## **IN-SEASON RANKINGS**

With the passage of the new competitive equity playoff system in January 2024 and changes to Bylaws 3519 and 3520 a weekly Top 10 poll will not be necessary. The playoff divisions will be created at the end of the regular season based on the current year's data.

It is <u>IMPERATIVE</u> that COACHES enter their full schedule and record results constantly throughout the season. Member schools who fail to accurately enter complete regular season results into the CIFSSHome system will not be placed into a playoff division and will be **INELIGIBLE** to participate in the Southern Section Championship playoffs.

Varsity matches are best 3 out of 5 pairs only. If a school, during the regular season, elects to play with only 3 pairs they elect to enter the match down 0 - 2.

Teams that earn an automatic entry into the playoffs through league play must have a five (5) pairs team.

At the half-way point of the season and then each week that follows until the end of the regular season on Wednesday, April 16<sup>th</sup> we will post in-season rankings of all Southern Section teams participating in girls' beach volleyball.

#### Mandatory Playoff Use Requirement:

The mandatory "official" ball rule for all playoff rounds, excluding golf. The rule applies throughout the conduct of <u>all</u> CIF-SS <u>playoff</u> contests.

\*Items in red are used in the final game for the CIF-SS Championships. Any model listed is approved for play in CIF-SS post season play.

#### Playoff Ball Use Rule Enforcement:

Should a school fail to provide the correct game ball, the game will always be played. Teams/schools failing to utilize the correct official ball in CIF-SS playoffs will be reported by officials to CIF-SS and will not be allowed to host their next available home playoff game. Penalty will carry over to the next season if not enforceable this season due to elimination.

Note: NFHS stamp is required in all sports except in golf, tennis and beach volleyball.

#### SUBJECT: CIF SOUTHERN SECTION BEACH VOLLEYBALL

#### DATE: December 15, 2022 (revised January 2025)

Below are several of the frequently questions I have received, along with my responses, which I hope will be useful to you as you make your decisions on forming a program. If you have additional questions, please feel free to contact me and I am happy to assist you.

- What will constitute a beach volleyball team? A minimum of 5 pairs team. That will indicate to our office that your school has registered for Beach Volleyball this school year.
- 2. What format of competition will be used for league and/or CIF postseason? League competition will be up to individual leagues. The CIF Southern Section Beach Volleyball Team Championship Tournament will be conducted like other bracketed sports. The format will be played best 3 out of 5 matches wins the head-to-head competition. A school will need to field <u>5 pairs at the varsity level to participate in the team playoff competition.</u>
- 3. Will there be a CIF Southern Section playoff this year? Yes. We plan to offer a team championship in two divisions and an individual pairs championship in one division possibly two. A third division team championship may be offered if the number of schools participating in Beach Volleyball increases.
- 4. Does playing CIF beach volleyball take away the ability to play club beach volleyball? No. Like Cross Country and Track & Field student-athletes, Beach Volleyball players will be allowed to compete for their high school and club at the same time following CIF Bylaw 600.G (unattached competition). During the designated high school Beach Volleyball season, a student or pair who wish to participate in a non-CIF Beach Volleyball event would need to do so as an unattached participant, meaning they could not represent their high school, club or any other organization. For example, they would need to enter as "Sally Smith" and "Jenny Jones".
- 5. How many players can a school have on its beach volleyball team?

That is up to each individual school. More established schools may have several pairs of players and could have more than one level (Frosh, JV, Varsity), while some schools may only have one or two pairs and one level.

7. Is there an official beach volleyball that must be used for high school competition at this time?

Yes. The CIF-Southern Section has partnered with Wilson and we have adopted the NCAA OPTX for use in all playoffs (team and individual).

## CIF SOUTHERN SECTION GIRLS BEACH VOLLEYBALL OFFICIALS INFORMATION

1. Are officials available and required?

Currently officials are available, and more are being trained to officiate beach volleyball. Depending on the request of the school your local assignor will work with the Southern California Volleyball Officials Association to provide you with either a "monitor" or a true R1 and R2 for head-to-head contests. Currently officials are not required but strongly encouraged to officiate beach competition. A "monitor" for a beach competition either head-to-head or tournament will be used similar to a high school tennis competition.

## **GUIDELINES FOR WARM-UP PROCEDURES (PRE-MATCH)**

Playing Area - Referee (50 minutes)

- 1. One hour before the competition, the official with the assistance of the home team, must confirm that the dimensions as well as the quality and safety of the boundary lines and all other sport equipment, meet the requirements.
- 2. Before the start of the Referee must check: The net is perpendicular to the court and the dimensions of the boundary lines and free zone are accurate.
  - a. Note: In a square court (8m x 8m for one side), the length of the short diagonals (11.31 meters) must be equal.
- 3. The playing area, sand condition and sport equipment are safe for the players and officials.
  - a. Note: Boundary lines must be properly secured and present no danger to players. Exposed hooks, metal fastening devices or spikes to hold the lines in place are not acceptable.
- 4. Prior to each match officiated, before the warmup time, inspect the court and free zone area checking its symmetry, safety, and general condition.

- a. Note: Before/during the match, the Referee must pay attention to the fact, that the free zone must always be free from any obstacle which can cause an injury to a team member (drinking bottles, TV camera tripods, sand rakes, etc.).
- 5. The playing court is maintained by the sand rakes who are responsible for raking it before, during the game, between sets, and between matches.
  - a. Note: The referee is responsible to check that this is done properly and together with the host school, and they should continuously monitor during the match the condition of the lines and the playing court, ensuring that both courts are in equal condition.

Net & Post - Referee must check:

- 6. The height of the net must be as per Rule.
  - a. Note: Before each match, after the sand has been rake, the referee must check the height of the net before the coin toss.
- 7. The net, posts and referee's stand are properly padded so that a player is not a risk of injury from exposed hard or sharp surfaces.
  - a. Notes: Before/during the game (and especially at the beginning of each set), must check whether the side bands are exactly perpendicular to the playing surface and placed directly above each sideline and whether the antennae are just at the outer edge of each side band. If this is not the case, they should be readjusted immediately.

Balls – Referee must check that:

8. The referee takes possession of the match balls before the match and checks that all of them have identical characteristics (color, circumference, weight, and pressure).

Scoresheet – Referee must check that:

- 9. Educating and training players on the proper completion of AVP scoresheets.
- 10. Correct scoresheet and results entry errors (working with the players to do so).

Formal Warm-Up Protocol: (10 minutes)

- 11. Ten minutes are allowed for warm-up. Formally, this period includes one minute to conduct the coin toss with a player representative from each competing pairs team and eight minutes of formal timed warm-up.
  - 10 Coin toss
  - 9 Start eight-minute formal timed warm-up (coaches must leave the playing court)
  - 1 End warm-up, teams to pre-determined team area, referee(s) to designated location
  - 0 Teams to end-lines (respective to team area)

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## HEALTH AND SAFETY

It is the expectation of the CIF Southern Section that your Athletic Coaches and Administration will take every measure to ensure the health and safety of your student athletes.

The following are key points of emphasis coaches should review with their staff and players in reference to CIF Southern Section rules and regulations in the 2024-2025 CIF Southern Section Blue Book. This list is not all-inclusive but only highlights key areas. ## **PHYSICAL EXAMINATION**

An annual physical examination, or a statement by a medical practitioner, is required for a student to take part in any authorized school practice session and/or pre-season conditioning period. This physical examination will be valid for a period of one year from the date of the examination. A student will be excused from this physical examination only if there is compliance with the Education Code (parent's refusal to consent). CIF Health and Safety Committee strongly recommends schools use the Pre-Participation Examination form that is endorsed by five major medical societies; American Academy of Family Physicians, American Academy of Pediatrics, American Medical Society for Sports Medicine, American orthopedic Sports Medicine and the American osteopathic Academy of Sports Medicine. All CIF schools must have school board approved forms.

## **CONCUSSION PROTOCOL**

A student athlete who is suspected of sustaining a concussion or head injury in a practice or game shall be removed from competition at the time for the remainder of the day. A student-athlete who has been removed from play may not return to play until the athlete is evaluated by a licensed health care provider trained in education and management of concussion and receives written clearance to return to play from that health care provider. If a licensed health care provider, trained in education and management of concussion determines that the athlete sustained a concussion or a head injury, the athlete is required to complete a graduated return to play protocol of no less than seven (7) full days from the time of diagnosis under the supervision of a licensed heath care provider. On a yearly basis, a concussion and head injury information sheet shall be signed and returned by all athletes and the athlete's parent/guardian/caregiver before the athlete's initial practice or competition. (Approved May 2010 Federated Council/Revised January 2015 Federated Council)

Answer: the "scope of practice" for licensed health care providers and medical professionals is defined by California state statutes. This scope of practice will limit the evaluation to a medical doctor (MD) or doctor of osteopathy (DO).

## SUDDEN CARDIAC ARREST PROTOCOL

A student-athlete who passes out or faints while participating in, or immediately following, an athletic activity or who is known to have passed out or fainted while participating in or immediately following an athletic activity, must be removed immediately from participating in a practice or game for the remainder of the day. A student-athlete who has been removed from play after displaying signs and symptoms associated with sudden cardiac arrest may not return to play until the athlete is evaluated by a licensed health care provider and receives written clearance to return to play from that health care provider. On a yearly basis, a Sudden Cardiac Arrest information sheet shall be signed and returned by all athletes and the athlete's parent/guardian/caregiver before the athlete's initial practice or competition.
