Tri-Players Are Named in CIF's 1-A Baseball

Yucaipa's Warren Bierma and Rio Mesa's Roger Hansen and Chuck Yaeger Monday were named the 1-A Division baseball Tri-Players of the Year by the Citizens Savings Athletic Foundation.

Bierma had 49 hits, 44 RBIs and 10 triples, all CIF records, and was named the San Andreas League MVP.

Hansen was a second-round choice of the Kansas City Royals in the recent baseball draft, Yaeger, who recently signed a letter of intent to attend UCLA, led Rio Mesa to a 28-0-1 record and the 1-A division title. Rio Mesa was the first baseball team in 20 years to go undefeated in the CIF.

Yaeger was undefeated (12-0) and had 106 strikeouts with a 1.04 ERA. Hansen hit 19 home runs in two seasons and batted .488 this year, striking out just once.

Andy Lynch, a junior pitcher who led Paraclete to the Small Schools division title, was named the Player of the Year in his division. Lynch was 12-3 with a 1.17 ERA.
