ALL - SOUTHERN SECTION FOOTBALL TEAM SALUTES
SOUTHLAND'S TOP GRID TALENT FOR 1985 SEASON...

Prep Writers Pick Premier Pigskin Team.....

FOR RELEASE: FRIDAY, JAN. 3 AMs and after ***WATCH RELEASE DATE!!!

ALL-SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA BOARD OF ATHLETICS, FOR THE FIRST TIME IN 1985, HAS SELECTED AN ALL-SOUTHERN SECTION FOOTBALL TEAM COMPOSED OF THE TOP FOOTBALL PLAYERS FROM THE NINE CONFERENCES OF THE CIF SOUTHERN SECTION. PRIOR TO THIS YEAR, THE 25-MEMBER BOARD OF SPORTS JOURNALISTS PICKED SEVERAL DIVISIONAL TEAMS, WITH THE VARIOUS CONFERENCES RANDOMLY PLACED IN FOUR DIVISIONS. THE BOARD'S 49TH ANNUAL SELECTION MEETING WAS HELD IN CULVER CITY AND A SINGLE "PREMIER" TEAM WAS NAMED...TWELVE PLAYERS ON OFFENSE AND TWELVE PLAYERS ON DEFENSE. THE BOARD ALSO VOTED TO ELIMINATE, FOR THE 1985 SEASON AT LEAST, THE SELECTION OF AN MVP FOR THE PREMIER SOUTHLAND TEAM. THERE WERE FIVE CONFERENCE MVPs OR CO-MVPs ON THE TEAM AND THE BOARD VOTE REFLECTED THE FACT THAT WITH SO MUCH TALENT A SINGLE MVP FROM THE GROUP MIGHT WELL PROVE UNFAIR.

Seven of the Southern Section nine conferences are represented on the 1985 all-star team. As expected the Big 5 Conference led the way with nine representatives. The Northwestern Conference placed four players, with the Eastern and Coastal Conferences placing three each. The Southern and South-Eastern Conferences landed two players each, while the Central Conference had one player named.

Nine players named to the All-Southern Section team represent Conference championship teams. A like number are repeaters from last year, each selected on a 1984 divisional all-star team.

[S] HANE FOLEY, NEWPORT HARBOR QUARTERBACK WHO LED THE SEAVIEW LEAGUE CHAMPIONS TO THE SEMI-FINALS OF THE CENTRAL CONFERENCE CHAMPIONSHIPS, HAS BEEN VOTED CENTRAL CONFERENCE PLAYER OF THE YEAR BY MEMBERS OF THE ALL-SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA BOARD OF ATHLETICS IN ANNUAL MEETINGS HELD IN CULVER CITY RECENTLY. FOLEY, WHO WOUND UP THE SOUTHERN SECTION'S 4TH RATED PASSER, ACCOUNTED FOR 5,000 YARDS OVER TWO SEASONS WITH THE SAILORS.

Newport Harbor lost to Garden Grove League Champion La Quinta in the playoffs, 42-29. La Quinta, in turn, lost to the Sea View League's No. 2 playoff entry Saddleback, 34-28. MVP Shane Foley completed 166 aerials for 2,332 yards during a ten-game regular season and registered 23 touchdowns.

MIKE REDDINGTON, WHO LED COACH STEVE CARNES' LEUZINGER OLYMPIANS TO THE DESERT-MOUNTAIN CONFERENCE CHAMPIONSHIP, HAS BEEN NAMED PLAYER OF THE YEAR BY MEMBERS OF THE SOUTHLAND'S ALL-SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA BOARD OF FOOTBALL, COMPOSED OF PREP SPORTS JOURNALISTS FROM THROUGHOUT THE SOUTHLAND. IT WAS THE FIRST TIME THAT THE SELECTION BOARD HAS NAMED ALL-CONFERENCE TEAMS, SINCE THE CONFERENCE CONCEPT WAS INSTITUTED BY THE CIF SOUTHERN SECTION SEVERAL YEARS AGO.

DAN McGWIRE, CLAREMONT QUARTERBACK, NAMED MVP IN EASTERN CONFERENCE FOR '85 GRID SEASON.....

DAN McGWIRE, CLAREMONT HIGH'S 6-8, 220-POUND SENIOR QUARTERBACK, HAD NO OP-POSITION FOR PLAYER OF THE YEAR HONORS IN 1985 AND THE ALL-SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA BOARD OF ATHLETICS PROMPTLY STAMPED THE TWO-YEAR ALL-STAR TEAM SELECTION AS THE EASTERN LEAGUE'S BEST FOR 1985. IN DIRECTING CLAREMONT TO ITS SECOND STRAIGHT CONFERENCE TITLE AND 27TH VICTORY IN 28 GAMES, McGWIRE COMPLETED 204 AERIALS FOR 3,172 YARDS AND 33 TDs. McGWIRE'S CAREER PASSING TOTALS ARE 6,559 PASSING YARDS AND 65 TOUCHDOWNS, PLACING HIM FIFTH ON THE ALL-TIME STATE LIST IN BOTH CATEGORIES.

Claremont defeated Damien of LaVerne for the Eastern Conference title, 37-22. In that game, McGwire passed for 303 yards and two touchdowns. Along the way, the Cougars who were Baseline League champions defeated Workman (59-12), Arlington (6-3), Norco (38-13) and Damien in the finals to conclude a 13-1 season.

A LL - SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA BOARD OF ATHLETICS, AT RECENTLY HELD ALL-STAR TEAM SELECTION MEETINGS, MADE ITS ANNUAL PREP PICKS AND FOR THE FIRST TIME SELECTED ALL-CONFERENCE TEAMS ALONG WITH A SINGLE (OFFENSE/DEFENSE) PREMIER ALL-SOUTHERN SECTION TEAM. AND IT WAS RICHE SWINTON, WHO LED MONTCLAIR PREP TO THE ALPHA LEAGUE CHAMPIONSHIP AND INTO THE INLAND CONFERENCE FINALS VS. TEHACHAPI, THAT WAS NAMED MVP OF THE CONFERENCE. SWINTON, WHO GAINED 2,265 YARDS (8.2 YD. AVG.) AND SCORED 26 TOUCHDOWNS DURING A 10-4 SEASON, WAS NAMED AS A DEFENSIVE BACK ON THE ALL-CONFERENCE TEAM. HE INTERCEPTED 6 PASSES DURING THE YEAR. THE MOUNTIES DEFEATED BISHOP (14-0), ONTARIO CHRISTIAN (35-0) AND PARACLETE (31-8), BEFORE LOSING TO TEHACHAPI IN THE CONFERENCE FINALS, 17-7. TEHACHAPI SHUT OUT THREE OPPONENTS -- L.A.
