

The following information is designed to update you on the current situation related to the 2022-2026 Releaguing Cycle. Attached to this communication are the completed Releaguing Plans, as approved, by each of the 9 areas within our section. Here are the processes and timelines moving forward...

- June 15, 2021 Area Releaguing plans due to the CIF Southern Section Office by 4:00 p.m. (Already submitted by all areas, see attached.)
- July 29, 2021 Schools wishing to appeal their placement into a particular league must send written notice of appeal to the CIF Southern Section Office by 4:00 p.m.

NOTE: Schools wishing to appeal their placement into a particular league must confine their appeal to their own school's placement into that league. Appeals will not be heard regarding placement of another school into the league the appellant school has been placed into. Schools who are appealing must also offer an alternative placement for their school into another league as part of their appeal.)

- August 12, 2021 – The CIF Southern Section Executive Committee will hear all initial appeals regarding Releaguing criteria and process. The Executive Committee may accept the appeal, in which case the Releaguing Chair for the respective area will re-convene the area schools to consider suggestions from the Executive Committee and possibly make changes to the original proposal. The Executive Committee shall make no recommendations or approve alternative appeal configurations. (Releaguing Appeals Procedures #1, 2020-2021 CIF Southern Section Blue Book, page 36.)

If a proposal is remanded back to its area, the area must re-consider and vote on a configuration. The configuration will be forwarded to all member schools in that area. (Releaguing Appeals Procedures #2, 2020-2021 CIF Southern Section Blue Book, page 36.)

- September 23, 2021 CIF Southern Section Executive Committee meeting. The Executive Committee will review any changes to Area Releaguing Proposals made by said areas as a result of appeals upheld in August and will move those affected proposals forward to the CIF Southern Section Council.
- September 30, 2021 CIF Southern Section Council approves Releaguing Proposals and hears final appeals relative to process. The 2022-2026 Releaguing Process is concluded.

The following information is designed to help you prepare for your Releaguing Appeal scheduled for the CIF Southern Section Executive Committee meeting on Thursday, August 12, 2021. We will be sending you an agenda soon for that day's meeting, which will begin at 1:00 pm, and that agenda will include your Releaguing Appeal being heard that day.

In preparation for your appeal hearing, here is some information to help you.

1) Your appeal hearing is scheduled for a maximum of 15 minutes. That will include the presentations, questions from the Executive Committee, open deliberation by that body and the vote to accept or not accept the appeal.

Note: If you wish to have PowerPoint as part of your presentation, we do have the capability for you to present it in our conference room. You may bring your own laptop if you wish, or we have one available here if you prefer, just let me know what you wish to do.

- 2) In terms of format for the appeal hearings, here are the guidelines...
 - A) As the appellant, you will make your presentation first and present the rationale behind your appeal of your area's decision to place your school into the league you have been placed into for the 2022-2024 Releaguing Cycle. Your presentation must focus on the three criteria of competitive equity, school enrollment and geography, as listed in the 2020-2021 CIF Southern Section Blue Book on page 36.

<u>NOTE:</u> Schools wishing to appeal their placement into a particular league must confine their appeal to their own school's placement into that particular league. Appeals will not be heard regarding placement of another school into the league the appellant school has been placed into.)

B) A representative from your area will follow your presentation focusing on the processes followed by your area and the criteria from the Blue Book referenced above. After both presentations, the Executive Committee will have the opportunity to ask questions and/or seek more clarification.

- C) After all presentations are finished and all questions answered, a member of the Executive Committee will make a motion to accept the appeal, that motion will be seconded and then discussion will be held.
- D) After discussion is concluded, there will be a vote on the motion. The vote to accept the appeal or not accept the appeal will be taken and the result of that vote will be final.
- E) The entire appeal hearing, from beginning to end, including the deliberation and vote of the Executive Committee, will be open to you and the decision will be made in your presence.

- August 12, 2021 – The CIF Southern Section Executive Committee will hear all initial appeals regarding Releaguing criteria and process. The Executive Committee may accept the appeal, in which case the Releaguing Chair for the respective area will re-convene the area schools to consider suggestions from the Executive Committee and possibly make changes to the original Releaguing Plan or may not accept the appeal. The Executive Committee shall make no recommendations or approve alternative appeal configurations. (Releaguing Appeals Procedures #1, 2020-2021 CIF Southern Section Blue Book, page 36.)

If a Releaguing Plan is remanded back to its area, the area must re-consider and vote on a configuration. The configuration will be forwarded to all member schools in that area. (Releaguing Appeals Procedures #2, 2020-2021 CIF Southern Section Blue Book, page 36.)

- September 23, 2021 CIF Southern Section Executive Committee meeting. The Executive Committee will review any changes to Area Releaguing Plans made by said areas as a result of appeals accepted on August 12 and will move those affected plans forward to the CIF Southern Section Council.
- September 30, 2021 CIF Southern Section Council approves Releaguing Plans and hears final appeals relative to process. The 2022-2024 Releaguing Process is concluded.

Advocation Points:

- The Centinela Valley Union High School District schools want a status quo of our current league alignment with the purpose of data collection over the course of non-distance learning schedules. The current leagues were created with an attempt to create competitive equity among all leagues and we have yet to have a chance to analyze the data as to whether that holds true.
- Da Vinci's addition to the Coastal Area necessitates their addition to one of the league's in the Coastal area

School Size

- WDV Athletics is composed of five member schools which have a combined enrollment of 1,933
 high school students. The schools include Da Vinci Science (577), Da Vinci Design (538), Da Vinci
 Communications (528), Da Vinci Rise (218), and Da Vinci Connect (72).
- Average school size in the Bay League is 2,426.
- Average school size in the Ocean League is 1,296.

Competitive Equity (please see attached data)

- This is our primary reason for our appeal to be placed in the Ocean League.
- The attached sheet has the break down by individual sport by playoff division.
- Our average division placement across our sports is division 5 for boys and girls sports.
- The average playoff divisions for the other schools in the Bay League are D1 and D2. This puts us last in the league by a difference of 3 for both boys and girls.
- The average playoff division in the Ocean League is D4. For girls, Morningside averages division 5. For boys Leuzinger, Beverly Hills and Centennial average division 3.
- We currently offer 8 sports (8 each for boys and girls). We don't have, water polo, tennis, golf, Lacrosse or football.
- Most schools in the Bay League offer all sports.
- Beverly Hills is the only team in the Ocean League that offers all sports. The other schools in the Ocean League are similar to the WDV program offering only certain sports.

Geography (please see attached map)

- Although we are centrally located in the area made up of the three leagues in the SBAA, placement in the Bay League results in more travel time for our student athletes.
- In the Bay League, Palos Verdes, Peninsula, and Santa Monica are all over 10 miles away.
- In the Ocean league, only Beverly Hills is more than 10 miles way. Leuzinger, Hawthorne, Inglewood and Morningside are 5 miles or less from the WDV schools.



The following information is designed to help you prepare for your Releaguing Appeal scheduled for the CIF Southern Section Executive Committee meeting on Thursday, August 12, 2021. We will be sending you an agenda soon for that day's meeting, which will begin at 1:00 pm, and that agenda will include your Releaguing Appeal being heard that day.

In preparation for your appeal hearing, here is some information to help you.

1) Your appeal hearing is scheduled for a maximum of 15 minutes. That will include the presentations, questions from the Executive Committee, open deliberation by that body and the vote to accept or not accept the appeal.

Note: If you wish to have PowerPoint as part of your presentation, we do have the capability for you to present it in our conference room. You may bring your own laptop if you wish, or we have one available here if you prefer, just let me know what you wish to do.

- 2) In terms of format for the appeal hearings, here are the guidelines...
 - A) As the appellant, you will make your presentation first and present the rationale behind your appeal of your area's decision to place your school into the league you have been placed into for the 2022-2024 Releaguing Cycle. Your presentation must focus on the three criteria of competitive equity, school enrollment and geography, as listed in the 2020-2021 CIF Southern Section Blue Book on page 36.

<u>NOTE:</u> Schools wishing to appeal their placement into a particular league must confine their appeal to their own school's placement into that particular league. Appeals will not be heard regarding placement of another school into the league the appellant school has been placed into.)

B) A representative from your area will follow your presentation focusing on the processes followed by your area and the criteria from the Blue Book referenced above. After both presentations, the Executive Committee will have the opportunity to ask questions and/or seek more clarification.

- C) After all presentations are finished and all questions answered, a member of the Executive Committee will make a motion to accept the appeal, that motion will be seconded and then discussion will be held.
- D) After discussion is concluded, there will be a vote on the motion. The vote to accept the appeal or not accept the appeal will be taken and the result of that vote will be final.
- E) The entire appeal hearing, from beginning to end, including the deliberation and vote of the Executive Committee, will be open to you and the decision will be made in your presence.

Here are the relevant timelines moving forward...

- August 12, 2021 – The CIF Southern Section Executive Committee will hear all initial appeals regarding Releaguing criteria and process. The Executive Committee may accept the appeal, in which case the Releaguing Chair for the respective area will re-convene the area schools to consider suggestions from the Executive Committee and possibly make changes to the original Releaguing Plan or may not accept the appeal. The Executive Committee shall make no recommendations or approve alternative appeal configurations. (Releaguing Appeals Procedures #1, 2020-2021 CIF Southern Section Blue Book, page 36.)

If a Releaguing Plan is remanded back to its area, the area must re-consider and vote on a configuration. The configuration will be forwarded to all member schools in that area. (Releaguing Appeals Procedures #2, 2020-2021 CIF Southern Section Blue Book, page 36.)

- September 23, 2021 CIF Southern Section Executive Committee meeting. The Executive Committee will review any changes to Area Releaguing Plans made by said areas as a result of appeals accepted on August 12 and will move those affected plans forward to the CIF Southern Section Council.
- September 30, 2021 CIF Southern Section Council approves Releaguing Plans and hears final appeals relative to process. The 2022-2024 Releaguing Process is concluded.

The following information is designed to help you prepare for your Releaguing Appeal scheduled for the CIF Southern Section Executive Committee meeting on Thursday, August 12, 2021. We will be sending you an agenda soon for that day's meeting, which will begin at 1:00 pm, and that agenda will include your Releaguing Appeal being heard that day.

In preparation for your appeal hearing, here is some information to help you.

1) Your appeal hearing is scheduled for a maximum of 15 minutes. That will include the presentations, questions from the Executive Committee, open deliberation by that body and the vote to accept or not accept the appeal.

Note: If you wish to have PowerPoint as part of your presentation, we do have the capability for you to present it in our conference room. You may bring your own laptop if you wish, or we have one available here if you prefer, just let me know what you wish to do.

- 2) In terms of format for the appeal hearings, here are the guidelines...
 - A) As the appellant, you will make your presentation first and present the rationale behind your appeal of your area's decision to place your school into the league you have been placed into for the 2022-2024 Releaguing Cycle. Your presentation must focus on the three criteria of competitive equity, school enrollment and geography, as listed in the 2020-2021 CIF Southern Section Blue Book on page 36.

NOTE: Schools wishing to appeal their placement into a particular league must confine their appeal to their own school's placement into that particular league. Appeals will not be heard regarding placement of another school into the league the appellant school has been placed into.)

B) A representative from your area will follow your presentation focusing on the processes followed by your area and the criteria from the Blue Book referenced above. After both presentations, the Executive Committee will have the opportunity to ask questions and/or seek more clarification.

- C) After all presentations are finished and all questions answered, a member of the Executive Committee will make a motion to accept the appeal, that motion will be seconded and then discussion will be held.
- D) After discussion is concluded, there will be a vote on the motion. The vote to accept the appeal or not accept the appeal will be taken and the result of that vote will be final.
- E) The entire appeal hearing, from beginning to end, including the deliberation and vote of the Executive Committee, will be open to you and the decision will be made in your presence.

Here are the relevant timelines moving forward...

- August 12, 2021 – The CIF Southern Section Executive Committee will hear all initial appeals regarding Releaguing criteria and process. The Executive Committee may accept the appeal, in which case the Releaguing Chair for the respective area will re-convene the area schools to consider suggestions from the Executive Committee and possibly make changes to the original Releaguing Plan or may not accept the appeal. The Executive Committee shall make no recommendations or approve alternative appeal configurations. (Releaguing Appeals Procedures #1, 2020-2021 CIF Southern Section Blue Book, page 36.)

If a Releaguing Plan is remanded back to its area, the area must re-consider and vote on a configuration. The configuration will be forwarded to all member schools in that area. (Releaguing Appeals Procedures #2, 2020-2021 CIF Southern Section Blue Book, page 36.)

- September 23, 2021 CIF Southern Section Executive Committee meeting. The Executive Committee will review any changes to Area Releaguing Plans made by said areas as a result of appeals accepted on August 12 and will move those affected plans forward to the CIF Southern Section Council.
- September 30, 2021 CIF Southern Section Council approves Releaguing Plans and hears final appeals relative to process. The 2022-2024 Releaguing Process is concluded.




