2. PUBLIC HEARING SESSION

A. Recognition of anyone wishing to address the Council. Speakers must limit their remarks to three minutes.

Jack Bautista, San Fernando Valley Soccer Officials assignor. Mr. Bautista spoke against the official's fees proposal and asked the Council to vote "no" on SS 636. Mr. Bautista stated that the proposal is not enough money for the lower-level soccer officials, nor does it provide enough of an increase for a center official working in a three-person crew.

1. Proposed 2022-23 CIF State Budget

Action

STATE 634

ITEM

President-Elect Jim Perry presented the CIF State Budget for review. The 2022-2023 Proposed Budget projects an income of \$6.68 million and expenses at \$6.61 million. Income sources for the State CIF office are: State championships, corporate and marketing sponsorship, and membership dues. The expected expenditures for the CIF State Office are marketing fulfillment agreements and the CIF Home partnership. The full proposed budget can be viewed at www.cifstate.org. There was a motion by the Southwestern League and a second by the Mulholland League to approve the proposal as written. There being no discussion, the motion carried.

2. CIF State Executive Committee Nominations

Action

STATE 635

President-Elect Jim Perry presented the CIF State Executive Committee nominations. Mr. John Becker, Sac Joaquin Section and Ms. Natalie Thorne, Central Coast Section are in consideration for the position of President-Elect.

President-Elect Jim Perry also announced that the following candidates have been nominated and have agreed to place their name for consideration to serve a two-year term on the CIF State Executive Committee: Catherine Arenson, San Francisco Section, Scott Giusti, San Diego Section, Marybeth Ortiz, CAPSO, Cris Oseguera, Northern Section, Louie Rocha, North Coast Section, Natalie Thorne, Central Coast Section and Mike West, Southern Section. These openings will begin with the 2022-2023 school year. President-Elect Perry requested the Council allow the Southern Section delegates to the CIF Federated Council to support Southern Section candidate Mike West and go uninstructed on the other positions. There was a motion by the Desert Empire League and a second by the Desert Valley League to support Mike West, Southern Section, and direct the Southern Section delegates to the CIF State Federated Council to go uninstructed on the other positions. There being no discussion, the motion carried.

B. SOUTHERN SECTION ACTION ITEMS

1. Proposed 2022-23 CIF Southern Section Budget

Action

SS 633

Chief Financial Officer Mitch Carty presented the Council with the 2022-2023 budget. The complete Proposed Budget can be viewed at www.cifss.org. There was a motion by the Surf League and a second by the Mulholland League to approve the proposal as written. There being no discussion, the motion carried.

2. CIF Southern Section Executive Committee Nominations

Action

SS 631

President Mike West reviewed the CIF Southern Section Nominating Committees slate of candidates for the 2022-2023 CIF Southern Section Executive Committee. Candidates included:

President-Elect – Dr. Paula Rodas, Principal, Lawndale High School and Mr. Jeff Williams, District Athletic Director, Antelope Valley Union High School District.

Dr. Paula Rodas received 57 votes, Mr. Jeff Williams received 24 votes.

2. CIF Southern Section Executive Committee Nominations (Cont.)

Citrus Belt Area Representative nominees are Mr. Darel Hanson, Principal, Riverside Poly High School and Mr. Kai Lyles, Athletic Director, Desert Hot Springs High School. Only members of the Citrus Belt Area are allowed to cast a vote for this position.

Mr. Darel Hanson received 5 votes, Mr. Kai Lyles received 10 votes.

Mt. SAC Area Representative nominees are Mr. Mitch Brunyer, Principal, Rowland High School and Monica Principe, Director of Secondary Education, Pomona Unified School District. Only members of the Mt. SAC Area are allowed to cast a vote for this position.

Mr. Mitch Brunyer received 5 votes, Mrs. Monica Principe received 2 votes.

3. Proposed Revision to Bylaw 510.1

Action

SS 632

President Mike West reviewed Action item SS 632 which was authored by the Private / Public Committee. This proposal would remove the bylaw limiting incoming 9th grade students who have participated in club/travel programs coached by high school coaches to enrollment in the public-school attendance area they live in. The proposal will allow students and families to freely choose a youth program, club, etc. they wish to participate in regardless of the coaching staffs' affiliation with a high school.

There was a motion by the Skyline League and a second by the Southwestern League to approve the motion as written. There being no discussion, the motion passed as written.

Motion Passed: 77-9-1

4. Officials Fees Proposal

Action

SS 636

President Mike West reviewed Action item SS 636 and asked the Officials Fees and Relations Committee Chair, Mr. Brice Sunderland, to step forward and answer any questions regarding the proposal. President West explained that this agreement looked to dramatically increase officials' fees across the board and move in a direction that tied compensation to the amount of time spent on campus for an official.

There was a motion by the Big VIII League and a second by the Surf League to approve the motion as written.

Discussion:

The Mulholland League asked for a current breakdown of officials' fees. President West explained that the full current rates and purposed rates over the next three years are contained in the supporting documents.

The Southwestern League asked what happened to the sports that were already receiving more than the purposed rate of \$35 / hour. The Official's Fees Committee Chair, Mr. Brice Sunderland, explained that no official would see their current rate decreased with this new agreement.

4. Officials Fees Proposal

Action

SS 636

The Marmonte League asked the question: "When was the full proposal and supporting documents released so the leagues could review the information?" Commissioner Wigod explained that the proposal was sent out to all Council League Representatives on January 26, 2022 prior to the February 1, 2022 CIF Southern Section Council meeting. During the February 1, 2022 CIF Southern Section Council meeting, held electronically via Microsoft Teams, there were small group breakout sessions so Council members could ask questions or get clarifications on SS 636 and report that information back to their respective leagues.

Motion Passed: 68-18-1

5. Proposed Revisions to Bylaws 3419.7 & 3420.3

Action

SS 637

President Mike West presented and reviewed the details of SS 637. This proposal would align 8-Man Football with the current competitive equity-based system of 11-Man Football playoff divisions. 8-Man Football playoff divisions are currently based on school enrollment and this proposal would now place teams in a respective division based on current year (regular season) data at the conclusion of the season.

There was a motion by the Trinity League and a second by the Tri-Valley League to approve the motion as written. There being no discussion, the motion passed as written.

Motion Passed: 78-1-8

6. Proposed Revisions to Bylaw 2415

Action

SS 639

President Mike West reviewed the details of SS 639. The proposal calls to align Girls Lacrosse with Boys and Girls Soccer regarding the issuing of two yellow cards during a contest. Currently in the sport of Girls Lacrosse, two yellow cards received by the same player warrants removal (ejection) from the current contest. CIF Southern Section Bylaw 1224 calls for the player to receive a subsequent game suspension due to the ejection from the last contest. The Girls Lacrosse Advisory Committee is proposing that when a player receives two yellow cards during a contest they are simply "fouling out" of that contest and they are not ejected. If they are not ejected, then they are not required to serve a subsequent game suspension. No Ejection Report would be filed by the game officials. The USA Lacrosse/ NFHS Rule Book has two clear definitions for what is a suspension penalty (yellow card) and what is an ejection (red card) so officials can clearly decide what needs to be reported and what does not.

There was a motion by the San Gabriel League and a second by the Suburban League to approve the motion as written. There being no discussion, the motion passed as written.

A. STATE FEDERATED COUNCIL NON-ACTION ITEMS

There are no CIF State Federated Council non-action items at this time.

B. SOUTHERN SECTION NON-ACTION ITEMS

1. Proposed Addition of Girls Flag Football

Non-Action

SS 638

Dr. Paula Rodas presented the proposal to the Council explaining that the sport will take place in the Fall season which will make it is more accessible to member schools and this aligns the sport with other schools within the State. Mr. Hartman from the Los Angeles Chargers expressed to the Council that they are available to assist with growth and sponsorship.

Discussion:

The San Andreas League asked about when would the season of sport take place if the proposal does not pass as a Fall sport? Dr. Rodas and Mr. Hartman explained that the plan would be to have the season in the late Fall / early Winter. The San Andreas League also asked who will be available to officiate these flag football contests? Dr. Rodas responded that they will continue to use 7 on 7 and flag football officials so it would not impact the use of 11-Man Football officials.

5. REPORTS

A. Financial Report

Mitch Carty

Mr. Mitch Carty reviewed and highlighted the Fall and Winter Sports playoff revenue. During the Fall Season the CIF Southern Section had a ticket sales revenue of \$1,143,265.85. This was an increase of \$256,975.00 compared to the 2019-2020 school year. During the Winter Season the CIF Southern Section had a ticket sales revenue of \$480,519.79. This was an increase of \$62,255.03 compared to the 2019-2020 school year. Other highlights mentioned was the 100% use of digital tickets via GoFan. The digital ticketing process now allows for a much more streamlined financial completion for each season that takes less than 1 month. Mr. Carty also reviewed that over \$1,000,000 has been sent back to schools in profit splits and honorariums to host schools in non-revenue sports. Finally, as of today, the net income in ticket revenue was \$1,371,274.00. This income revenue is similar to the 2014-2015 school year which resulted in a membership dues refund.

B. Treasurer's Report

Chris Calderwood

Mr. Calderwood reminded the Council that PPP loan #1 was submitted for forgiveness and approved. Currently PPP loan #2 has submitted for forgiveness as of March, 2022 and we are awaiting that decision.

C. President's Report

Mike West

President West gave his final address as Southern Section Council President and expressed his tremendous amount of pride by the member schools and support they have shown him during his presidency. President West has been very honored to serve as Southern Section President, especially during the COVID pandemic, and he takes pride in knowing that as he steps down the Southern Section is in great hands going forward.

Rob Wigod

1. CIF Southern Section 2021-2022 Goals - Responses

Commissioner Rob Wigod reviewed the 2021-2022 Southern Section Goals and updated responses to those goals. These goals and responses can be viewed in full within the complete agenda packet. Commissioner Wigod highlighted our continued increase in the social media platforms of Facebook, Twitter and Instagram along with promoting and participation in the Title IX at 50 celebration in cooperation with the National Federation of State High School Associations and the CIF State Office. Commissioner Wigod reminded the Council of the May 1st deadline for Distinguished Service/ Hall of Fame nominations and Champions for Character nominations is quickly approaching and to please submit those names for consideration. Next, Commissioner Wigod thanked the Council for disseminating information to member schools, supporting the Official's Fees Committee, thanked the Executive Committee and the Southern Section Office staff. Finally, Commissioner Wigod concluded with a special thank you to outgoing President Mike West for his leadership, guidance, and support in a very difficult time for our member schools during the COVID pandemic.
