

# MIKE McNARY, LAKEWOOD HIGH'S TITLE-WINNING PITCHER, WINS MVP VOTE IN 4-A BASEBALL FOR '87

AND THE FIRST INTERSTATE BANK - AMATEUR ATHLETIC FOUNDATION OF LOS ANGELES BOARD OF SPORTS JOURNALISTS WERE QUICK TO NAME THE DIMINUTIVE, 2-TIME CIF ALL-STAR TEAM MEMBER THE 4-A DIVISION PLAYER OF THE YEAR. **T**ROY HIGH SCHOOL'S SENIOR PITCHER CHRIS ROBINSON HURLED A 7-4 WIN OVER ARLINGTON HIGH TO GIVE THE WARRIORS THEIR FIRST EVER TEAM SPORTS TITLE IN THE SCHOOL'S 25-YEAR HISTORY AND WITH THE DOING WON HIMSELF CO-PLAYER OF THE YEAR HONORS IN 3-A DIVISION BASEBALL FOR 1987. AN EQUALLY IMPRESSIVE MOUND PERFORMANCE WAS TURNED IN BY PIONEER LEAGUE CHAMPION REDONDO'S SCOTT DAVISON (12-2 SEASON RECORD & 1.45 ERA), WHO WAS ACCLAIMED CO-MVP BY THE FIRST INTERSTATE BANK - AMATEUR ATHLETIC FOUNDATION SELECTION BOARD. ROBINSON FINISHED 14-2, WITH A 1.80 ERA AND SET SCHOOL RECORDS FOR STRIKEOUTS (130 SEASON) AND (195 CAREER).

**B**RETT SNYDER, WHO LED COACH CRAIG ANDERSON'S CAPISTRANO VALLEY COUGARS TO THE 2-A DIVISION BASEBALL TITLE IN 1987, HAS BEEN VOTED PLAYER OF THE YEAR BY MEMBERS OF THE FIRST INTERSTATE BANK - AMATEUR ATHLETIC FOUNDATION OF LOS ANGELES BOARD OF ATHLETICS. SELECTION OF THE 50TH ANNUAL SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA BASEBALL TEAMS WAS HELD RECENTLY IN CULVER CITY.

The South Coast League champions from Capistrano Valley won the championship game 6-2 over Whitmont League champion La Serna, with Snyder hurling a six-inning shutout. **T**IM WILLIAMS, ST. BERNARD'S TWO-TIME C.I.F. PITCHER-OUTFIELDER, HAS BEEN VOTED PLAYER OF THE YEAR IN I-A DIVISION BASEBALL BY MEMBERS OF THE FIRST INTERSTATE BANK - AMATEUR ATHLETIC FOUNDATION BOARD OF SPORTS JOURNALISTS. THE BOARD'S 50TH ANNUAL DIAMOND SELECTIONS WERE HELD RECENTLY IN CULVER CITY.

Williams posted a 9-2 mound record, with a 1.40 era. He batted .508, had 36 rbi, 13 homers and 20 stollen bases. Last season, as a junior, Tim had an 8-2 mark with a 1.09 era.

Winning the Camino Real League title, St. Bernard reached the finals before losing to Whittier Christian, 8-6. All-star team member Daryl Lancaster of Whittier Christian bested Williams in the championship game. Lancaster finished the season 14-1.

Coach Tom Caffrey's Whittier Christian Herald, a "wild card" entry in the playoffs as the Olympic League's number two team, defeated Centwell (5-4) La Salle (10-3), Temple City (7-4), Gladstone (17-5) and then St. Bernard in the finals to conclude its season 21-5.

All-star team players will be honored at Dodger Stadium on Thursday, Aug. 13 prior to the Los Angeles Dodgers - Cincinnati Reds game at the stadium. Awards will be presented to players, championship coaches and MVPs by members of the Dodgers, selection committee members and high school administrators.
