## JON VAN VUREN, SOUTH HILLS "MR. VERSATILE" NAMED "AAAA" FOOTBALL PLAYER OF YEAR IN '75

**J**ON VAN VUREN, "MR. VERSATILE" FOR COACH JIMMY JONES' SOUTH HILLS HIGH SCHOOL HUSKIES IN 1975, HAS BEEN NAMED 4-A DIVISION FOOTBALL PLAYER OF THE YEAR BY VOTE OF CITIZENS SAVINGS ATHLETIC FOUNDATION'S ALL-SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA BOARD OF ATHLETICS. AS IS ALWAYS THE CASE, SEVERAL OUTSTANDING CANDIDATES FOR MVP HONORS WERE NOMINATED, BUT THE TWO-YEAR, TWO-WAY STARTER WHO WAS A PART OF A THREE-YEAR 33-3 VARSITY GRID RECORD, WON OUT IN FINAL BALLOTING. IT MARKS THE SECOND YEAR IN A ROW THAT SOUTH HILLS HAS PRODUCED THE DIVISION MVP. BRIAN BETHKE SHARED HONORS WITH ST. JOHN BOSCO'S DAN MOROVICK IN 1974.

AT 6-2 AND 193 POUNDS, VAN VUREN IS WHAT COACH JONES REFERS TO AS A "COMPLETE" PLAYER. "JON WAS THE LEADING SCORER IN OUR LEAGUE (SIERRA) WITH 18 TOUCH-DOWNS. HE RUSHED AND CAUGHT PASSES FOR OVER 1,500 YARDS AND IS AN OUTSTANDING PUNTER WITH A 39.2-YARD AVERAGE. HE HAS INTERCEPTED 26 PASSES IN THREE YEARS, 12 THIS SEASON. HE HAS STARTED EVERY GAME FOR SOUTH HILLS AS A JUNIOR AND SENIOR. HE WAS THE SIERRA LEAGUE'S MOST VALUABLE PLAYER."

ALL-SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA BOARD OF FOOTBALL'S 39TH ANNUAL AWARDS PROGRAM WILL BE HELD AT MAGIC MOUNTAIN PARK ON SATURDAY MORNING, JAN. 17TH AT 10:30 A.M. ALL PLAYERS NAMED FOR 1975 GRID HONORS BY THE CITIZENS SAVINGS BOARD WILL BE RECIPIENTS OF FRAMED SCROLL AWARDS. PLAYERS OF THE YEAR AND TITLE-WINNING COACHES WILL ALSO BE PRESENTED WITH SPECIAL AWARDS.

COMMEMORATIVE FOOTBALLS FROM AMF VOIT INC. WILL ALSO BE AWARDED EACH ALL-STAR TEAM MEMBER....SOMETHING THE ATHLETIC EQUIPMENT COMPANY HAS KINDLY DONE FOR MORE THAN 20 YEARS.

Fifty-four players, representing 30 4-A high schools are listed on the 1975 all-star squad...two teams on offense and two on defense. Three players, Fred Ford (St. John Bosco), Rick Parma (Kennedy, La Palma) and Anthony Munoz (Caffey) are the repeaters from last year's second offensive unit.

Four-A champion Loyola had five of its players named to the honor teams, while runner-up St. Paul landed six. Loyola bested South Torrance (28-13), Foothill (13-8), West Covina (21-12) and Anaheim (21-17), before edging the Swordsmen 14-13 for the championship. St. Paul defeated Simi Valley (36-3), St. John Bosco (21-14), Fountain Valley (24-17) and South Hills (10-7) prior to reaching the finals.

TWO OF SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA'S PREMIER PIGSKIN PERFORMERS FOR 1975 — BRUCE BEN BEN OF VILLA PARK & HANK SWANSON OF SOUTH PASADENA — HAVE BEEN NAMED CO-PLAYERS OF THE YEAR IN 3-A FOOTBALL, AS ANNUAL GRID SELECTIONS WERE RELEASED TODAY BY CITIZENS SAVINGS ATHLETIC FOUNDATION. IN THE OPINION OF BOARD MEMBERS (MAKING THE FOUNDATION'S 39TH ANNUAL SELECTIONS), THE TWO PLAYERS WERE AS CLOSE AS THE FINISH OF THEIR TWO TEAMS....SWANSON'S SOUTH PASADENA TIGERS JUST EDGING BEN BEN'S VILLA PARK SPARTANS 13-12 IN THE 3-A TITLE DECIDER.

BEN BEN LED THE SPARTANS IN THE TITLE GAME AS HE HAD ALL YEAR WITH ONE OF SEVERAL 100-YARD-PLUS RUSHING EFFORTS. THE 5-11, 170-POUND HALFBACK ENDED THE SEASON WITH 1,443 YARDS AND SCORED OVER 100 TOTAL POINTS. BRUCE WAS THE VILLA PARK PUNTER AND PLACE KICKER AND ALTHOUGH THE SPARTANS FINISHED ONLY 3RD IN THE CENTURY LEAGUE, THE TEAM CAME ON STRONG IN THE PLAYOFFS....BEN BEN LEADING THE WAY.

HANK SWANSON WAS COACH JIM YANG'S NUMBER ONE PERFORMER ON THE TIGERS' TITLE-WINNING TEAM. HE PLAYED WITH GREAT DETERMINATION OFFENSIVELY AND WITH FEROCITY ON DEFENSE. THE TIGERS WON THE RIO HONDO LEAGUE TITLE, FINISHING THE SEASON WITH A 13-1 RECORD. SWANSON & COMPANY WON THEIR LAST 12 GAMES IN A ROW.

Champion South Pasadena placed four players on the team, as did Burroughs of Burbank. Runner-up Villa Park placed three players, as did Crescenta Valley.
