

LEE CUSEY, LEFFINGWELL CHRISTIAN PITCHER, WINS MVP VOTE IN "SMALL SCHOOLS" BASEBALL FOR 1988

LEE CUSEY, WHO PITCHED LEFFINGWELL CHRISTIAN'S LIONS TO THE "SMALL SCHOOLS" DIVISION CHAMPIONSHIP OF THE CIF SOUTHERN SECTION, HAS BEEN NAMED PLAYER OF THE YEAR BY MEMBERS OF THE FIRST INTERSTATE BANK - AMATEUR ATHLETIC FOUNDATION OF LOS ANGELES HIGH SCHOOL AWARDS BOARD. ANNUAL DIAMOND SELECTIONS WERE MADE RECENTLY IN CULVER CITY.

Only a junior and a member of last year's "Small Schools" team, Cusey had 14 strikeouts in the title game against Pasadena Poly, won by the Lions 4-1. Cusey completed Leffingwell Christian's 20-5-1 season with nine wins against a single loss and posted a 0.71 era.

The Lions finished second in the Academy League behind Whitney and defeated Flintridge Prep (6-3), Victor Valley Christian (2-1), Villanova Prep (10-3 and Woodcrest Christian (8-4) before the championship encounter with Pasadena Poly.

WILLIE LEIGHTON, FILLMORE "PORTSIDER", VOTED TOP PLAYER IN 1-A DIVISION BASEBALL FOR 1988

WILLIE LEIGHTON, FILLMORE HIGH SCHOOL'S PERFECT 15-0 PITCHER, HAS BEEN NAMED CIF SOUTHERN SECTION 1-A DIVISION PLAYER OF THE YEAR BY MEMBERS OF THE FIRST INTERSTATE BANK - AMATEUR ATHLETIC FOUNDATION OF LOS ANGELES' ALL-SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA BOARD OF ATHLETICS. THE ANNUAL ALL-STAR TEAM SELECTIONS TOOK PLACE RECENTLY IN CULVER CITY.

Leighton defeated last year's "Small Schools" (Large) champion Crossroads, 4-2 in the title game. He pitched all 28 innings in the playoffs and recorded 46 strikeouts, while allowing but 13 hits. Two of his playoff wins -- 1-0 over Maranatha and 7-0 over Aquinas -- were shutouts.

Leighton recorded a perfect 15-0 season with a 1.46 era. He had two no-hitters and one one-hitter. Over 101 innings he registered 155 strikeouts, walking 29. He batted .397. He was Tri-Valley League MVP and Ventura County Division II Co-Player of the Year. The Fillmore Flashes under coach Tom Ecklund finished the season 22-2.

U NABLE TO SEPARATE THE TALENTS OF TWO OUTSTANDING 2-A DIVISION PERFORMERS, ALL-SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA BOARD OF ATHLETICS NAMED BILL JORDAN OF CHAMPION NORTE VISTA AND ROYCE CLAYTON OF SEMI-FINALIST ST. BERNARD CO-PLAYERS OF THE YEAR IN 2-A DIVISION BASEBALL FOR THE 1988 SEASON. ANNUAL ALL-STAR TEAMS WERE NAMED RECENTLY IN CULVER CITY.

Bill Jordan compiled a 15-3 mound mark during '88, including an 8-4 win over Sunkist League rival Bloomington in the division title game. Coached by Don Edmondson, the Norte Vista Braves completed the season 22-6 with playoff wins over Azusa (10-3), La Canada (14-1) and St. Bernard (3-2) before defeating Bloomington for the championship. Bloomington edged Cantwell (9-8), Temple City (5-1), St. Genevieve (10-2) and Baldwin Park (3-2) prior to the title decider.

Royce Clayton, coach Bob Yernell's fine shortstop at St. Bernard, is a repeater from last year's 1-A Division team. Undefeated (14-0) in Camino Real league play, the Vikings wound up their season 22-4 with Clayton hitting .513. Royce was co-MVP in the league with teammate Dan Melendez, also a 2-A Division pick. ERIC BROOKS, WHO PITCHED AND BATTED COACH TONY CORRENTE'S MATADORES TO THE CIF 3-A DIVISION BASEBALL CHAMPIONSHIP, WAS UNANIMOUSLY NAMED PLAYER OF THE YEAR IN HIS DIVISION BY MEMBERS OF THE FIRST INTERSTATE BANK - AMATEUR ATHLETIC FOUNDATION OF LOS ANGELES BOARD OF SPORTSWRITERS. IN THE TITLE GAME WIN OVER EL TORO, BROOKS (15-1) STRUCK OUT NINE, WHILE ALLOWING BUT THREE HITS UNTIL THE SEVENTH INNING.
