DAVID HARRIS, WESTMINSTER MOUND MAGICIAN,  
TOPS 4-A DIVISION ALL STARS FOR '81 SEASON

DAVID HARRIS, 6-4, 205-POUND PITCHER-OUTFIELDER FOR 4-A DIVISION CHAMPION WESTMINSTER HIGH SCHOOL, HAS BEEN NAMED PLAYER OF THE YEAR BY MEMBERS OF THE CITIZENS SAVINGS ATHLETIC FOUNDATION'S PREP SELECTION BOARD. HARRIS TWIRLED A 3-0 SHUTOUT AT SUNSET LEAGUE RIVAL EDISON IN THE FINAL PLAYOFF GAME TO BRING HIS RECORD TO 12-2 FOR THE SEASON. WHEN NOT ON THE MOUND, HARRIS PLAYED IN THE OUTFIELD WHERE HE BATTED .383 WITH 18 RBIs.

Harris and Edison High School's Tom Duggan were named co-MVPs in the Sunset League for '81. Edison lost three of four engagements to Westminster's White Lions during the year...including the playoff final.

Westminster defeated Notre Dame (3-2), Hueneme (6-5), Walnut (4-3) and Channel Islands (5-2) before meeting Edison. In the lower bracket, Edison disposed of St. Paul (9-2), Lakewood (5-0), Eisenhower (3-1) and South Torrance (5-0) before suffering the final-game shutout.

**MIKE ASBURY (COVINA PITCHER) & LENNY DYKSTRA  
(GARDEN GROVE OUTFIELDER) NAMED CO-PLAYERS  
OF YEAR IN 3-A DIVISION BASEBALL FOR 1981**

**M**IKE ASBURY, UNDEFEATED (11-0) COVINA PITCHER AND TWO-TIME ALL-CIF OUTFIELDER LENNY DYKSTRA WHO BATTED A LUSTY .496 OVER THE PAST SEASON, HAVE BEEN NAMED SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA CIF 3-A DIVISION CO-PLAYERS OF THE YEAR IN ALL-STAR TEAM SELECTIONS RELEASED TODAY BY CITIZENS SAVINGS ATHLETIC FOUNDATION. ASBURY'S COVINA COLTS, WHICH WON THE 2-A DIVISION CROWN IN 1979, DEFEATED EL DORADO 3-2 FOR THE 3-A CROWN THIS SEASON. MIKE NAILED DOWN HIS 11 VICTORY IN THE FINALE.

Dykstra, a first team selection in the outfield last year when he batted .441, pelted the pelota at a .496 clip this past season. He had 20 RBIs and 25 stolen bases in 27 games.

Asbury, a 5-9 and 140-pound junior, had an era of 0.87. Both Asbury and Dykstra will be honored along with all other first-team all-stars at Dodger Stadium on Wednesday, July 29 at the 44th annual All-Southern California Board of Baseball Awards Program. JEFF PRIES, CORONA DEL MAR PITCHER-INFIELDER,  
WINS MVP VOTE IN 2-A DIV. BASEBALL FOR 1981

**C**ORONA DEL MAR'S JEFF PRIES, 6-5 AND 185-POUND SENIOR PITCHER-SHORTSTOP HAS BEEN NAMED SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA CIF 2-A DIVISION BASEBALL PLAYER OF THE YEAR IN ANNUAL TEAMS SELECTED BY THE ATHLETIC FOUNDATION'S ALL-SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA BOARD OF ATHLETICS. THE TWO-SPORT STAR -- PRIES WAS A MEMBER OF THE SEA KINGS 3-A BASKETBALL TITLE TEAM -- WAS SELECTED AS AN INFIELDER (PLAYED SHORTSTOP) ON THE '81 ALL-STARS. HE BATTED .439 WITH 26 RBIs AND SIX HOME RUNS. HE HAD A PERFECT 9-0 MOUND MARK AND AN 0.88 ERA.

Pries is a returnee from last year's 1st team, when he compiled an 8-0 record and a 1.19 era. Jeff missed the first five games of the season because of the basketball playoffs.

Corona del Mar defeated defending 2-A Division champion Santa Fe 3-2 in the playoff final. The Sea Kings finished the year 24-3-1, while Santa Fe ended 21-6.
