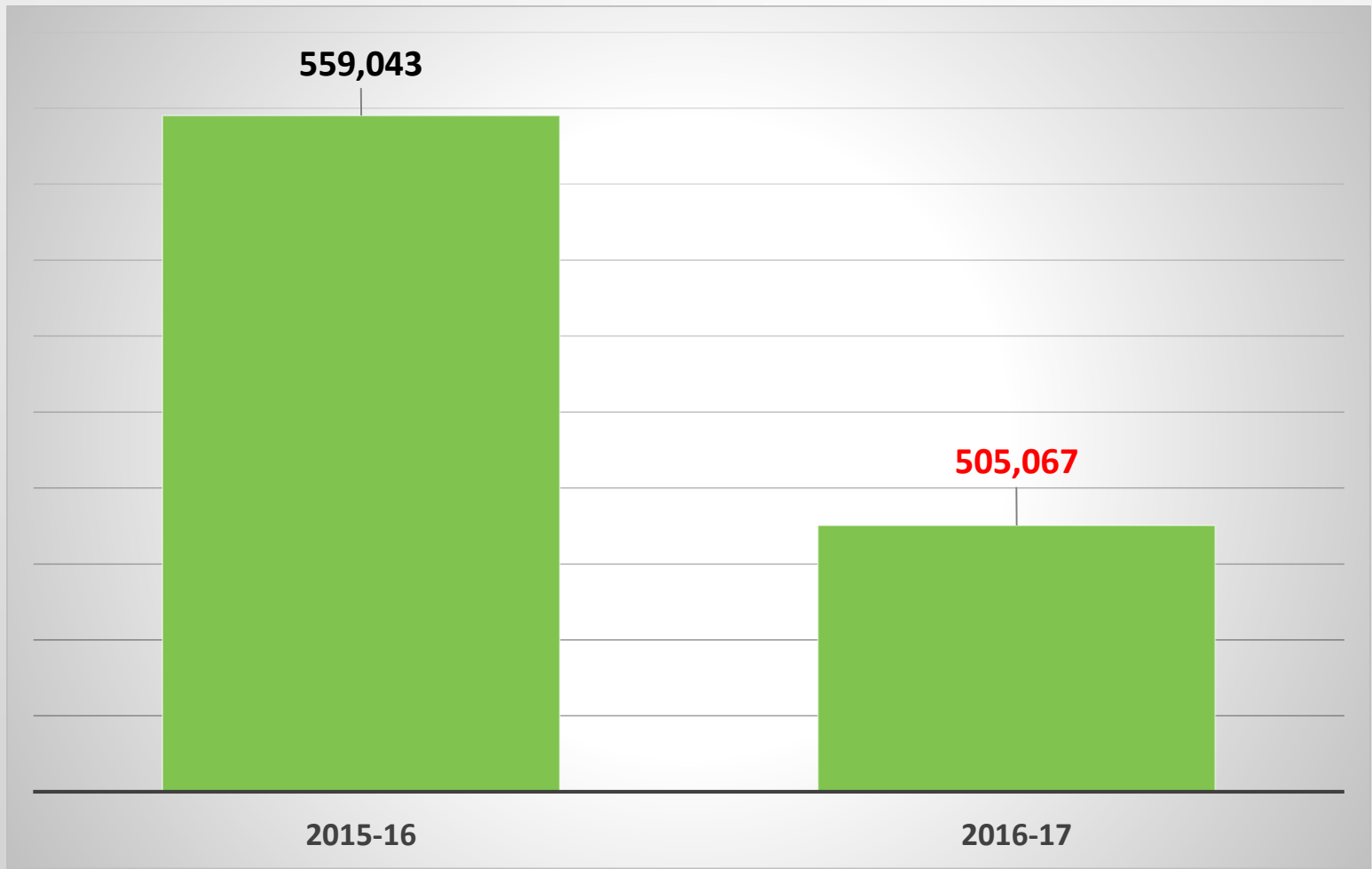


## SPORTS REVENUE DROP (2015-16 to 2016-17)

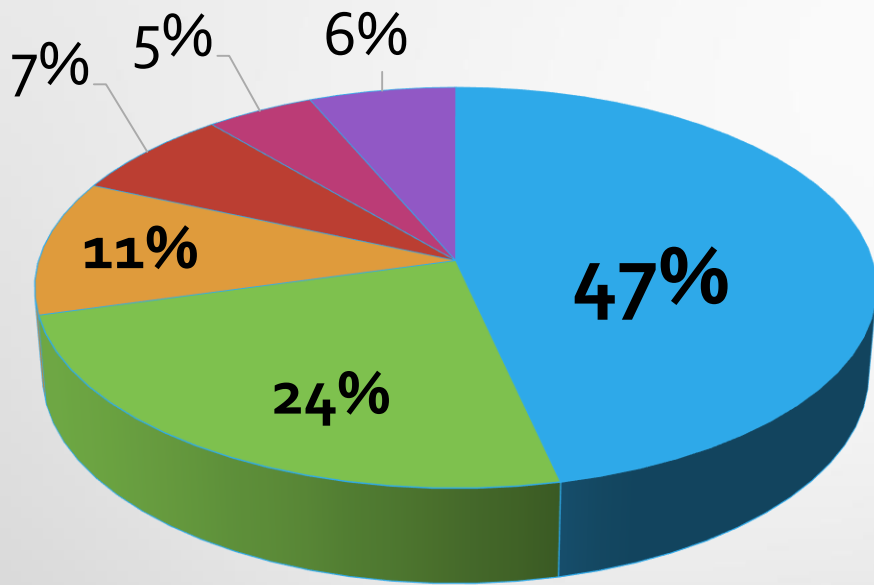

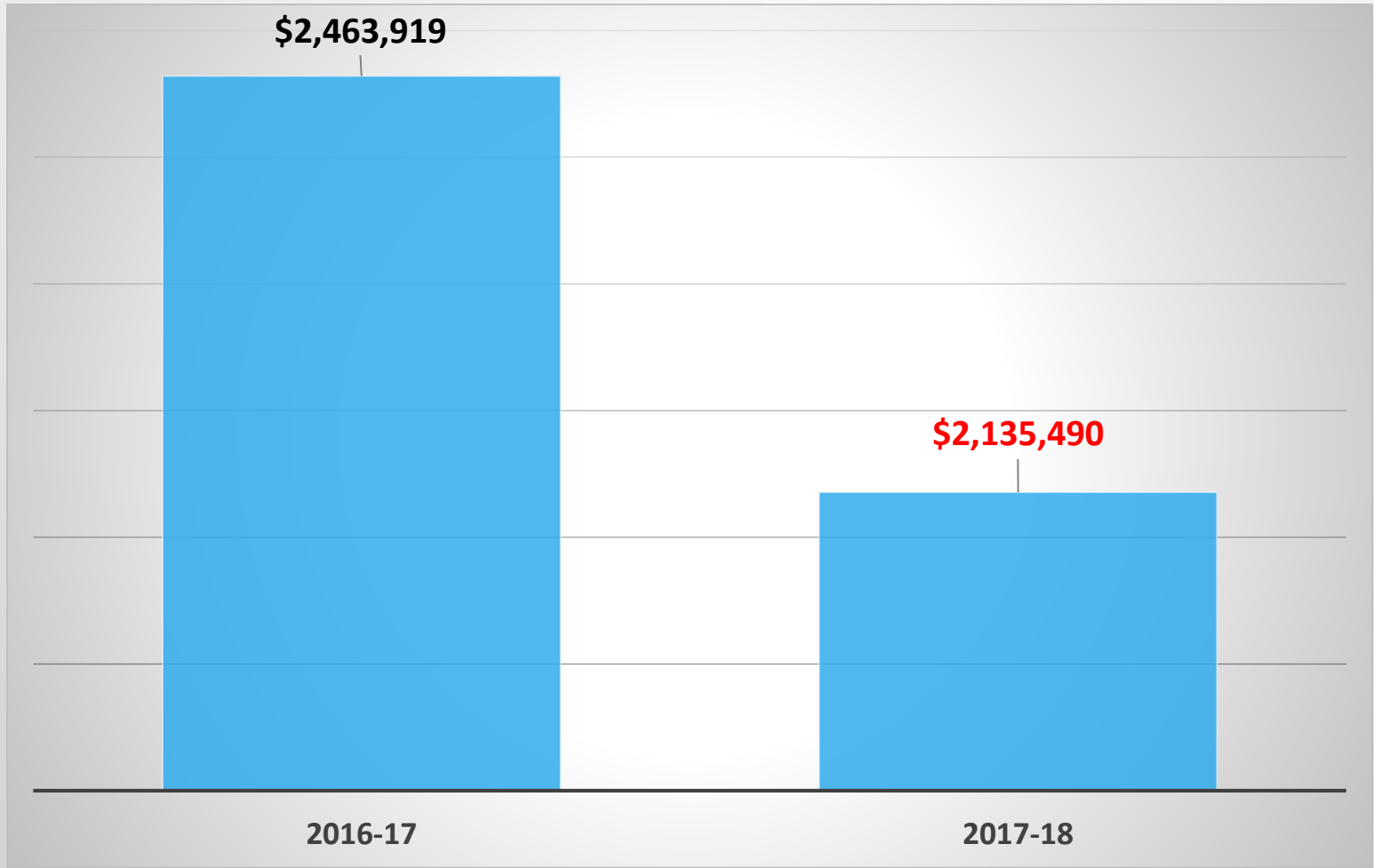

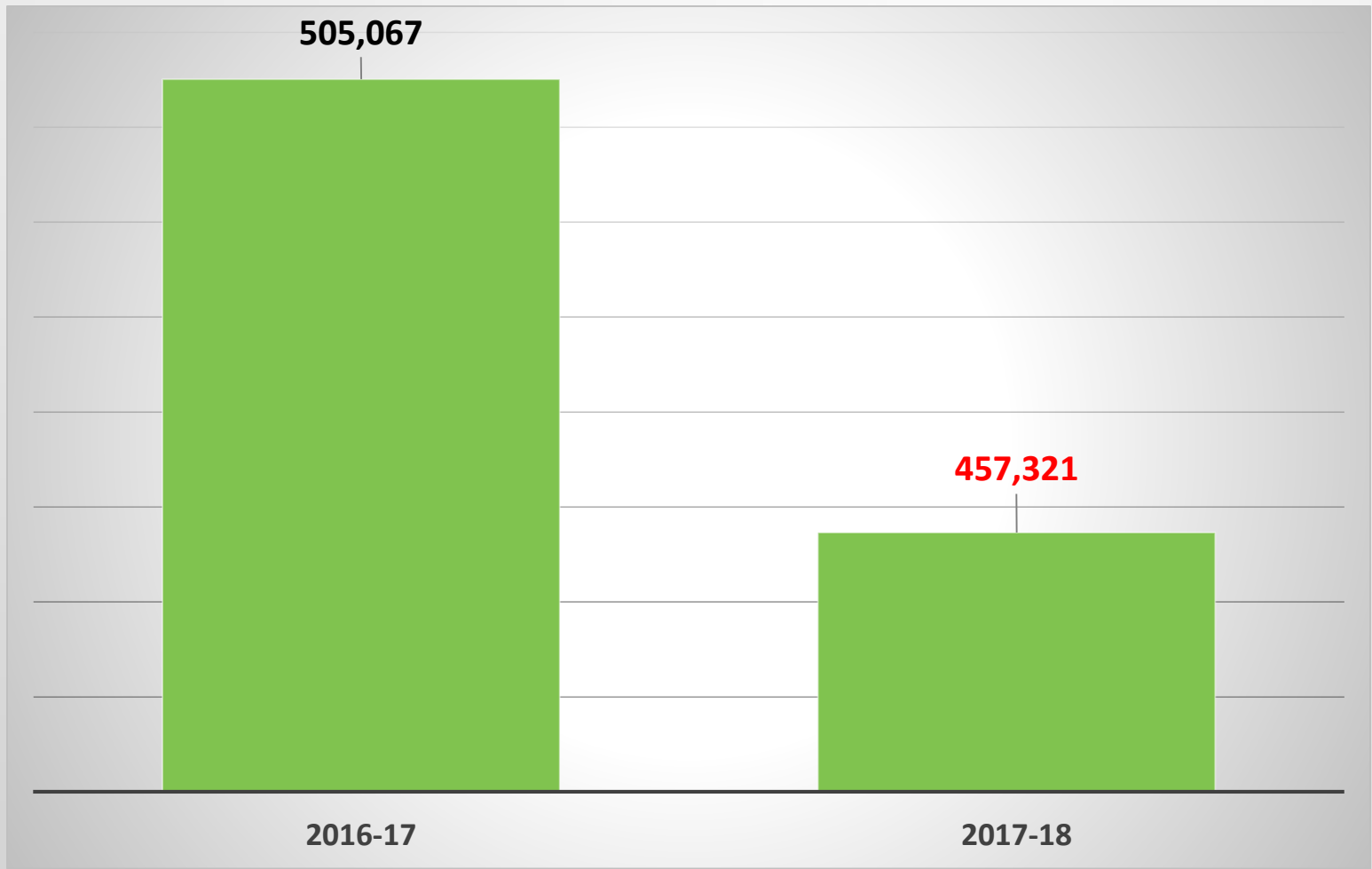

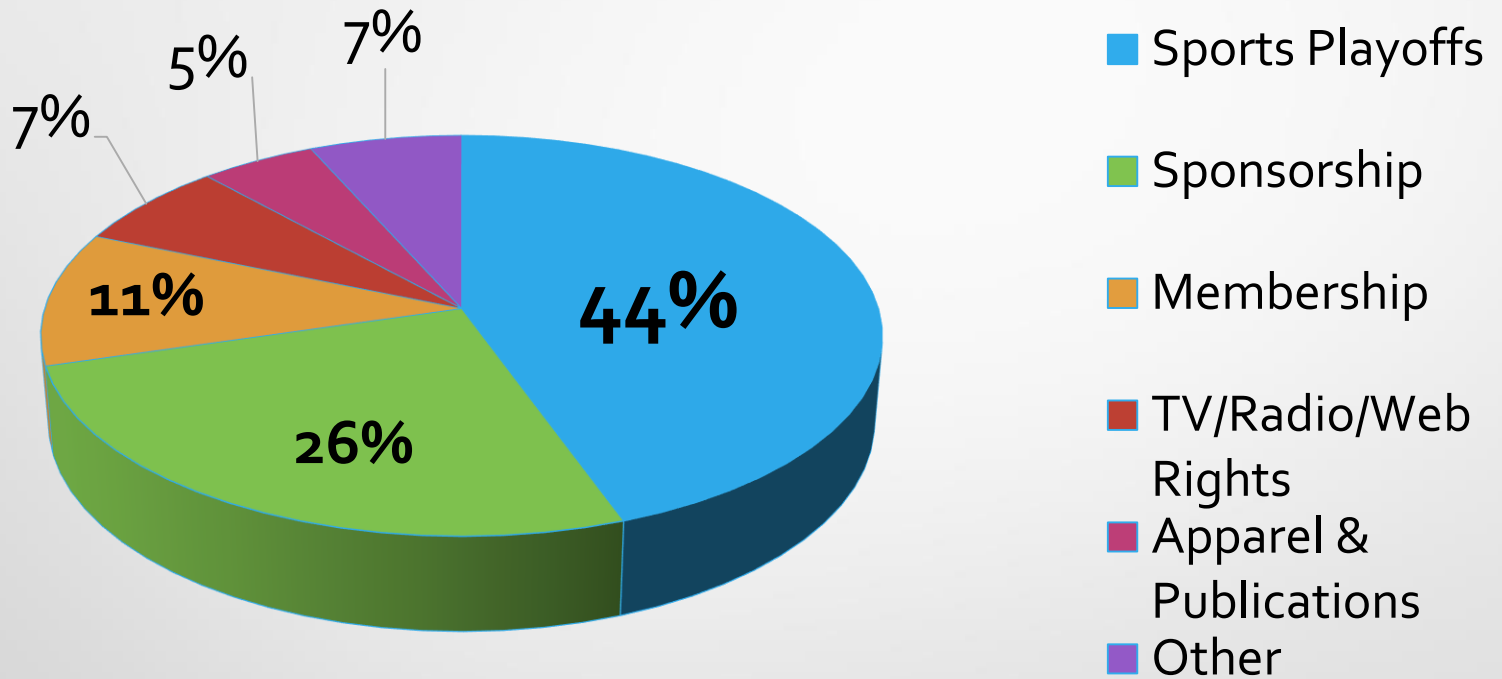

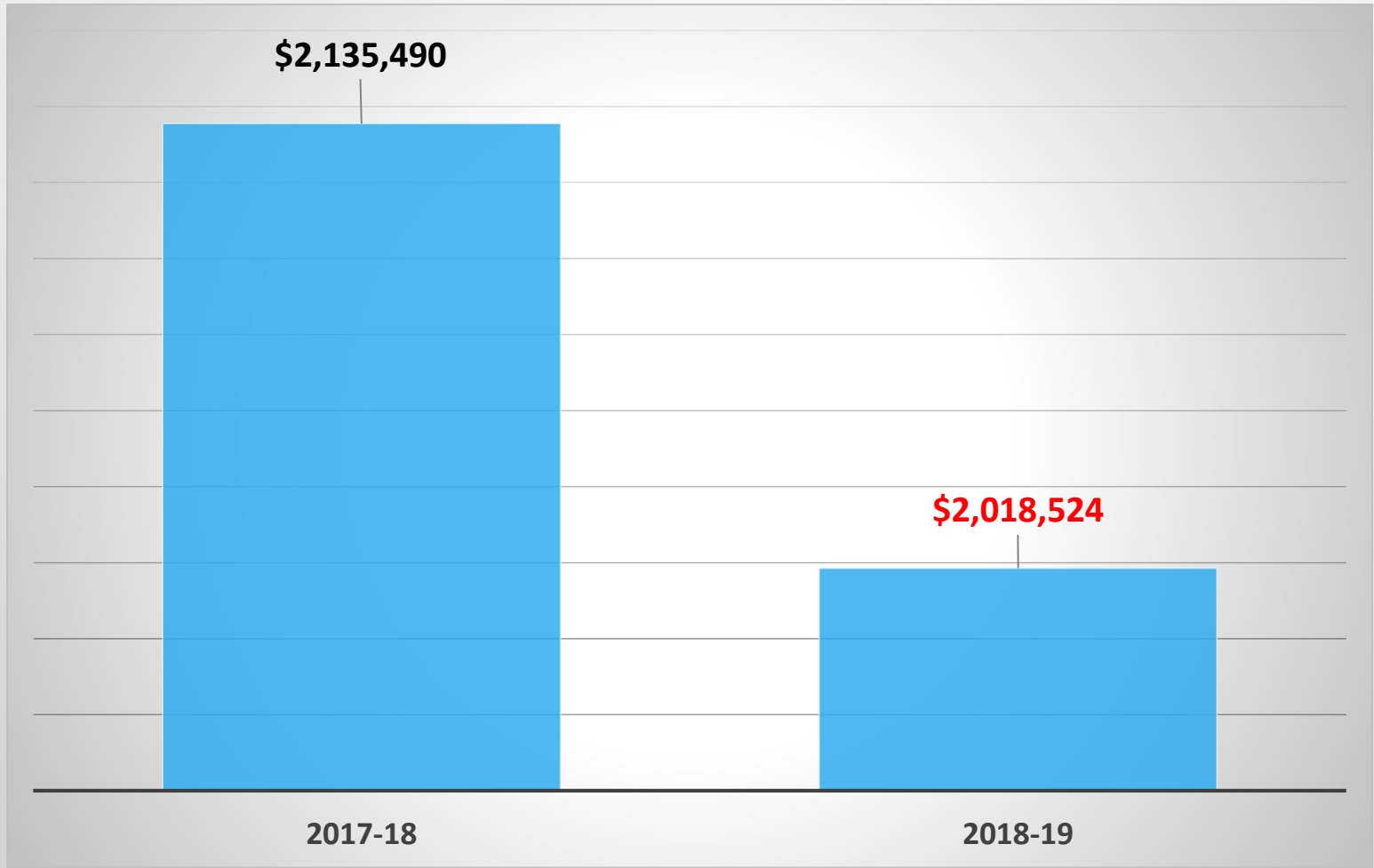

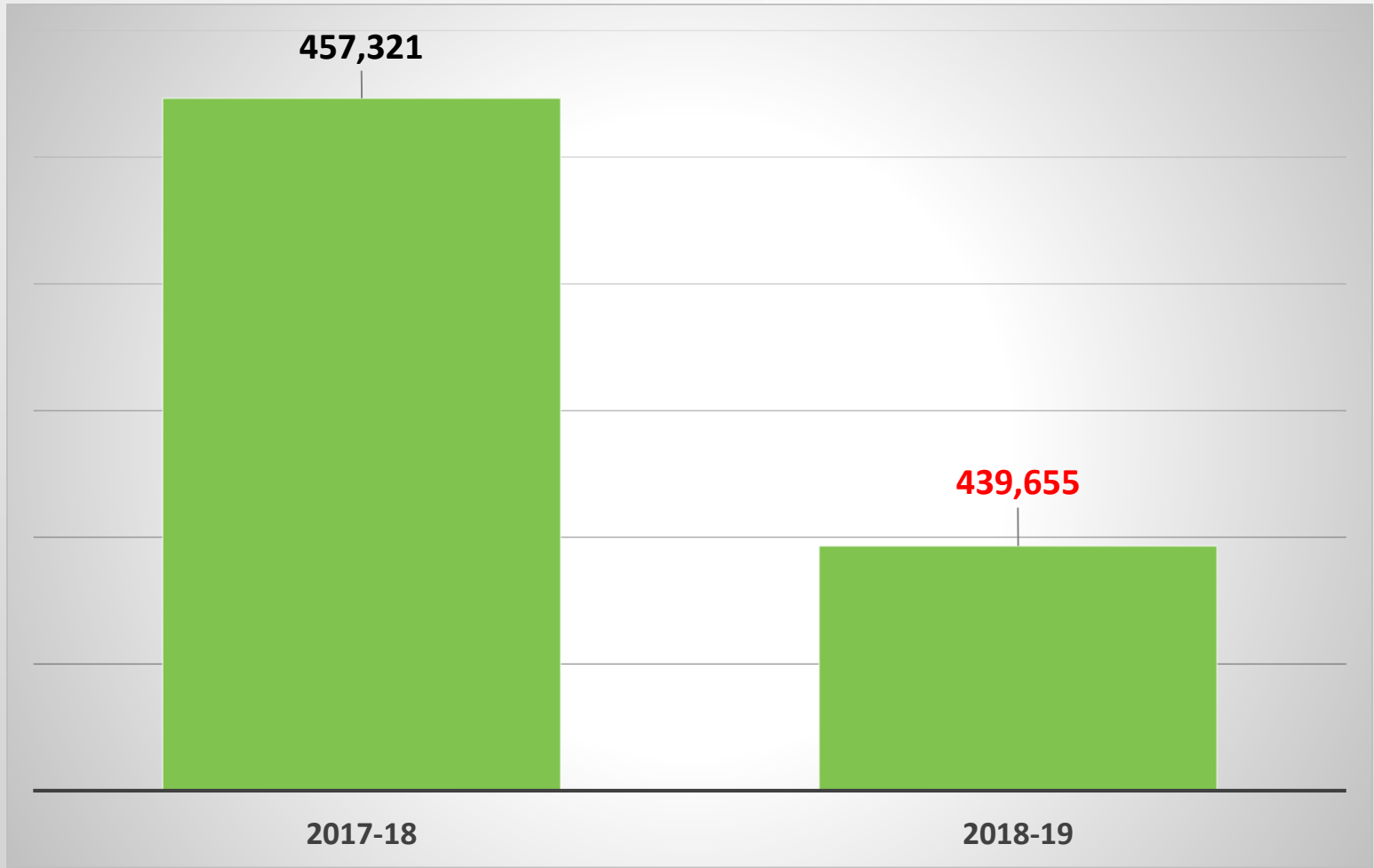
## SPORTS REVENUE DROP (2017-18 to 2018-19)

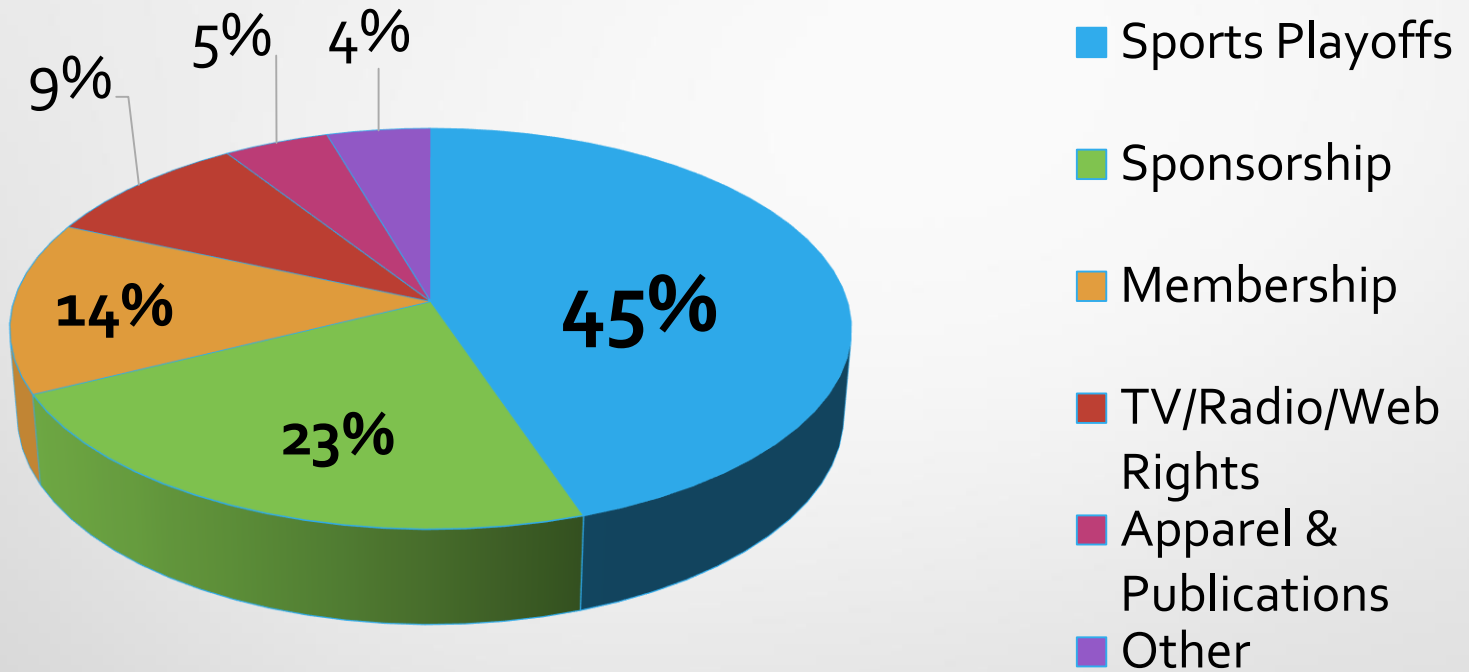

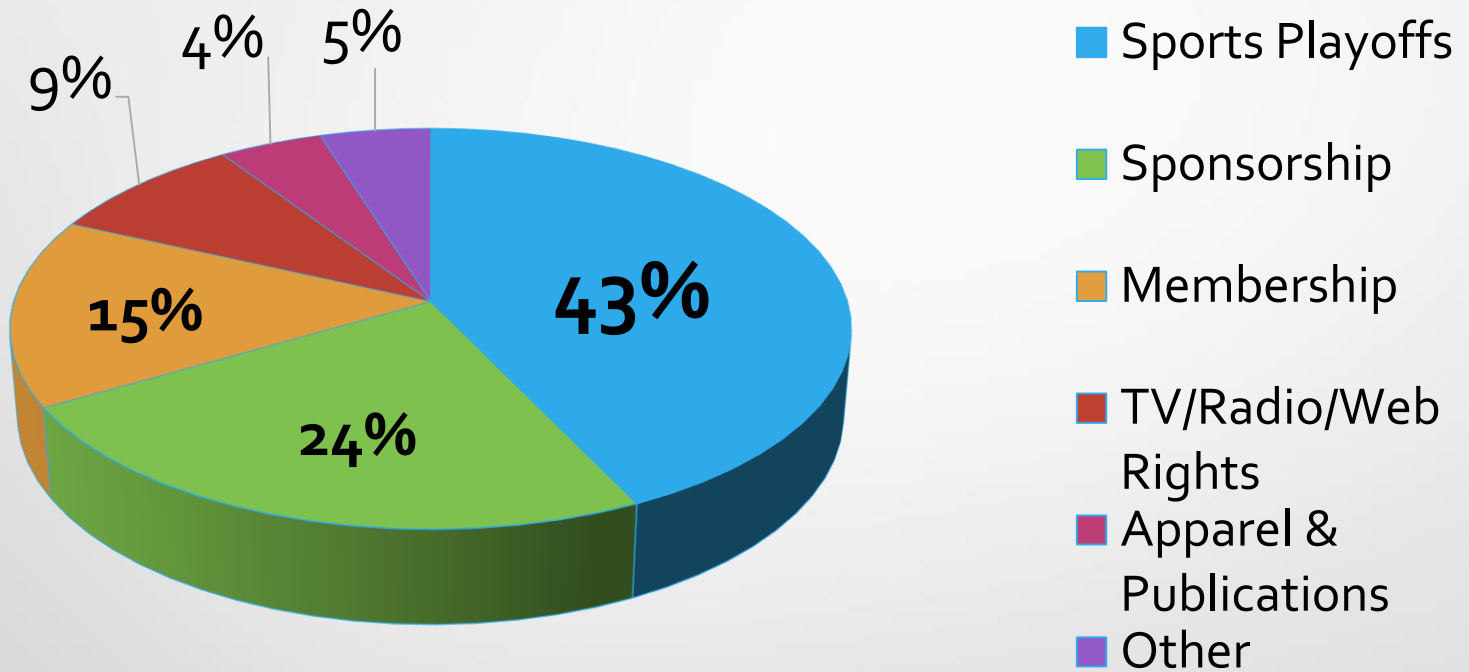

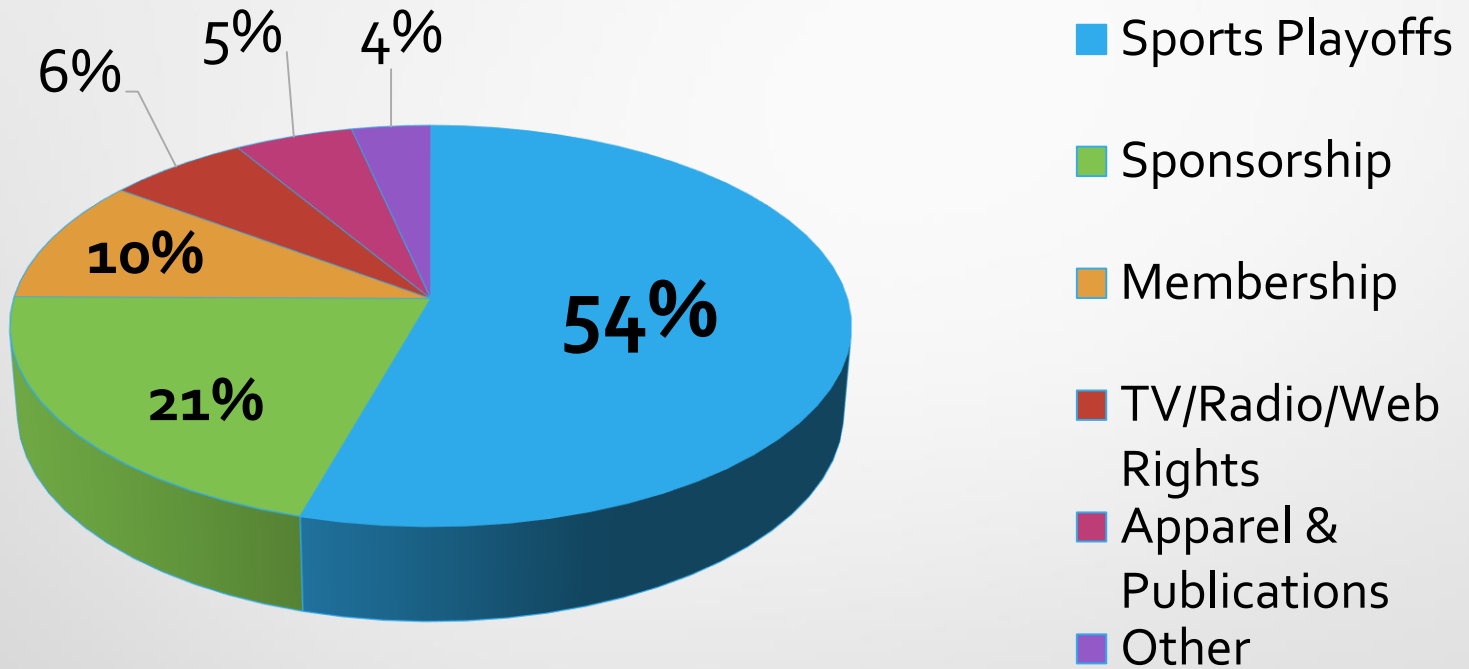
