MIKE LIEBERTHAL, WESTLAKE HIGH SCHOOL CATCHER, NAMED
PLAYER OF THE YEAR IN DIVISION 5-A BASEBALL . . .

MIKE LIEBERTHAL, AMONG THE NATION'S TOP-RATED HORSEHIDERS, HAS BEEN NAMED 5-A DIVISION PLAYER OF THE YEAR BY MEMBERS OF THE FIRST INTERSTATE BANK - AMATEUR ATHLETIC FOUNDATION OF LOS ANGELES' ALL-SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA BOARD OF ATHLETICS. THE WESTLAKE HIGH CATCHER PLAYED THE POSITION FOR THE FIRST TIME THIS SEASON.

Drafted in the first round and the number three pick in the nation, Lieberthal had been offered a full-ride scholarship to Arizona State. He was the first catcher drafted and was taken by the Phillies.

Westlake was the top-ranked team in the state for much of the season and ranked number one in the nation the final week of the regular season. The Warriors entered the playoffs 24-1 and defeated Mira Costa, 6-5, Torrance 4-1, and Bishop Amat 5-2 before losing to eventual 5-A titlist Marina, 4-1.

An indication of what Lieberthal meant to the Warriors is the fact that he was the board's MVP selection over Westlake teammate Mike Eby who finished 11-0 on the mound and was also a first-team pick.

Lieberthal batted .448, with 43 rbi's. He had 10 doubles, one triple and 13 homeruns. He walked 15 times and scored 32 runs.

Marina finished third in the Sunset League, but met every challenge in the playoffs defeating Wilson, HH, 4-2, Esperanza, 3-1, Mater Dei, 4-0, and Westlake, 4-1. In the finals Marina defeated another third place league finisher, Diamond Bar (Sierra League) 6-4.

TIM KUBINSKI, SAN LUIS OBISPO HIGH'S 12-0 PITCHER,
NAMED PLAYER OF YEAR IN 4-A DIVISION BASEBALL.....

TIM KUBINSKI, 6'4" 175 POUND PITCHER/OUTFIELDER WHO LED COACH DAVE OVERLAND'S S.L.O. TIGERS TO THE 4-A DIVISION BASEBALL TITLE, HAS BEEN VOTED PLAYER OF THE YEAR FOR 1990. SELECTION OF KUBINSKI AND THE 4-A DIVISION ALL-STAR TEAM WAS MADE BY THE FIRST INTERSTATE BANK - AMATEUR ATHLETIC FOUNDATION OF LOS ANGELES' ALL-SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA BOARD OF ATHLETICS.

Kubinski registered a perfect mound record over the Tigers' 28-game season (24-4), finishing 12-0 with an 0.84 era. In the championship game....4-0 over Valle Vista League champion South Hills....he knocked in two runs with a double and saved the game for starter Robbie Weeks striking out four of the last five batters he faced. Kubinski batted .364.

Northern League champions, San Luis Obispo defeated Ventura, Hart, Canyon of Anaheim and Upland in the first four playoff rounds....all by one run 4-3. Each of the Tigers four opponents, save Ventura, were league champions.

South Hills, 20-5 going into the playoffs and one of four seeded teams, shut out three of four opponents before reaching the finals. The Huskies blanked Hemet, 2-0 in eight innings, Arroyo Grande, 6-0, gave up one run to Glendora, 4-1, and then whipped Troy, 8-0. South Hills ended its season 24-6.

Both 4-A finalists placed three players on the all-star teams. The Huskies battery....Cory and Kevin Lidle....were first and third team picks respectively.

BRYAN DUNAGAN, LA SERNA HIGH SCHOOL JUNIOR PITCHER/FIRST BASEMAN,
VOTED TOP PLAYER IN DIVISION 3-A C.I.F. BASEBALL FOR 1990 SEASON

BRYAN DUNAGAN, WHO LED COACH VERN BROCK'S LA SERNA HIGH LANCERS TO THE SOUTHERN SECTION DIVISION 3-A BASEBALL TITLE THIS PAST SEASON, HAS BEEN VOTED PLAYER OF THE YEAR IN HIS DIVISION FOR THE 1990 SEASON. SELECTION OF DUNAGAN AND OTHER 3-A ALL-STARS WAS MADE IN ANNUAL SELECTIONS BY THE FIRST INTERSTATE BANK - AMATEUR ATHLETIC FOUNDATION OF LOS ANGELES' ALL-SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA BOARD OF BASEBALL.

Dunagan received high praise from his coach, who calls him "the best junior pitcher I saw all year." Registering a 10-2 mound record, Dunagan batted .353, with 28 rbi's, eight homeruns, eight doubles, two triples and reached base 51 times. He had one perfect game this season and three one-hitters over the past two seasons.

La Serna, which finished behind El Rancho in the Whitmont League, defeated Arroyo, 11-1, Bellflower, 6-2, Saugus, 4-3 in 11 innings and Orange, 10-1, before battling Tustin in the finals. Although managing only three hits off Tustin's Dan Baker, La Serna won the title, 1-0, when Baker issued a walk with the bases loaded in the bottom of the seventh inning.

Making the 3-A Division first team along with Dunagan is teammate and Whitmont League MVP the past two seasons, Willie Adams. On his way to Stanford, Adams registered 111 strikeouts this past season and over two years is 18-6.



KEYAAN COOK, MONTCLAIR PREP SHORTSTOP, VOTED
TOP PLAYER IN 1-A DIVISION BASEBALL FOR 1990

Montclair Prep senior shortstop Keyaan Cook has been named Player of the Year in C.I.F. Southern Section Division 1-A baseball. Selection of Cook, along with the naming of the 1-A Division All-Star Team, was made by the First Interstate Bank - Amateur Athletiuc Foundation of Los Angeles' All - Southern California Board of Baseball.

Cook, a repeater from last year's team when he batted over .500, bettered his average by some 43 percentage points this season, as he pelted the pelota at a .551 clip. He registered a .969 fielding percentage, with 38 hits, 33 rbi, 13 stolen bases and five homeruns.

The Alpha League champions, Montclair Prep defeated Brentwood, 6-0, Beaumont, 11-9, Paraclete, 2-0, and Village Christian, the Alpha League's wild-card entry, 14-4. It was ironic that Village Christian had defeated Moorpark 14-4 to get into the playoffs as a wild-card entry.

Kevin Zoll, St. Bonaventure pitcher/shortstop, made the team for the third time, while four other players repeated from the 1989 team.
