Determination of Playoff Divisions – Water Polo

With the passage of the new competitive equity playoff system (CIFSS Council, January 2024), and changes to Bylaws 3519 and 3520, the way we group playoff divisions has changed. To summarize, playoff divisions will be created at the end of the regular season based on a team's current win/loss data.

It is imperative that coaches/athletic directors enter their full schedule, and score results consistently throughout the season. Member schools who fail to accurately enter complete regular season results into the CIFSSHome system will not be placed into a playoff division and will be ineligible to participate in the Southern Section Championship Playoff Tournament.

Schools (via the coach and/or AD email) have been getting updates of missing scores throughout the season. Those vacancies must be filled. Schools tend to use "TBA" as opponent names in tournament situations as placeholders. Please review your results carefully, entering actual tournament opponents played and the game scores. Please look through your schedule and scores on CIFSSHome (not another platform) as all data retrieval will be from CIFSSHome.

Massey Ratings, the same power ranking system the CIFSS has used in various sports since 2014, will continue to be used. The only thing changing is the timeframe of data used to feed this system. Previously, the two most recent year's results would feed Massey Ratings for pre-season divisional placement. Now, only the current year will be used for in-season divisional placement. The benefit of this is being placed in a division based on the accolades of the team a school currently has, rather than the success of the team in the two previous years.

Selection of Open Division Teams

Eight teams will be chosen at the end of the regular season for the Open Division Championship. This tournament bracket will be played in a “pool play” game format. Teams will play through their pool, with the fourth-place team in each group being dropped and the first-place team securing their position in the semi-final game. The second and third-place finishers in each bracket will cross over (2A vs. 3B and 2B vs. 3A), with the winners advancing to the semifinals. If a tie-breaking procedure is needed to determine the winner in any pool, 1) Goal differential, 2) Goals allowed, and 3) Goals scored will be used (in that order).

Criteria for selection of CIF-SS open division teams and seeding

The CIFSS formed a committee to make decisions regarding Open Division competition (such as the number of teams and playoff format). Current members of the water polo advisory board represent that group. Per CIF bylaw, the power ranking system, water polo has had it in place since 2014, will drive the selection and determine the seed of the eight teams in the Open Division.

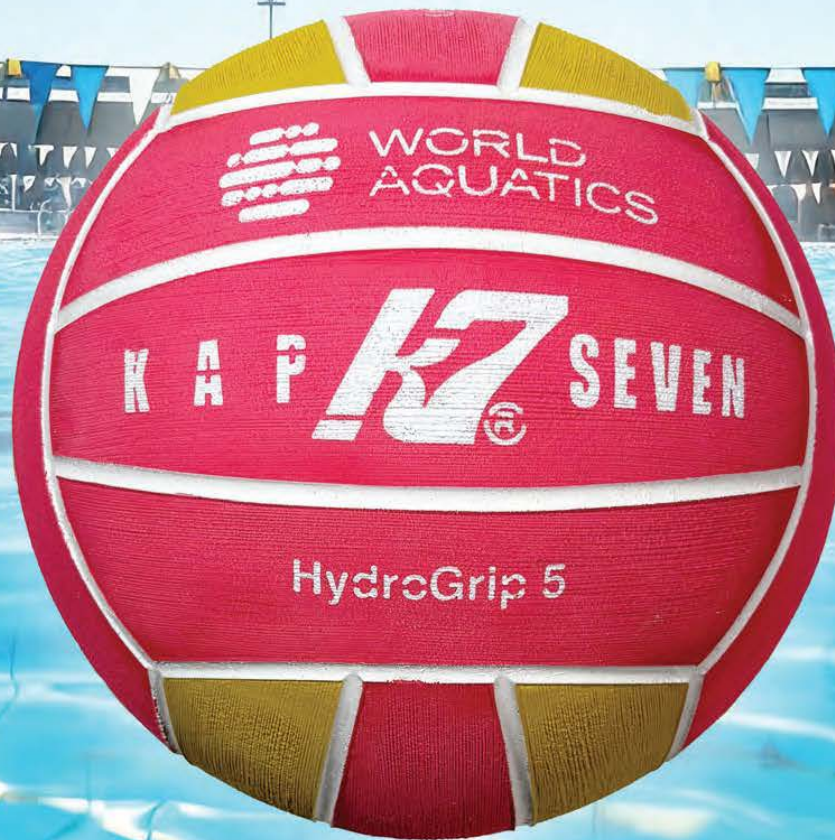

CIFSSHOME REQUIREMENTS

SCHEDULES & SCORES Complete your schedule in CIFSSHome prior to your season as well as update scores following each contest

Attention Athletic Directors/Coaches: It is very important that you enter your entire season schedule into CIFSSHOME (www.cifsshome.org) as well as update the scores immediately following your contests.

Log in @ www.cifsshome.org (If you do not have a log in & password as a coach, check with your Athletic Director). Once you are logged in:

-On the left panel, click on "Teams", select "Water Polo, Girls"

To **Add a game:**

- On the left panel, click on "Events", select "Add Event", choose Game under "Event Type", choose date of game under "Event Date", choose **Water Polo, Girls** under "Sport", choose Varsity under "Level", type the opposing school name in "Add Opponent", choose the type of game under "Select Game Type", click on Home, Away or Neutral under "Location", choose "Start Time" Click on "Save" to add one game or "Save & Duplicate" for multiple games.

- To **Submit your score:**


- On the left panel, click on "Teams", select "Teams Manager", scroll down to "**Water Polo, Girls**" and click on VR to add Varsity scores Click on "Post Result" button, enter your team's score, enter the opponent's score, result should auto populate with either "W", "L" or "T" based on the correct match score entered. 

PLAYOFF FORMAT

4- team leagues are guaranteed two entries into the 2025-2026 Water Polo Playoffs, 5-6 team leagues are guaranteed three entries and 7-8 team leagues are guaranteed four entries. Freelance teams may fill byes in each divisional draw, or teams submitted by leagues, who qualify for an At-Large entry. **See rule 3414.1 for rules regarding "At-Large" entries.**

Note: The 2024-2026 Water Polo At Large Form must be submitted by your school using the online CIFSSHome Application (www.cifsshome.org), **no later than 8:00 pm on WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 28, 2026.**

RULE 3510 - FREE LANCE PLAYOFF ENTRY VERIFICATION

If a school does not have membership in a league or the school belongs to a league which does not offer students in a given sport an opportunity to qualify into CIF Southern Section championships, special conditions exist which must be followed in order to qualify for possible entry into a CIF Southern Section playoff activity.

3510.1 Team Sports - All freelance schools desiring entry into the playoffs must submit schedules to the Commissioner for evaluation and approval of conditions under which the team may qualify. Schedules must be submitted prior to the start of each season for evaluation.

Q & A - How can a freelance team qualify for CIF playoff consideration?

You must schedule 80% of allowable games per sport and they must be at the varsity level, and in order to be considered for the playoffs, the school must have a .500 or better record in all contests played and there must be openings in the bracket. Additionally, teams that win 80% of their contests played will be guaranteed entry. (Except football.)

DATE OF LAST CONTEST

By Southern Section Council action, **ALL** contests must be completed by **WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 28, 2026 BY 6:00PM.**

DETERMINATION OF HOST TEAMS

FIRST-ROUND CONTESTS - An asterisk (*) on the draw sheet will indicate the host school for all first-round contests.

SECOND-ROUND CONTESTS

The host school for these rounds will be determined in accordance with Section 3404, of the CIF-SS Blue Book. **In all divisions and in all rounds, the host school will be responsible for securing a pool that meets the championship standards as stated below.**

SEMIFINAL ROUND

Semifinal round games may be played at a school's home site (provided the pool meets playoff specifications) if the CIFSS IS NOT hosting your division at a common site. All game locations in the playoff series are scheduled at the discretion of the CIFSS office. Approval for a change of time or venue IS required. **DIVISION 1 AND OPEN SEMI FINALS WILL BE HOSTED AT WOOLLETT AQUATICS CENTER ON WEDNESDAY FEBRUARY 18, 2026. GAME TIMES TBD.**

All Championship Finals will be held Mt. San Antonio College in Walnut and will be managed by the CIF Southern Section.

PRE -FLIPS

For ALL Rounds we will be conducting pre-flips in order to give schools immediate notice of their next game location. When the pairings are released on **FRIDAY, JANUARY 30TH, 2026**, the draw will indicate home and away teams. That day we will also do pre-flips to determine the host school in the next round. Each morning following games played in your division we will do pre-flips for the round following your next round.

Coin Flip results will be available @ www.cifss.org after 10:00 a.m. the morning of the flip.

Note: Should a team be found in violation of using the official, mandated ball, in violation of any NFHS uniform requirement or facility requirements, that team will lose the ability to host a home game in the next round. They will, however, be charged with the home game. This will continue

until uniforms and/or equipment comply. Any unserved sanctions will carry over to the next season for which the team qualifies.

TEAM BENCHES – ALL DIVISIONS ALL ROUNDS

Each school will get a max of 23 participant entry tickets (this is for your players, coaches, trainer, sports psychologist, etc.), anyone your school intends to be seated in the bench area. For rounds with ticket sales, any additional ticket needs must be purchased. “Faculty Supervisors” are in the stands with parent and student sections (not in the bench area). All 23 (or less) participants in the bench area MUST BE ROSTERED. The bench area is not intended for Board Members, Administration, lower-level athletes, etc.

FACILITY REQUIREMENTS – ALL DIVISIONS AND ALL ROUNDS

- Width - No less than 45 feet (20m), no more than 66 feet (13m).
- Length - 75 feet or (25m). For pools with floating goals, the distance from goal line to goal line shall be a minimum of 75 feet (25yds) and a maximum of 25m. For pools with wall goals, the length of the pool from wall to wall shall be a minimum of 75 feet (25yds) and a maximum of 25m. * Floating goals may not be used in 25 yard pools.
- Minimum Depth - 6 1/2 feet
- When a common location is used for multiple games, teams shall have ample warm-up time and reasonable warm-up space (conducive to swimming and passing) with at least 15 minutes in the playing field before the start of a subsequent game (if multiple games are being played at one site). With the coaches’ mutual agreement, the game may begin when both teams are ready, but not before the published game time.
- Seating (benches or chairs) should be provided for the allotted number of rostered participants as players may not be allowed to remain in the water.

PLAYING RULES

All playoff games will be conducted according to the 2024-2026 National Federation Water Polo Rules (previously distributed to all CIF-SS Water Polo coaches), except where superseded by the CIF-SS Blue Book, or this bulletin.

HOME/AWAYS TEAMS

The white team will use the bench area as well as begin the competition to the left from the vantage point of the scorers’ table. The dark team will use the bench area as well as begin the competition to the right from the vantage point of the scorers’ table.

OFFICIALS

The CIF-SS Office will assign officials for all water polo playoff games. Fees for officials will be:
Single Game (Playoff Rounds) -- \$80.00 each official, during all playoff rounds
Championship Final -- \$88.00 each official

Upon request, the host school will be provided the names of the officials by a representative of the CIF-SS Office.

GAME BALLS

Participating teams will furnish their own balls for pre-game warm-ups and practice sessions. It will be the responsibility of the host team to provide an official game ball (KAP7 104), as specified in the National Federation Rules, and per CIF Southern Section contract. **All playoff contests must be played using the KAP7 ball.** The CIF Southern Section will furnish the KAP7 ball for all Championship Final games.

Note: Should a team be found in violation of using the official, mandated ball, in violation of any NFHS uniform requirement or facility requirements, that team will lose the ability to host a home game in the next round. They will, however, be charged with the home game. This will continue until uniforms and/or equipment comply. Any unserved sanctions will carry over to the next season for which the team qualifies.

ADMISSION CHARGES

- A. Preliminary Rounds -- As per Article 1, Section 143 of the CIF-SS Blue Book, there will be no admission charged for games, except upon petition to the Commissioner's Office, by the principals of the schools involved. If written permission is granted, the prices are to be \$12.00 for Adults/Students without high school I.D., \$6.00 for Children/Students with proper high school I.D., and \$6.00 for children 13 & under.
- B. Championship Finals – Game schedule and admission prices for the finals will be as follows:

Mt. San Antonio College —SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 21ST

Divisions will be assigned specific game times on Thursday, February 19th no later than 10:00 a.m.

Ticket Prices

- \$14.00 Adults
- \$7.00 High School Students (w/HS ID)
- \$7.00 Children (13 & under)

Through the CIF-SS partnership with GoFan, all championship tickets will be made available online for digital purchase and presented electronically at the event gate for entry.

All seating at the Mt. San Antonio College will be general admission (first come, first served). This will allow the fans of competing schools to have an equal opportunity for seats. Schools are responsible for securing their own valuables. Valuables should not be left unattended. Each team should designate someone to secure those valuables and keep them in their possession at all times.

AWARDS

The following awards will be given during the playoffs:

- A. Championship Plaques - All first-place teams.
- B. Runner-up Plaques - All second-place teams.
- C. Championship Patches - 18 individual patches for members of all championship teams.
- D. Championship T-shirts - 18 t-shirts for members of all championship teams.
- E. Medals - 18 individual medals for members of all runner-up teams.
- F. Certificates - Individual participation certificates for members of each team participating in the playoffs are available at CIFSSHome (www.cifsshome.org), under the Forms tab.

Each member of a team participating in the CIF Southern Section playoffs can receive a CIF SOUTHERN SECTION PARTICIPATION CERTIFICATE. These certificates will be printed by your school. The document is in a "type-in" PDF format and can be found on CIFSSHOME.

CHEERING SECTIONS

Fan/Student cheering sections are encouraged to cheer and support their own team and should display proper sportsmanship with respect to the opposing team and the game officials. They are expected to follow the following guidelines and failure to do so may lead to removal from the contest and/or forfeiture of the contest.

1. No noisemakers (horns, bells, victory bells, sirens, chimes, wooden blocks, balloons, thunder sticks, etc.). Megaphones may only be used by the school's uniformed cheer squads.
2. Cheering devices such as rally towels, pom poms and pennants are acceptable when used within the bounds of good sportsmanship.
3. It is the expectation that cheering section behavior will be monitored by the assigned school staff of the school that they represent. All improper behavior/language should be addressed and corrected immediately by school staff supervisors.
4. Face painting is acceptable from the neck up only and shall not include any inappropriate letters or symbols. Assigned school staff shall monitor their cheering sections in regards to face painting.

CONTEST FINANCES

- A. If permission is granted to charge admission, the gross profit will be split equally between the schools, with the visitor paying its own travel expense and the host team paying the game expense.

- B. Concessions and Programs -- In all games except the finals, the host school reserves the right to handle programs and concessions as a separate venture, and need not share the profit, or expect the visiting school or CIF-SS, to share in any loss.
- C. Championship Finals -- When managed by the CIF-SS, all receipts will revert to the CIF-SS, who will pay game, facility, and award expenses.

PROTESTS OF PLAYOFF CONTESTS

By action of the CIF-SS Council at its March 1983 meeting, protests of playoff contests involving National Federation rules will no longer be entertained following the conclusion of the contest.

Coaches may direct questions to the game officials as they pertain to a possible misapplication of the rules in accordance with the National Federation rules governing that sport. No protest may be carried forth once the contest is completed.

Coaches are encouraged to carry National Federation rulebooks with them for all playoff contests. Schools will still have the opportunity to protest a contest, in accordance with Southern Section Rule 1111, as it pertains to use of an ineligible player, or violations of any CIF-Southern Section rule in connection with the contest.

Subject: CIF STATE WATER POLO REGIONAL CRITERIA

The CIF SoCal Regional Water Polo Championships will be hosted in Orange County and shall be conducted in three divisions. The CIF Southern Section will be granted 12 entries total with automatic entrants being chosen as follows:

STATE DIVISIONS I, II and III: The Southern Section receives 12 entries total

- The top four teams from Southern Section Open Division
- The "Finalists" from Southern Section Divisions 1 and 2 (both the Champion and Runner-Up)
- The Champion from Southern Section Divisions 3, 4 and 5.

ENTRIES –SEEDING PROCEDURES

The CIF SoCal Regional Water Polo Championships will be conducted using eight-team (8) brackets in each of the three (3) divisions. In each division, the Southern Section will receive four (4) automatic entries. The Regional Seeding Committee will determine the divisional placement of the Section entries for the Regional Water Polo Championship. Seeding will take place Sunday morning immediately following the CIF Southern Section Championship.

Official Ball Rule:

Should a school fail to provide the correct game ball, the game will always be played. Teams/schools failing to utilize the correct official ball in CIF-SS playoffs will be reported by officials to CIF-SS and will not be allowed to host their next available home playoff game. Penalty will carry over to the next season if not enforceable this season due to elimination.

Rosters & Scores:

- Complete schedules are to be submitted to CIFSSHOME prior to each season.
 - Update scores following every contest direct to CIFSSHOME
- Additional directions on accessing CIFSSHOME are included in this document.

TV/Web/Radio Rights:

Any TV or streaming webcast (video or audio) or radio transmission of a CIF-SS playoff or championship event requires a contract and rights fees through the CIF-SS office prior to the contest. The only ‘exceptions’ are: Games broadcast via The NFHS Network, Spectrum Sports Net, Spectrum.

‘Official’ Championship Souvenirs:

The exclusive vendor for CIF Southern Section Championship souvenirs (t-shirts, scarfs, pins, beanies, hats, etc...) is our long-time partner *CIF T-shirts*. These are the official items sold each year per sport. You are likely familiar with their annual shirts at the finals. You can order team and individual items through them at www.ciftshirts.com.

Official Ball Required:

Only the approved official ball in each ball sport may be played by either school during CIF-SS playoff contests. Violation of this rule will result in loss of your next home playoff game. The current Official Ball list for each sport is included and available at www.cifss.org in the “Resources” drop down. This policy has been in effect since 2002.

Gatorade Only:

Only Gatorade jugs, cups, bottles, ice chests may be used or visible during any CIF-SS playoff contest. (No Powerade, Body Armor, etc). The only acceptable alternative is a plain-wrap or Igloo labeled products. This rule does not apply to the actual liquid distributed to athletes. This policy has been in effect since 1995.

CIF-SS on Souvenirs:

The ‘CIF Southern Section’, ‘CIF-SS’, ‘Southern Section’ and ‘CIF’ marks and logos are registered trademarks with the State of California. Schools may only use the CIF Southern Section marks on rings, patches and banners, by doing business with a CIF-SS licensed vendor. **Schools may only use the CIF Southern Section marks on apparel and other souvenir items exclusively through ciftshirts.com. Schools creating items with CIF-SS registered marks from a non-licensed vendor will face sanction and/or will be required to purchase any unsold shirts/items at the Championship Final.** A list of the currently licensed vendors for these products is included and regularly updated on www.cifss.org.

Please note: The use of only “CIF” is strictly prohibited per the State CIF registered trademark. The “CIF”, is not just the CIF Southern Section. Only those teams in State regionals, bowl games and individual sport finals actually qualify to use CIF without Southern Section attached. Any such use must be approved in advance by the CIF State office.

Host Site Requirements:

- Playoff Tickets:** (This pertains to revenue sports of basketball, football and volleyball): It is mandatory to sell tickets for admission to all CIF-SS playoffs and championship contests. Through the CIF-SS partnership with GoFan, all playoff tickets will be made available online for digital purchase and presented electronically at the event gate for entry. Patrons can purchase in advance via gofan.co, via private links made available by the participating schools or via QR code at the entry gate of the playoff event. All playoff revenue will be sent directly to CIF-SS. Both the host and visiting schools will be required to submit a financial/expense report following each playoff game in an effort to receive reimbursement for game expenses and revenue share split in the case of a profit game.
- CIF-SS/FORD Banner:** It is a requirement of each host school (including off-site) that the CIF-SS/Ford Championship banner be displayed at every playoff home game in football and the gymnasium sports post football season (or on the electronic signage where schools/venues do not display banners). If you need a banner please contact jackieg@cifss.org
- Gatorade:** It is a requirement of each school use only Gatorade product/jugs/cups/squeeze bottles during CIF-SS championship events. No other competitive product shall be used. Water can be placed in Gatorade merchandise.
- PA Announcements:** As a host of a CIF-SS playoff contest, the CIF-SS announcements take precedence over the host school's messaging and must be read in entirety at each playoff contest. Home schools are the host of a CIF-SS event in the playoffs. For contractual requirements, please read all the provided PA's each contest. PA's for each sport can be found on cifss.org under the designated sports page.
- Media Credential Access:** Accredited working media should be given admission to all playoff games by showing their CIF-SS Media credential.

CUSTOM AWARDS/ RINGS/BANNERS/APPAREL SOUVENIRS USING CIF-SS:

Schools often seek to create custom patches, gym banners and championship rings that include both the school and CIF-SS marks/logos/names. Example: ‘ACME BOYS BASKETBALL 2022 CIF-SS CHAMPIONS’. Schools may create these items using CIF-SS marks only through a CIF-SS licensed vendor.

Schools creating items with CIF-SS registered marks from a non-licensed vendor will face sanction and/or will be required to purchase any unsold shirts/items at the Championship final if similar non-licensed items appear at the contest. A list of the currently licensed vendors for these products is included and regularly updated on www.cifss.org.

Please note: The use of only “CIF” is strictly prohibited per the State CIF registered trademarks. Only those teams in State regionals, bowl games and individual sport finals actually qualify to use CIF without Southern Section attached. Any such use must be approved in advance by the CIF State office.

CIF-SS vendors who are licensed to create custom items for schools that include CIF-SS:
