

# ALL-SOUTHERN SECTION FOOTBALL TEAM - 1987

## Big 5 Conference Places 11, Southern Lands 6

**[A]**LL-SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA BOARD OF ATHLETICS RELEASED ITS 51ST ANNUAL SOUTHERN SECTION ALL-STAR FOOTBALL TEAM TODAY, FOLLOWING THE BOARD'S ANNUAL GRIDIRON SELECTIONS IN CULVER CITY. AS WAS TRUE LAST YEAR, THE BIG FIVE CONFERENCE LED ALL OTHER EIGHT CONFERENCES IN PLAYERS NAMED. ALSO REFLECTING A FEELING HELD OVER THE LAST TWO SEASONS, NO PLAYER OF THE YEAR SELECTION WAS MADE. WITH SO MUCH TALENT REPRESENTING THE NINE CONFERENCES OF THE SOUTHERN SECTION, IT HAS BEEN FELT THAT THE SELECTION OF AN MVP MIGHT PROVE UNFAIR.

Eleven players represent the Big Five Conference on this year's team, with conference MVP Russell White of Crespi holding down one of the three running-back positions. The Southern Conference, with co-MVPs Bret Johnson (El Toro) and Glyn Milburn (Santa Monica) leading the way, placed six players. Milburn set a new Southern Section single-season rushing record, registering 2,716 net yards and scored 38 rushing TDs (plus one on a punt return), also a Southern Section high water mark.

Four players named to the All-Southern Section Team represent Conference Championship Teams....with three players named from runner-up schools. Crespi High's Russ White is the lone repeater from 1986 and he is one of four juniors to make the premier team.

Players named to this year's All-Southern Section Team will be recipients of beautiful framed scroll awards from First Interstate Bank & The Amateur Athletic Foundation of Los Angeles. This year marks the 51st year that the Athletic Foundation's All-Southern California Board of Athletics has named southland all-star teams. These selections, dating back to 1937, are on file in the Foundation library. All-Southern Section selections follow:

# CRESPI HIGH'S RUSSELL WHITE REPEATS AS BIG 5 CONFERENCE PLAYER OF YEAR FOR 1987 SEASON....

**F**OR THE SECOND STRAIGHT SEASON, COACH BILL REDELL'S POWERFUL RUNNING BACK AT CRESPI HIGH, RUSSELL WHITE, HAS BEEN ACCLAIMED THE TOP PERFORMER IN BIG FIVE CONFERENCE FOOTBALL. WHITE, A COUSIN OF FORMER USC HEISMAN TROPHY WINNER CHARLES WHITE, WOUND UP NUMBER EIGHT AMONG REGULAR-SEASON RUSHING BACKS WITH 1,526 YARDS IN NINE GAMES. PRIOR TO LOSING TO EVENTUAL CHAMPION FONTANA, WHITE CARRIED 202 TIMES FOR 2,085 YARDS AND 33 TOUCHDOWNS. HE ALSO REGISTERED 14 PASS-RECEPTIONS FOR 284 YARDS AND FOUR TDs.

As a sophomore on Crespi High's Big Five Conference Champions of 1986, White rushed for 2,339 yards and 31 touchdowns. The Celts were 13-1 last year and 10-2-1 in '87.

Coach Dick Bruich's Fontana Steelers completed a perfect 14-0 season, winning the Citrus Belt League title and defeating Fountain Valley, the Sunset League's best, 14-0. The Steelers Derrick Malone, who placed 14th on the regular-season rushing list, raced for 1,386 yards and 19 touchdowns, with a 7.5 yard average.

Four other conference running backs sparkled during '87...Mazio Royster of Bishop Amat, Derek Brown of Servite, Dennis Collier of Eisenhower and Jason McGehee of Huntington Beach. McGehee wound up 7th on the Southern Section rushing list, with 1,544 net yards, averaging 7.6 yards per carry. Collier averaged 7.5 yards and 1,384 yards, Brown 5.6 yards and 1,097 yards and Royster had a 5.8 yard average and 1,261 yards.

All honored athletes receive awards from First Interstate Bank & The Amateur Athletic Foundation of Los Angeles. The Big Five Conf. team follows.

# DAMON FISHER (BOLSA GRANDE) & MIKE EDWARDS (VALENCIA) SHARE CENTRAL CONF. MVP HONOR ...

**A** LL - SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA BOARD OF ATHLETICS, COMPOSED OF SOUTHLAND SPORTS JOURNALISTS COVERING HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETICS, NAMED DAMON FISHER AND MIKE EDWARDS CO-PLAYERS OF THE YEAR IN CENTRAL CONFERENCE FOOTBALL FOR THE 1987 SEASON. ANNUAL TEAMS WERE RELEASED TODAY BY FIRST INTERSTATE BANK & THE AMATEUR ATHLETIC FOUNDATION OF LOS ANGELES, SPONSORING ORGANIZATIONS.

Edwards, named as a defensive back on last year's Central Conf. team, made the '87 squad as a wide receiver. He caught 42 aeriels for 625 yards and six touchdowns and also played a strong game on defense.

Fisher, also returning from the '86 team when named on offense, had even interceptions during the regular season. He gained 1,048 on offense in 11 games and scored 15 touchdowns.

Valencia, Orange League champions, finished '87 with an overall record of 12-2. The Tigers defeated Santiago (27-0), Corona del Mar (16-7), and Pacifica (21-9), before blanking Anaheim (13-0) and winning the school's first ever Southern Section football title. Anaheim came into the game 10-2-1.

All-Southern California Board of Athletics, sponsored by the Amateur Athletic Foundation and organized some 51 years ago (1937) by the Helms Athletic Foundation, selects all-star teams at the close of each season in football, basketball and baseball. Players and coaches receive recognition at the close of each season, receiving awards from First Interstate Bank and The Amateur Athletic Foundation of Los Angeles.

# THOUSAND OAKS TAILBACK, MARC MONESTIME, NAMED PLAYER OF YEAR IN COASTAL CONFERENCE FOR 1987

**M**ARC MONESTIME, SENIOR TAILBACK FOR COACH BOB RICHARDS' COASTAL CONFERENCE CHAMPION THOUSAND OAKS LANCERS, HAS BEEN VOTED PLAYER OF THE YEAR BY MEMBERS OF THE FIRST INTERSTATE BANK - AMATEUR ATHLETIC FOUNDATION OF LOS ANGELES AWARDS BOARD. MEMBERS OF THE ATHLETIC FOUNDATION'S ALL-SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA BOARD OF ATHLETICS HAS BEEN NAMING ALL-STAR TEAMS IN THE SOUTHLAND SINCE 1937.

In winning the school's first-ever football title, Thousand Oaks completed a 12-1-1 season. Although the Lancers lost the Marmonte League Championship to Channel Islands, they came back to defeat the Raiders 27-12 in the Coastal Conference title game.

Monestime, a 5-11, 187-pound senior tailback, rushed for 1,653 yards overall in '87, scoring 19 touchdowns. Over his prep career, Marc gained 4,042 yards making him the all-time Ventura County rushing leader.

Thousand Oaks defeated San Marcos (35-6), Palmdale (31-7) and Antelope Valley (34-14) before running into Channel Islands in the title-decider. The Raiders bettered Quartz Hill (27-19), Hueneme (39-21) and Canyon (42-6) on their way to the championship game.

This marks the 51st year that All-Southern California Board of Football has made all-star team selections in the southland. Over the years, many of the top collegiate and professional athletes have been named to these all-star teams. All players named for honors on the Coastal Conference teams will be recipients of First Interstate Bank - Amateur Athletic Foundation of Los Angeles awards. Coaches and conference MVPs will also receive awards. Honor teams follow:

**A**LL - SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA BOARD OF ATHLETICS RELEASED ITS ANNUAL SOUTHEASTERN CONFERENCE TEAM TODAY, AND CAJON HIGH SCHOOL'S STAR TAILBACK, MIKE BEAUREGARD, WAS ACCLAIMED SOUTHEASTERN CONFERENCE PLAYER OF THE YEAR FOR 1987. FIRST INTERSTATE BANK AND THE AMATEUR ATHLETIC FOUNDATION OF LOS ANGELES SPONSOR THE AWARDS FOR HIGH SCHOOL FOOTBALL PLAYERS AND COACHES EACH YEAR.

Coach Chuck Pettersen's "mighty-mite" tailback led the Cajon Cowboys to the San Andreas League title in '87 and the Southeastern Conference Championship. Beauregard, among the Southern Section's top 10 rushers during the regular season, (1,524 yards & 19 TDs), wound up with 2,197 yards and 25 touchdowns on the year. He averaged 7.79 yards per carry (282 attempts) and led Santa Barbara County in rushing. He ran for a school record 312 yards (24 carries) against Arroyo in a title-winning effort, 44-6. Cajon concluded its season 13-1.

On its way to the conference championship, Cajon defeated Bonita (24-7), Rosemead (21-14) and Baldwin Park (16-14) before meeting Arroyo in the title decider. Arroyo won the Southeastern crown last year 7-3 over Victor Valley.

# BRET JOHNSON (EL TORO) & GLYN MILBURN (SANTA MONICA) NAMED CO-MVPs IN SOUTHERN CONFERENCE

Two of the Southland's finest gridgers -- quarterback Bret Johnson of El Toro High School and runnings back Glyn Milburn of Santa Monica -- have been named co-players of the year in the Southern Conference of the C.I.F., as annual all-star football team selections were made last week in Culver City. It marks the 51st year that all-southern California board of football, composed of Southland sports journalists, has made all-star team selections.

El Toro High School won the Southern Conference Championship on the gifted arm of senior quarterback Bret Johnson, called by many the top QB in Southern California. Johnson threw for 22 touchdowns in '87 and over the regular ten game season completed 132 passes (241 attempts) for 2,091 yards.

In the 36-6 championship win over Los Alamitos, Bret passed for 175 yards and three TDs in the first half alone. He completed 60 percent of his passes during the season. This was El Toro's second straight conference title.

Santa Monica's senior running back, Glyn Milburn, registered a phenomenal 2,713 rushing yards in 11 games in 1987 and had nine straight 200-plus yards games. He set a new Southern Section scoring record, with 39 touchdowns, 38 rushing and one on a punt return.
