EDISON'S CHARGERS IN WINNING THEIR SECOND BIG 5 CROWN (55-0 OVER REDLANDS IN '79) BEAT SERVITE (35-0), COLTON (34-14), ST. FRANCIS (39-6) AND FOUNTAIN VALLEY IN THE FINALE...14-0 TO MATCH THEIR SEASON RECORD.

Thirty-three players representing 14 high schools are on this year's Div. 1 All-Star Team. As expected, Edison placed more players on the team than any other conference school....six. Both Fountain Valley and St. Paul landed four representatives, with Los Altos placing three. St. John Bosco, St. Francis, Mater Dei, Bishop Montgomery and Fontana have two players.
