BOB ACOSTA, WESTERN HIGH QB, NAMED "AAAA" CIF FOOTBALL PLAYER OF YEAR FOR '72 SEASON

WESTERN HIGH OF ANAHEIM'S HIGHLY BALLYHOODED QUARTERBACK BOB ACOSTA, WITH SPARKLING OFFENSIVE STATISTICS TO BACK HIS MVP CLAIM, HAS BEEN NAMED THE SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA "AAAA" DIVISION PLAYER OF THE YEAR, IN TEAMS RELEASED TODAY BY UNITED SAVINGS HELMS ATHLETIC FOUNDATION. ALL-SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA BOARD OF ATHLETICS DISCUSSED "AAAA" MVP HONORS OVER A LENGTHY PERIOD, WITH THE FINAL VOTE GOING TO THE ORANGE COUNTY STAR BY A CLEAR MAJORITY. BILL VARGO, WORKHORSE FULLBACK OF THE FOUR "A" CHAMPION ST. PAUL SWORDSMEN, RECEIVED STAUNCH BACKING FROM HIS BOARD SUPPORTERS.

IN LEADING WESTERN HIGH'S PIONEERS TO THE SUNSET LEAGUE CROWN IN 1972, BOB ACOSTA COMPLETED 57% OF HIS PASSES FOR 1,540 YARDS AND 11 TOUCHDOWNS. HE RUSHED FOR AN ADDITIONAL 986 YARDS AND 12 TOUCHDOWNS TO BRING HIS SEASON TOTAL YARDAGE TO 2,526 YARDS AND 23 TOUCHDOWNS. CAPTAIN OF COACH JIM EVERETT'S ELEVEN DURING 1972, ACOSTA IS A FINE STUDENT AND WILL BE A PRIME COLLEGIATE QB PRIZE. WESTERN WAS UNDEFEATED GOING INTO THE "AAAA" TITLE GAME WITH ST. PAUL, AS WERE THE SWORDSMEN. WESTERN FINISHED THE YEAR 12-1, WHILE ST. PAUL COMPLETED A PERFECT 13-0 SEASON.

IN THEIR RESPECTIVE BRACKETS, CHAMPION ST. PAUL ELIMINATED LA SERNA (47-0), DOS PUEBLOS (34-0), WESTMINSTER (10-7) AND WESTERN IN THE FINALE (29-24), WHILE WESTERN WAS UP-ENDING SERVITE (29-21), LAKEWOOD (21-14), AND ANAHEIM (15-14) BEFORE THE EXCITING TITLE GAME WITH ST. PAUL.

Honored Players on the "AAAA" Division First Team, coaches and special guests from the field of football will gather at International Hotel on Saturday morning, Jan. 27th at 10:30 a.m. for the 36th annual All-Southern California Board of Football Awards Program, with framed scrolls going to all 1st team players. Bob Acosta, as MVP, will receive the United Savings Helms bronze medallion award, while coach Marijon Anich will be recipient of the traditional Silver Tumbler.

Three players from last year's honor teams are back in 1972. Western guard Paul Charlton finds himself on the first team for a second year, while Bob Acosta, Paul's teammate, and El Rancho's Mark Bailey are up from last season's second team. St. Paul landed four spots on the all-star squads, while Western and Westminster landed three berths. (Thirty schools are represented on the three all-star teams.

ROBERT HERTEL, LOS ALTOS QB, WINS "AAA" MVP HONOR FROM UNITED SAVINGS HELMS BOARD IN '72

**R**OBERT HERTEL, AFFECTIONATELY KNOWN TO HIS LOS ALTOS CONQUEROR TEAMMATES AS "ROB" AND A QUARTERBACK WHO DIRECTED HIS TEAM TO THE CIF "AAA" DIVISION TITLE WHILE AMASSING 2,822 PASSING YARDS, HAS BEEN NAMED PLAYER OF THE YEAR FOR 1972 BY MEMBERS OF UNITED SAVINGS HELMS ATHLETIC FOUNDATION'S ALL-SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA BOARD OF FOOTBALL. THE LOS ALTOS STAR RECEIVED NO SERIOUS OPPOSITION FOR MVP HONORS, AS HE LED COACH DWAYNE DE SPAIN'S CHARGES THROUGH SIERRA LEAGUE PLAY AND FOUR ROUNDS OF TRIPLE "A" PLAYOFFS TO NOTCH THE 1972 CROWN.

A FINE COLLEGE PROSPECT AT 6-2 AND 180-POUNDS, HERTEL ALSO BOASTS A SPARKLING 3.75 GRADE AVERAGE. HE ACCOUNTED FOR 5,506 YARDS DURING HIS CAREER AT LOS ALTOS HIGH, WHICH RANKS 3RD ON THE ALL-TIME CIF LIST. IN THE TITLE GAME, ROB EVIDENCED HIS "COOL" BY DIRECTING THE CONQUERORS TO THEIR WINNING POINTS WITH JUST 1:44 LEFT ON THE CLOCK....DEFEATING PREVIOUSLY UNDEFEATED SANTA MARIA, 16-15, AS HERTEL WENT FOR THE TWO-POINT CONVERSION NECESSARY FOR VICTORY. LOS ALTOS WOUND UP THE SEASON WITH AN 11-0-2 RECORD, WHILE SANTA MARIA WAS 12-1.

ROB HERTEL, FIRST-TEAM "AAA" DIVISION PLAYERS, AND COACHES TO BE HONORED AT 36TH ANNUAL AWARDS PROGRAM ON JAN. 27TH

All-Southern California Board of Football's 36th Annual Football Awards Program will be held at the International Hotel on Saturday morning, Jan. 27th at 10:30 a.m. All first team "AAA" players and their coaches will be honored guests at the awards luncheon. Rob Hertel will receive the United Helms bronze medallion award, while honored players will receive special scroll awards. Coach Dwayne De Spain of title-winning Los Altos will be recipient of the traditional Silver Tumbler award.

Three players return from last year's three "A" teams. Rob Hertel was a second team pick in 1971, while Claremont's Brad Kessler and Upland's Rocky Chapman were third-team choices.

As expected, champion Los Altos headed all teams in placing men on the honor teams. The Conquerors notched six berths, while runner-up Santa Maria was awarded three positions, all on the first team. Crespi, a quarter-finalist, has four players represented, while La Habra, West Covina and Claremont each landed three spots.

There are thirty "AAA" Division schools represented on the three teams selected by United Savings Helms Athletic Foundation's board of sports journalists. Although only first team members will be invited to attend awards ceremonies, all selected players will receive scroll awards, first, second and third teams.

Tetrick, who was a first-team Small Schools Division selection in both 1970 and 1971, led the Knights to the Small Schools title in 1971 and through nine undefeated contests in 1972. Fillmore upset the Big Baptist Machine, 20-8, in the quarter-finals of the playoffs, as Tetrick wound up gaining 2,370 yards for the season and scoring 206 points. Steve's three-year career mark of 5,180 stands as a new CIF rushing record.

Mike Nanko and five teammates found their way onto the 1972 "AA" honor teams. It was coach Hitchcock's third consecutive "AA" title at Temple City. Nanko and fullback Rick Brown, a junior, raced through the Rio Hondo League in their customary loose style and then dispatched San Bernardino (31-0), Palo Verde (49-12), Northview (38-13) and Neff (28-6) almost without raising a long breath.

Paso Robles, winner of the Single A Division crown in 1972 with wins over Carpinteria, Tehachapi, Fillmore and Boron, placed three performers on the two honor teams. Boron, "A" Division runners-up, also placed three players.
