McMichael Top CIF Player

Southpaw Chuck McMichael, who pitched Hoover to its first CIF 4-A baseball championship, Monday was chosen CIF Player of the Year by the Citizens Savings Athletic Board.

McMichael did not allow an earned run in 36 innings of playoff competition as he notched all five Tornado victories, including three shutouts.

He struck out 148 in 117 innings during the season while compiling a 16-2 record. He hit .444 with 18 RBI.
