ALL - SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA BOARD OF ATHLETICS RELEASED ITS 53RD ANNUAL SOUTHERN SECTION ALL-STAR FOOTBALL TEAM TODAY, FOLLOWING THE BOARD'S GRIDIRON SELECTIONS IN CULVER CITY. THIS YEAR'S TEAM REFLECTS THE FINEST PLAYERS REPRESENTING THE NINE DIVISIONS OF THE SOUTHERN SECTION, WITH DIVISION I ATHLETES LEADING THE PARADE AS IN YEAR'S PAST.

Only the cream of southland prep football talent has been selected on the board's "super" team, made up of 11 players on both offense and defense. A kicker and punter have also been named to the team.

With so much talent on the annual "super" team, no player of the year has been named. With division MVPs crowding the "super" team, the board felt an MVP selection might prove unfair.

Six division champion or co-champion teams are represented on the "super" squad. Fontana (Div. 1), Muir & Santa Barbara (Co-Champs in Div. 2), Paramount (Div. 3), Glendora (Co-Champs in Div. 4) and Serra (Div. 7).

Players named for this year's All-Southern Section Football Team will receive beautiful framed scroll awards from First Interstate Bank - Amateur Athletic Foundation of Los Angeles.

BOBBY SYLVESTER, FONTANA LB/FULLBACK AND RON RIVERS, SAN
GORGONIO TAILBACK/SAFETY, VOTED DIV. I CO-PLAYERS OF YEAR

BOBBY SYLVESTER, TWO-TIME DIV. I PICK AND DEFENSIVE LEADER OF COACH DICK BRUICH'S OUTSTANDING VARSITY AND TAILBACK RON RIVERS, WHO RACED FOR OVER 2,000 YARDS AND SCORED 29 TOUCHDOWNS FOR COACH KARL GAYTAN AT SAN GORGONIO, HAVE BEEN VOTED CO-PLAYERS OF THE YEAR FOR 1989 BY MEMBERS OF THE FIRST INTERSTATE BANK - AMATEUR ATHLETIC FOUNDATION OF LOS ANGELES' ALL-STAR TEAM SELECTION COMMITTEE.

ANNUAL SELECTIONS WERE MADE RECENTLY IN CULVER CITY.

Citrus Belt League Champion Fontana completed a perfect 14-0 season with its convincing 35-7 win over league rival San Gorgonio in the division final. The Steelers are 38-2 over the past three years.

As a fullback, Sylvester was 159/959 yards and 13 TDs. As a linebacker 115 unassisted tackles and 10 knockdown passes. Rivers, number six in the state in rushing was 296/2,094 yards and 29 TDs. As a strong safety, he had six interceptions, three for touchdowns.

On its way to a perfect season, Fontana upended Fountain Valley 51-6, Wilson, Long Beach 28-0, and Edison 48-35 before closing out the year against San Gorgonio. The Spartans defeated Ocean View 32-24, Poly, Long Beach 14-6, and Loyola 21-12 and finished its season 10-4 after the loss to Fontana.

PONCHO RENTERIA, SANTA BARBARA DONS SENIOR QUARTERBACK, WHO DIRECTED COACH MANUEL GARCIA'S 12-1-1 TEAM TO A CO-DIVISION II TITLE THIS PAST GRIDIRON SEASON, HAS BEEN VOTED PLAYER OF THE YEAR FOR 1989. THE SELECTION OF ~~GARCIA~~ ^{RENTERIA}, ALONG WITH ANNUAL ALL-STAR TEAM PICKS, WAS MADE RECENTLY IN CULVER CITY.

Channel League Champion Santa Barbara met Pacific L. runner-up team Muir for the division title...the game ending in a 7-7 tie. Division MVP Renteria completed 128 of 201 aerials for 2,098 and 29 touchdowns during the Dons 14 game season. He threw only three interceptions, two of them coming in the championship game.

Muir, which tied for the division crown under first-year coach John Tyree, completed its season 9-1-2. The Mustangs defeated Quartz Hill 27-14, San Marcos 28-0, and Thousand Oaks 9-3 in overtime before entering the finals.

Santa Barbara whipped Crescenta Valley 44-7, Newbury Park 14-6, and Canyon, CC 28-27 in overtime to reach the title match.

VOTED CO-PLAYERS OF THE YEAR IN DIVISION IV FOOTBALL FOR '89

TWO OUTSTANDING BACKS, WHO GUIDED THEIR RESPECTIVE TEAMS TO A CO-CHAMPIONSHIP IN DIVISION IV FOOTBALL FOR 1989, HAVE BEEN NAMED CO-PLAYERS OF THE YEAR BY FIRST INTERSTATE BANK - AMATEUR ATHLETIC FOUNDATION'S ALL-SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA BOARD OF ATHLETICS. ANNUAL SELECTIONS OF THE SOUTHERN SECTION, CIF ALL-STAR TEAMS WERE MADE RECENTLY IN CULVER CITY.

Troy Thomas finished the regular season 6th among Southern Section running backs with 1,569 yards and 23 touchdowns. He averaged over eight yards per carry. O'Laughlin passed for 1,700-plus yards for co-division champion Glendora...200 of which came in the playoff-final tie with Ramona, 28-28.

Ramona, which wound up second to Palm Springs in the Ivy League, finished the season 9-3-2. The Rams beat Bell Gardens 26-9, Wilson, HH 54-12 and Upland 35-7 before finishing in a 28-28 tie with Baseline League champion Glendora.

Glendora defeated Montebello 35-8, Los Altos 16-3 and Nogales 27-12 before ending its season with the title-tie and a 12-1-1 record.
