Junior Catcher Named 4-A All-CIF Top Player

Junior catcher Dennis Littlejohn, who led North Torrance High School to its first CIF Southern Section baseball title, has been named the outstanding performer in the "AAAA" division baseball for 1971 as voted by the All-Southern California Board of Athletics.

Littlejohn led the Saxons to a portion of the Bay League title and the 4-A championship as he batted .382 and only had three steals on him in 34 games, throwing out nine base runners.

Representing the northern-most league in the large schools division, Channel League representatives Hueneme and Buena of Ventura landed two players each.

Both semi-finalists, the teams placed outfielder Dan Marple, a .407 hitter from Hueneme

on the first team; Buena junior shortstop Mike Glenn (.375) on the second team and third team selections utility player Dan Garcia (.378 and 6-2) from Hueneme and Buena junior second baseman Jim Irvine (.321).

The Los Angeles Dodgers will host members of the All-Los Angeles and All-CIF Southern Section (all levels) teams at Dodger Stadium prior to the Dodgers' Thursday, June 24 game with the Cardinals. United Savings-Helms Athletic Foundation awards will be presented on the field to all players named for 1971 honors. Players, coaches and families of the honored players will be guests of the Dodgers.

Los Padres Pair On 2-A All-CIF

Santa Ynez Pirates' shortstop Brian Asselstine and Atascadero pitcher Mike Molina were both named to the "AA" division All-CIF baseball team announced today by the All-Southern California Board of Baseball composed of journalists from throughout Southern California.

The two senior athletes were both named to the second team. Asselstine, who batted .363 for the Pirates, marked his second year as an All-CIF player, having been named to the "AA" first team in 1970. Molina had an 0.85 ERA and was 9-0 for the Los Padres League champion Greyhounds of Atascadero.

Palo Verde outfielder Terry Whitfield, a .470 hitter drafted by the Yankees, was named co-MVP along with Antelope Valley pitcher Dan Tippit (19-5 and 0.74 ERA), a 3-A CIF choice in 1970.
