# El Segundo's DeMaria CIF 4-A Player of Year

El Segundo High won its fifth CIF baseball title behind the pitching of George DeMaria, who Thursday was named the 4-A Player of the Year by the Citizens Savings Athletic Board.

DeMaria won all five playoff games, pitching 31½ innings and allowing only one unearned run. He pitched a two-hitter in the Eagles' 5-0 win over Hueneme for the title.

The 6-4, 185-pound senior compiled a 12-0 season record and 0.69 ERA (he allowed nine earned runs). The right-hander pitched 91½ innings and gave up 52 hits, struck out 121 and walked 31.

Also making the first team from El Segundo was Dave Combs, a senior who batted .326. John Wood (.319, senior) and Jere Longenecker (.410, senior) from runnerup Hueneme were named to the first team.

## Covina's Moore Wins CIF 2-A Honors With Hitting, Pitching

Bill Moore, who led Covina High to the CIF 2-A baseball championship, was named the Player of the Year in the 2-A Division Tuesday by the Citizens Savings Athletic Board.

Moore, who was named MVP of the Montview League, batted .513 while setting records for home runs (11), hits (49) and RBI (42) in a season. The 178-pound senior pitcher finished with a 10-1 record and a 1.43 ERA. He pitched two no-hitters during the year.

Joining Moore on the first team were teammates Larry Baab and Mike O'Hara. Baab, a junior catcher, batted .513. O'Hara, a senior pitcher, had a 11-0 record and 2.15 ERA.

# Burroughs, Vaughn named to All-CIF 4A first squad

Outfielder Tim Burroughs of San Gorgonio and pitcher-first baseman Kevin Vaughn of Chaffey have been named to the All-CIF 4A first team.

They were joined on the 4A team by Chaffey's Bob Fellhauer, a second-team selection, and San Gorgonio's Fred Toliver, a third-team pick.

Vaughn played a key role as Chaffey won the Citrus Belt League title. He compiled a 10-1 pitching record and batted .412

Fellhauer, a shortstop, hit .342 for the Tigers.

Burroughs led San G. with an incredible .567 batting average. Toliver, a hard-throwing right-hander, was 9-5 with an earned run average of 2.37. He recently signed with the New York Yankees.
