no illegal payments were made.

"We never wanted anything to do with a player that you had to buy, and we never did," Wooden said during a break from a basketball camp he is conducting in Thousand Oaks. "I have a complete clear feeling about that."

Scott, a longtime sports activist, said in a book about Bill Walton, UCLA star now with the Portland Trail Blazers, that UCLA players were well taken care of beyond NCAA rules. He said one unidentified player got \$4,500 from Bruin booster Sam Gilbert—which Gilbert denies.

"When you're successful," Wooden said, "the NCAA likes to investigate you, and they investigated us while I was at UCLA . . . And I know that Sam was investigated by the NCAA and nothing came of it."

## Lopez, Marshall Named Top Players in Two CIF Divisions

Damian Lopez of St. Genevieve (Class 1-A) and Terry Marshall of Riverside Christian (Small Schools) were named Players of the Year in their respective CIF divisions Monday by the Citizens Savings Athletic Board.

Lopez, a senior right-hander, led St. Genevieve to the 1-A title with a 9-0 record, 19-1 over two years. He had five shutouts this season and batted .443.

Marshall pitched Riverside Christian to the semifinals. He finished with a 14-1 record and 0.60 ERA.
