C HERYL MILLER, WITHOUT MUCH QUESTION THE MOST DOMINANT GIRL HIGH SCHOOL BASKET-BALL PLAYER IN SOUTHLAND HISTORY, HAS BEEN NAMED 4-A DIVISION PLAYER OF THE

YEAR BY MEMBERS OF THE FIRST INTERSTATE BANK ATHLETIC FOUNDATION'S HIGH SCHOOL BOARD OF ATHLETICS. TO NO ONE'S SURPRISE, THE FOUR-TIME ALL-CIF ALL-STAR TEAM SELECTION HAD NO COMPETITION IN THE MVP VOTING HAVING BEEN THE DIVISION MVP IN BOTH 1980 AND 1981.

Miller, who averaged 37 points this year, has led Poly's Bears to 84 straight wins since December of 1979 when Gahr beat them 57-56. The all-time hardcourt phenom has 3,419 career points (33.4 avg.), 1,564 rebounds (15.3 avg.) and 433 assists (4.2 avg.). In one game during the '82 season (vs. Norte Vista) Miller scored 105 points, hitting an amazing 47 of 50 shots from the floor. Miller's previous high was 77 made in 1981.

This season Riverside Poly's Bears won the 4-A Division crown over a strong Gahr High five, 63-57. Gahr had won 22 straight to finish the season 27-4. The Bears defeated Gahr again in the Southern Regional finals, 48-39, and then swamped previously undefeated Los Gatos (33-1) in the State Championships 77-44 as Miller had 41 points, 16 rebounds, seven steals and four blocks.
