FOUNTAIN VALLEY WIDE RECEIVER, EMILE HARRY, TOPS C.I.F. DIV. I GRID SELECTIONS FOR 1980

EMILE HARRY, 6-1 175-POUND WIDE RECEIVER FROM FOUNTAIN VALLEY HIGH SCHOOL HAS BEEN NAMED CIF DIVISION I (BIG 5 CONFERENCE) PLAYER OF THE YEAR BY MEMBERS OF THE CITIZENS SAVINGS ATHLETIC FOUNDATION'S PREP SELECTION BOARD. THE LEADING RECEIVER IN ORANGE COUNTY, HARRY IMPRESSED FANS AND OPPONENTS ALIKE AS HE RECORDED OVER 50 CATCHES AND 1,000-PLUS YARDS.

FOUNTAIN VALLEY LOST TO EDISON IN THIS YEAR'S BIG 5 CONFERENCE PLAYOFF, 14-0 AND FINISHED THE SEASON 11-3. PRIOR TO ITS LOSS TO EDISON, THE BARONS DEFEATED EISENHOWER (36-13), LOS ALTOS (20-12) AND ST. PAUL (23-6). EDISON'S CHARGERS IN WINNING THEIR SECOND BIG 5 CROWN (55-0 OVER REDLANDS IN '79) BEAT SERVITE (35-0), COLTON (34-14), ST. FRANCIS (39-6) AND FOUNTAIN VALLEY IN THE FINALE...14-0 TO MATCH THEIR SEASON RECORD.

Thirty-three players representing 14 high schools are on this year's Div. I All-Star Team. As expected, Edison placed more players on the team than any other conference school....six. Both Fountain Valley and St. Paul landed four representatives, with Los Altos placing three. St. John Bosco, St. Francis, Mater Dei, Bishop Montgomery and Fontana have two players.

All players named for Division I (Big 5 Conf.) all-star team honors will be invited to attend the 44th annual Citizens Savings Athletic Foundation Awards Program, Sat. Jan. 31st. Location of this year's program is pending.

DIVISION III FOOTBALL PLAYER OF THE YEAR BY MEMBERS OF THE CITIZENS SAVINGS ATHLETIC FOUNDATION'S ALL-SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA BOARD OF ATHLETICS. STEFAN DERRICK, L.B. POLY QB, VOTED MVP IN C.I.F. DIV. II FOOTBALL FOR '80 SEASON

STEFAN DERRICK, ALL-TIME LONG BEACH POLY QUARTERBACK WHO LED THE JACK-RABBITS TO THE COASTAL CONFERENCE C.I.F. FOOTBALL CHAMPIONSHIPS, HAS BEEN NAMED SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA C.I.F. DIVISION II PLAYER OF THE YEAR BY MEMBERS OF THE CITIZENS SAVINGS ATHLETIC FOUNDATION'S PREP SELECTION BOARD. THE 6-1 185-POUND SENIOR WAS NAMED THE OUTSTANDING PERFORMER AMONG GRIDDERS PERFORMING IN THE SOUTHERN, COASTAL AND NORTHWESTERN CONFERENCES.

DERRICK, WHO LED HIS TEAM TO AN 11-2 RECORD IN 1980, COMPLETED THE SEASON WITH 2,135 YARDS AND 23 TOUCHDOWNS. HIS FINAL PREP PERFORMANCE -- AGAINST SANTA BARBARA IN THE COASTAL CONFERENCE FINALS -- SAW HIM THROW FOR 251 YARDS AND FOUR TOUCHDOWNS. THE JACKRABBITS DEFEATED THE SANTA BARBARA DONS 35-7 IN THE FINALS. ON ITS WAY TO THE TITLE POLY DEFEATED CRESCENTA VALLEY (36-8), NORTH TORRANCE (24-3), AND ARCADIA (56-21) BEFORE DOWNING SANTA BARBARA.

POLY LANDED FIVE REPRESENTATIVES ON THE DIVISION II TEAMS, WHILE SOUTHERN CONFERENCE CHAMP LYNWOOD PLACED THREE. LIKE POLY, THE LYNWOOD KNIGHTS ALSO POSTED AN 11-2 SEASON RECORD. THEY DEFEATED EL MODENA IN THE FINALS OF THE SOUTHERN CONFERENCE PLAYOFFS, 14-13. IN EARLY-ROUND GAMES THEY DISPOSED OF CYPRESS (35-20), SANTA ANA (28-21) AND FOOTHILL (33-22).

SAN LUIS OBISPO, NORTHWESTERN CONFERENCE CHAMPION (7-0) OVER LOMPOC IN THE CHAMPIONSHIP DECIDER, BEAT BLAIR (21-20), LA CANADA (16-14) and BURROUGHS OF BURBANK (14-12 ON ITS WAY TO THE TITLE. THE S.L.O. TIGERS PLACED THREE PLAYERS ON THE ALL-STAR DIVISION II TEAM.
