This is highlighted with sports revenue projections set toward conservative goals, sponsorship and broadcast contracts being fulfilled at 100% and sport fees to match the 2020-2021 school year. This proposal also includes the return of the full 17-member office staff, longevity steps and COLA increases, when revenue can support it, and the full return of employee benefits. 5. REPORTS

A. Financial Report

Mitch Carty

Chief Financial Officer Mitch Carty reported to the Council that 99% (\$716,000) of the sport fees have been received as of today. Current investment revenue over Quarter 3, Quarter 4 and Quarter 1 has been very strong totaling \$210,000 in revenue. In addition, we have received 79% of the marketing and broadcast payments for the 2020-2021 budget year, however \$0 in sport playoff revenue has been received. PPP Loan #1 in the amount of \$456,000 was utilized in July and August of 2020, vacation accrual usage by office staff continues and employee furloughs and benefit reductions are ongoing. Season 2 playoffs are currently being planned and some additional revenue is possible. The full office staff will be returning as of Monday, April 19, 2021. Based on the current projections and expenses Mr. Carty projected an expected loss of \$168, 687 for the 2020-2021 school year. PPP Loan #2 in the amount of \$388,000 has been received and this amount will go to offset the projected loss. This would leave \$219,000 to cover playoff expenses, and restoration of benefits lost, and other expenses.

B. Treasurer's Report

Chris Calderwood

Treasurer Chris Calderwood reported that 550 schools have paid the required membership dues as of today. That leaves nine schools with outstanding balances. Friends of Golf have donated \$23,500 all of which 100% of those funds will be distributed to member schools that have boys and girls golf programs. Finally, the annual audit for the 2019-2020 fiscal year was completed and submitted along with an outstanding audit report with no findings.

C. President's Report

President Mike West took time to thank the CIF-Southern Section staff and leadership for all the efforts they have done to operate in such a successful way over the past year. President West wanted to remind all the members that the staff has taken pay cuts along with the loss of benefits in order to serve the member schools to the best of their abilities.



LEAGUE PLACEMENT APPEAL



GOAL: To be moved from the Coast View Conference and placed in the Orange Coast League for the 2022-24 cycle. This league placement is based on the proposal from the Empire League and received significant support during the Orange County re-leaguing process.

RATIONALE FOR APPEAL:

<u>Competitive Equity:</u> The data below clearly demonstrates a significant disparity in the competitive level of our school in comparison to the other teams in the Coast View Conference. CIF has gone to great lengths, with the support of this Council, to develop playoff structures in every sport based on competitive equity. This league placement is counter to those years of effort in creating our current system.

<u>Precedent:</u> Laguna Hills was granted relief from the Coast View Conference two years ago in the re-leaguing process. They requested relief based on a change in school size and competitive equity. As a comparison, Laguna Hills has 1,600 students, while St. Margaret's only has 470. In addition, Laguna Hills was competing in higher divisions in most of the sports they offer when the appeal was granted.

<u>Health & Safety:</u> Our current football roster has a total of 37 players, which is a jump from the 22 (five of whom were freshman) we played with last year. Our ability to maintain the health and safety of these athletes in the Coast View Conference is not realistic and it is highly unlikely that we would be able to complete a league season against teams that regularly field 75-100 players. This remains true in most of the other contact sports as well.

<u>School Size:</u> We are the second smallest school in Orange County area and were placed in the conference/league with the largest average school size. Our inability to field lower-level teams throughout sports will cause difficulty in scheduling for fellow conference members.

Proposal Summary: The CIF Executive Committee is proposing revisions to Article 70.D. (Terms of Office). The proposed revision to Article 70.D.(6) will provide balance to our election process and potential committee turnover. Beginning with the 2022-2023 school year, this would result in two (2) open positions available for election to the Executive Committee plus an at large representative appointed in odd numbered years and three (3) open positions available for election to the Executive Committee in even numbered years. If passed, this revision to Article 70.D.(6) would be automatically revoked following the Executive Committee appointment of the At-Large Representative at their June 2022 meeting and the two (2)-year term for the At-Large Representative would be reinstated for June 2023 appointee. The proposed revision to Article 70.D.(7) would allow for an Executive Committee member who, in the second year of their term, ceases to be a representative of their Section to the Federated Council to remain as an additional representative of their Section until the end of that representative's prescribed term. This would not change the number of weighted votes for that Section(s).

Fiscal Impact: None

Background: In February of 2019, the Federated Council approved a revision to Article 70.D. (Terms of Office) which changed the term of Executive Committee members (including the At-Large member) from one (1) year to two (2) years. This revision would temporarily revise that Article to provide balance to our election process.

The above Article revisions are for immediate implementation.

70.D. Terms of Office

- (1) The President-Elect will serve two (2) years before assuming the presidency. The President-Elect shall assume the office of President immediately following service in the office of President-Elect. (Revised May 2002 Federated Council)
- (2) The President shall serve a two (2)-year term.
- (3) The Past-President shall serve a two (2)-year term immediately following service as President.
- (4) Other committee members shall be elected annually by the Federated Council to serve a two (2)-year term. An Executive Committee member may serve for two (2) consecutive terms of two (2) years each.
- (5) If there is a break of one (1) year in the service of an Executive Committee member as a member of the committee, that member may be eligible for nomination, election and service for one (1) additional term of office as an Executive Committee member but no one shall be eligible to serve more than a total of six (6) years on the committee.
- One (1) At-Large Representative from the Federated Council, in an effort to reflect both gender and ethnic representation, shall be appointed for a two one (2 1)-year term (see Note below).
- (7) If in the second year of their term, an Executive Committee member ceases to be a representative of their Section to the Federated Council, that Executive Committee member may remain as an additional representative of their Section until the end of that representatives prescribed term.

Note: For item 70.D.(6) above, the At-Large Representative appointed by the Executive Committee at their June 2022 meeting shall serve a one (1)-year term. The person appointed to serve this one (1)-year term shall be eligible to serve two additional two (2)-year terms unless it is the current appointee who would be eligible to serve only one additional two (2)-year term.

Proposal Summary: The CIF Executive Committee is proposing a revision to Article 70.E. (Nominations). The proposed revision to Article 70.E.(6) would reduce the number of nominations for the Executive Committee from seven (7) to five (5) due to the number of open Executive Committee positions being reduced from five (5) each year to either three (3) in even numbered years or two (2) in odd numbered years.

Fiscal Impact: None

Background: In February of 2019, the Federated Council approved a revision to Article 70.D. (Terms of Office) which changed the term of Executive Committee members (including the At-Large member) from one (1) year to two (2) years and staggered their terms. Prior to this revision, there were five (5) open Executive Committee positions each year and the Nominating Committee would nominate at least seven (7) candidates for these positions. This revision would reduce the number of nominations given that there are fewer open positions each year.

70.E. **Nominations**

- (1) Each year, the President shall appoint a nominating committee consisting of at least five (5) members. Members of the nominating committee shall be selected from among the Federated Council and may include no more than two (2) current members of the Executive Committee.
- (2) The Executive Director and the President shall be ex-officio members of the Nominating Committee.
- (3) Nominations for the Executive Committee shall be presented to the Federated Council at the meeting prior to the election.
- (4) Nominations for President-Elect will occur in even numbered years.
- (5) Each person nominated for an officer or other Executive Committee seat must be a current member of the Federated Council at the time of nomination and election.
- (6) The Nominating Committee will name at least seven five (7.5) candidates for two (2)-year terms for the Executive Committee and at least two (2) candidates for President-Elect.

 (Approved January 2020 Federated Council)
- (7) Nominations will also be accepted from the floor at the Federated Council meeting whereupon nominations are presented.
- (8) Nominations for an at-large representative will be solicited from Sections and Allied Organizations after the election of Executive Committee members. The Executive Committee, at its June meeting, will select a candidate from among those nominations to serve as an at-large representative.
