THE BOARD'S 49TH ANNUAL SELECTION MEETING WAS HELD IN CULVER CITY AND A SINGLE "PREMIER" TEAM WAS NAMED...TWELVE PLAYERS ON OFFENSE AND TWELVE PLAYERS ON DEFENSE. THE BOARD ALSO VOTED TO ELIMINATE, FOR THE 1985 SEASON AT LEAST, THE SELECTION OF AN MVP FOR THE PREMIER SOUTHLAND TEAM.
