You are permitted a maximum of 28 contests during the regular season. By participating in the aforementioned pre-season NFHS sanctioned tournament prior to the official CIF Southern Section start date, you are agreeing to the following:

- Your designated dead period dates have been completed and it has ended prior to your participation in this event.
- The tournament will count as 2, 3, 4 or 5 contests against your overall record and will be included in your 28 regular season contests (see Bylaw 3005 for tournament breakdown).
- By participating in a tournament prior to the start of the season, you will forfeit the opportunity to have any interscholastic scrimmages after the first contest has been played.
- Once your team has participated in its first contest, the 18-Hour Practice Rule (Bylaw 506) and Sunday Contact Rule (Bylaw 504.M) will be in effect until the end of the season of sport.

Example: Queen’s Court Tournament (Aug. 6-7). This event is a non NFHS sanction event and is outside the season of sport. This event will not count towards a team’s 28 contest limit.

Ann Kang Invitational (Aug. 11-13). This event is a NFHS sanctioned event therefore once you begin play your official CIF season has started and all rules apply.
