1. Proposed 2021-2022 CIF State Budget

Exe. Comm. Voted STATE 621

to Support 20-0-0

President-Elect Jim Perry presented the CIF State Budget for review. The 2021-2022 Proposed Budget projects a surplus of \$30,000. The budget is highlighted by projected CIF Regional Baseball and Softball revenues and changes in Marketing revenue due to the fulfillment of contracts. The full proposed budget can be viewed at www.cifstate.org. There was a motion by the Big VIII League and a second by the Freeway League to approve the proposal as written. There being no discussion, the motion carried.

2. CIF State Executive Committee Nominations

Exe. Comm. Voted STATE 622 to Support 22-0-0

President-Elect Jim Perry presented the CIF State Executive Committee nominations and stated that two positions will be elected from the seven total candidates. These openings will begin with the 2021-2022 school year. President West requested the Council to allow the Southern Section delegates to go uninstructed to the April 23, 2021 Federated Council meeting. There was a motion by the Mission League and a second by the Southwestern League to approve the proposal as written. There being no discussion, the motion carried.

3. Proposed Bylaw 504.M Revision – Sunday Cheer Competition

Exe. Comm. Voted STATE 619 to Support 21-1-0

This proposal will allow Traditional Competitive Cheer teams to compete on Sunday at the National High School Cheerleading Championship (NHSCC) event. This exception may be used one time per school year for the above-named event only. There was a motion by the Coastal League and a second by the North Hills League to approve the proposal as written. Chief Financial Officer Mitch Carty presented the Council with Option 2, Best Case Scenario for the 2021-2022 school year. This is highlighted with sports revenue projections set toward conservative goals, sponsorship and broadcast contracts being fulfilled at 100% and sport fees to match the 2020-2021 school year. This proposal also includes the return of the full 17-member office staff, longevity steps and COLA increases, when revenue can support it, and the full return of employee benefits. There being no discussion, the motion carried.

The Coast Area and the Mt. SAC Area currently will have vacancies for the 2021-2022 school year. The candidates for Coast Area are Dr. Paula Hart Rodas, Principal, Lawndale High School and Dr. Allan Tyner, Principal, Palos Verdes High School.

For the Mt. SAC Area, the candidates are Paul Lopez, Director, Special Education/Health, Glendora Unified School District and Monica Principe, Director of Secondary Education, Pomona Unified School District. President West reminded the Council that only leagues in the affected areas will be voting for these nominees.

Paula Rodas was elected by a vote of 3-0-1 to represent the Coast Area for a four-year term beginning in the 2021-2022 school year.

Paul Lopez was elected by a vote of 5-2-0 to represent the Mr. SAC Area for a four-year term beginning in the 2021-2022 school year.

There are no CIF State Federated Council non-action items at this time.

B. SOUTHERN SECTION NON-ACTION ITEMS

There are no CIF Southern Section Council non-action items at this time.

A. Financial Report Mitch Carty

Chief Financial Officer Mitch Carty reported to the Council that 99% (\$716,000) of the sport fees have been received as of today. Current investment revenue over Quarter 3, Quarter 4 and Quarter 1 has been very strong totaling \$210,000 in revenue. In addition, we have received 79% of the marketing and broadcast payments for the 2020-2021 budget year, however \$0 in sport playoff revenue has been received. PPP Loan #1 in the amount of \$456,000 was utilized in July and August of 2020, vacation accrual usage by office staff continues and employee furloughs and benefit reductions are ongoing. Season 2 playoffs are currently being planned and some additional revenue is possible. The full office staff will be returning as of Monday, April 19, 2021. Based on the current projections and expenses Mr. Carty projected an expected loss of \$168, 687 for the 2020-2021 school year. PPP Loan #2 in the amount of \$388,000 has been received and this amount will go to offset the projected loss. This would leave \$219,000 to cover playoff expenses, and restoration of benefits lost, and other expenses.

B. Treasurer's Report

Chris Calderwood

Treasurer Chris Calderwood reported that 550 schools have paid the required membership dues as of today. That leaves nine schools with outstanding balances. Friends of Golf have donated \$23,500 all of which 100% of those funds will be distributed to member schools that have boys and girls golf programs. Finally, the annual audit for the 2019-2020 fiscal year was completed and submitted along with an outstanding audit report with no findings.

C. President's Report

Mike West

President Mike West took time to thank the CIF-Southern Section staff and leadership for all the efforts they have done to operate in such a successful way over the past year. President West wanted to remind all the members that the staff has taken pay cuts along with the loss of benefits in order to serve the member schools to the best of their abilities.




