MVPs FOR 1976 GRID SEASON

A PAIR OF OUTSTANDING 1976 PREP GRIDIRON PERFORMERS -- LOS ALTOS HIGH'S RANDY HERTEL, WHO LED THE CONQUERORS TO THE 4-A DIVISION TITLE AND SANTA MONICA HIGH SCHOOL'S ALL-'ROUND PLAYER DENNIS SMITH -- HAVE BEEN NAMED CO-PLAYERS OF THE YEAR IN THEIR DIVISION FOR THE PAST PREP SEASON. ANNUAL SELECTIONS WERE RELEASED TODAY BY CITIZENS SAVINGS ATHLETIC FOUNDATION, HAVING BEEN PICKED BY THE FOUNDATION'S ALL-SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA BOARD OF ATHLETICS.

HERTEL, A 6-1, 180-POUND SENIOR WHO'S BROTHER ROB WAS 3-A MVP IN '72 WHEN LOS ALTOS WON ANOTHER C.I.F. CROWN, PASSED FOR 2,440 YDS. IN '76 AND 32 TDs. HE COMPLETED 64 % OF HIS AERIALS...WHICH IS THIRD IN THE SECTION RECORD BOOK TO PAT HADEN (67.9 % IN '69) AND DENNIS SPROUL (67.8 % IN '73). HERTEL RUSHED FOR AN ADDITIONAL 83 YARDS IN 40 CARRIES AND SCORED FOUR TDs.

DENNIS SMITH, DESCRIBED BY HIS COACH TEBB KUSSEROW AS "A PLAYER WITH THE ABILITY TO START ON EITHER OFFENSE OR DEFENSE AS A FRESHMAN AT A MAJOR COLLEGE," WAS NAMED TO THE DEFENSIVE UNIT (AS HE WAS LAST YEAR) ALTHOUGH HE CAUGHT 33 PASSES FOR 777 YDS. (23.5-YD. AVG.) AND 11 TOUCHDOWNS. A "DEVASTATING BLOCKER FROM CLOSED FORMATIONS," DENNIS WAS NO LESS ABLE ON DEFENSE, WHERE HE PLAYED THE CORNERS AS WELL AS DEEP SAFETY WITH EQUAL EFFECTIVENESS.

HERTEL - SMITH & ALL-STARS HONORED AT MAGIC MT. ON SAT., JAN. 22 FOR 4TH YEAR

The 40th Annual All-Southern California Board of Football Awards Program will be held at Magic Mountain Park in Valencia on Saturday morning, Jan. 22 at 10:30 a.m. All players named for all-star team honors, along with their coaches and high school administrators, will be specially invited guests. Coaches from the college ranks will also be special guests.

AMF - VOIT PRESENTS FOOTBALLS FOR 25TH YEAR

The AMF - VOIT INC. will again present miniature footballs to players honored on the 1976 all-star teams. The AMF VOIT people have kindly awarded these footballs to prep players in Southern California for the past 25 years...and make similar awards to honored players in Northern California.

Fifty-two players, representing 27 "AAAA" Division high schools make up this year's team. Just two players repeat...Dennis Smith, a defender on the 2nd team in '75 and Loyola's ace linebacker Bob Woolway, a 1st team '75 pick. Los Altos led the way by placing five players on the '76 squad and defeated Chaffey (22-14), Dos Pueblos (41-7), West Torrance (28-14), West Covina (21-16) and Fontana (27-0) in the finals...to win its third C.I.F. crown in the last five years.

**ROBBY CHAPMAN (SOUTH PASADENA TAILBACK)
NAMED TOP PLAYER IN C.I.F. 3-A FOOTBALL...**

ROBBY CHAPMAN, SOUTH PASADENA'S TWO-TIME ALL-CIF RUNNING BACK, HAS BEEN VOTED PLAYER OF THE YEAR IN "AAA" DIVISION FOOTBALL FOR 1976, BY THE CITIZENS SAVINGS ATHLETIC FOUNDATION'S ALL-SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA BOARD OF ATHLETICS. THIS MARKS THE 40TH YEAR THAT ALL-SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA BOARD OF ATHLETICS HAS MADE ITS SELECTIONS, WITH HONORED PLAYERS RECEIVING SUITABLE AWARDS FROM THE SPONSORING AGENCY.

LEADING THE SOUTH PASADENA TIGERS TO THE SEMI-FINALS OF THIS YEAR'S 3-A PLAYOFFS, ROBBY CHAPMAN RUSHED FOR 1,370 YARDS AND 13 TOUCHDOWNS. THE TIGERS, WHO WON THE TITLE GAME LAST YEAR AS CHAPMAN HAD A SEASON YARDAGE TOTAL OF 1,647 YARDS AND 18 TOUCHDOWNS, DEFEATED SANTA FE (14-9), TROY (20-17), AND LOMPOC (10-7) BEFORE BOWING TO VILLA PARK (20-13) IN THE SEMIS. CHAPMAN AMASSED A TWO-YEAR YARDAGE TOTAL OF 3,017 YARDS AND 31 TOUCHDOWNS IN HIS TWO SPECTACULAR SEASONS AND THE 6-2, 190-POUND SENIOR WAS ONE OF THREE SOUTH PAS TIGERS TO MAKE THE 3-A ALL-STARS.
