

THOUSAND OAKS SHORTSTOP, KURT STILLMELL, 4-A DIV MVP BY VOTE OF ATHLETIC FOUNDATION BOARD FOR '83 Top Prep Pick in '86 Draft... Batted Career .465

KURT STILLMELL, A FOUR-YEAR SENIOR AT THOUSAND OAKS HIGH SCHOOL WHO WAS DRAFTED NUMBER TWO IN THE NATIONAL COLLEGIATE ATHLETIC FOUNDATION BOARD'S CHOICE AS CIF 4-A DIVISION PLAYER OF THE YEAR, AS ANNUAL NONSCHOLARSHIP ALL-STAR TEAMS WERE RELEASED TODAY BY THE ATHLETIC FOUNDATION.

STILLMELL'S SELECTION WAS NO SURPRISE, SINCE THE THOUSAND OAKS SHORTSTOP RECORDED A CAREER BATTING AVERAGE OF .465 AND SET A CIF SOUTHERN SECTION RECORD FOR CAREER HITS, AT 107.

The 6-0, 160-pound senior who passed up a scholarship offer from Stanford to accept a substantial bonus from the Reds, batted .552 this season (32-58), had 27 RBIs, five doubles, six homers, 30 runs, 32 walks (11 intentional), a .704 on-base average and stole 24 of 25 bases. Coach Jim Hansen's Lancers were 19-4 in '83, losing to Crespi (5-3) in the first round of the playoffs. Coach Daniel Peters' Millikan Reds won the 4-A title with wins over Eisenhower (8-6), Culver City (13-3), Loyola (10-4), Crespi (10-3) and Colton (6-5) for the title.

Doug Thorne, ~~perfect~~ prep pitcher (13-0) from division-winning Serrano High School of Phelan, Calif., has been named player of the year for 1983 by members of First Interstate Bank Athletic Foundation's All-Southern California Board of Athletics in annual prep diamond selections made last week. A unanimous selection by the 25-man board, Thorne led the diamondbacks to a 25-1 season record and a relief-winning appearance in the championship game...3-1 over Orange Lutheran.

A 5-11, 165-pound senior, Thorne is a two-time All-Arrowhead League performer, who set a school record in '83 with 14 RBIs, two shy of the CIF mark.
