Determination of Playoff Divisions – Flag Football

With the passage of the new competitive equity playoff system (CIFSS Council, January 2024), and changes to Bylaws 3519 and 3520, the way we group playoff divisions has changed. To summarize, playoff divisions will be created at the end of the regular season based on a team's current win/loss data.

It is imperative that coaches/athletic directors enter their full schedule and score results consistently throughout the season. Member schools who fail to accurately enter complete regular season results into the CIFSSHome system will not be placed into a playoff division and will be ineligible to participate in the Southern Section Championship Playoff Tournament.

Schools (via the coach and/or AD email) have been getting updates of missing scores throughout the season. Those vacancies must be filled. Schools tend to use "TBA" as opponent names in tournament situations as placeholders. Please review your results carefully, entering actual tournament opponents played and the game scores. Please look through your schedule and scores on CIFSSHome (not another platform) as all data retrieval will be from CIFSSHome.

Massey Ratings, the same power ranking system the CIFSS has used in various sports since 2014, will continue to be used. The only thing changing is the timeframe of data used to feed this system. Previously, the two most recent year's results would feed Massey Ratings for pre-season divisional placement. Now, only the current year will be used for in-season divisional placement. The benefit of this is being placed in a division based on the accolades of the team a school currently has, rather than the success of the team in the two previous years.

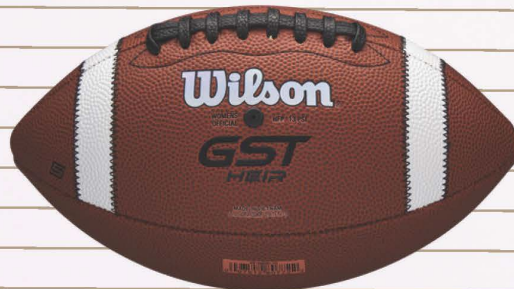

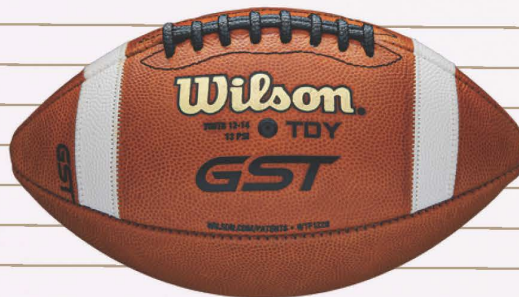

*The official ball rule is mandatory for all CIF-SS playoff rounds.

Official Ball Rule:

Should a school fail to provide the correct game ball, the game will always be played. Teams/schools failing to utilize the correct official ball in CIF-SS playoffs will be reported by officials to CIF-SS and will not be allowed to host their next available home playoff game. Penalty will carry over to the next season if not enforceable this season due to elimination.

CIFSSHOME REQUIREMENTS

SCHEDULES & SCORES Complete your schedule in CIFSSHome prior to your season as well as update scores following each contest

Attention Athletic Directors/Coaches: It is very important that you enter your entire season schedule into CIFSSHOME (www.cifsshome.org) as well as update the scores immediately following your contests.

Log in @ www.cifsshome.org (If you do not have a log in & password as a coach, check with your Athletic Director). Once you are logged in:

- On the left panel, click on "Teams", select "Flag Football, Girls"

To Add a game:

- On the left panel, click on "Events", select "Add Event", choose Game under "Event Type", choose date of game under "Event Date", choose **Flag Football, Girls** under "Sport", choose Varsity under "Level", type the opposing school name in "Add Opponent", choose the type of game under "Select Game Type", click on Home, Away or Neutral under "Location", choose "Start Time"
Click on "Save" to add one game or "Save & Duplicate" for multiple games.

- To Submit your score:

- On the left panel, click on "Teams", select "Teams Manager", scroll down to "**Flag Football, Girls**" and click on VR to add Varsity scores
Click on "Post Result" button, enter your team's score, enter the opponent's score, result should auto populate with either "W", "L" or "T" based on the correct match score entered. If the game was a forfeit, click on the Yes box, enter the set scores in "Notes".

Make sure that your overall and team records are correct on your team page

Log in @ www.cifsshome.org (If you do not have a log in & password as a coach, check with your Athletic Director).

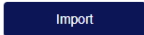

PLAYOFF FORMAT

4- team leagues are guaranteed two entries into the 2025-2026 Girls' Flag Football Playoffs, 5-6 team leagues are guaranteed three entries and 7-8 team leagues are guaranteed four entries. Freelance teams may fill byes in each divisional draw, or teams submitted by leagues, who qualify for an At-Large entry. **See rule 3414.1 for rules regarding "At-Large" entries.**

Note: The 2025-2026 Girls' Flag Football At Large Form must be submitted by your school using the online CIFSSHome Application (www.cifsshome.org), **no later than 8:00 p.m. on WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 15, 2025.**

RULE 3510 - FREE LANCE PLAYOFF ENTRY VERIFICATION

If a school does not have membership in a league or the school belongs to a league which does not offer students in a given sport an opportunity to qualify into CIF Southern Section championships, special conditions exist which must be followed in order to qualify for possible entry into a CIF Southern Section playoff activity.

3510.1 Team Sports - All free-lance schools desiring entry into the playoffs must submit schedules to the Commissioner for evaluation and approval of conditions under which the team may qualify. Schedules must be submitted prior to the start of each season for evaluation.

Q & A - How can a freelance team qualify for CIF playoff consideration?

You must schedule 80% of allowable games per sport and they must be at the varsity level, and in order to be considered for the playoffs, the school must have a .500 or better record in all contests played and there must be openings in the bracket. Additionally, teams that win 80% of their contests played will be guaranteed entry. (Except football.)

DATE OF LAST CONTEST

By Southern Section Council action, **ALL** contests must be completed by **WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 15, 2025.**

DETERMINATION OF HOST TEAMS

FIRST-ROUND CONTESTS - An asterisk (*) on the draw sheet will indicate the host school for all first-round contests.

FACILITY REQUIREMENTS – ALL DIVISIONS AND ALL ROUNDS

- Field – The field size for the CIF postseason and playoffs will be 40 yards wide by 80 yards long with two 10 yard endzones.
- Team Area: 2 yards from each sideline and between the 20-yard markers. The team box will be marked with either discs, cones or lines.
- The line to gain will be marked at the 20-yard line sideline, 40-yard sideline and 20-yard sideline with a disc or cone.
- The Goal Line and the End Line will be marked with Pylons.
- The restricted area is the area extending two yards outside the perimeter of the entire field (i.e., outside both sidelines and end lines). This restricted area is designated by the restraining line.
 - The restraining line is coned or lined mark on the field, at least 2 yards from the sideline.
 - The restraining line is the field sideline of the team box.
- The team box is the area immediately outside the restricted area between the 20-yard lines on each side of the field. With limited exceptions, nonplayers include coaches, team personnel, spectators, game administrators and members of the media.

SECOND-ROUND CONTESTS

The host school for these rounds will be determined in accordance with Section 3404, of the CIF-SS Blue Book. **In all divisions and in all rounds, the host school will be responsible for securing a field that meets the championship standards of 80x40.**

All Championship Finals will be held at the Fred Kelly Stadium in Orange and will be managed by the CIF Southern Section.

PRE –FLIPS

For ALL Rounds we will be conducting pre-flips to give schools immediate notice of their next game location. When the pairings are released on **FRIDAY, OCTOBER 17, 2025**, the draw will indicate home and away teams. That day we will also do pre-flips to determine the host school in the next round. Each morning following games played in your division, we will do pre-flips for the round following your next round.

Coin Flip results will be available @ www.cifss.org after 10:00 a.m. the morning of the flip.

TEAM BENCHES – ALL DIVISIONS ALL ROUNDS

Each school will get a max of 30 participant entry tickets (this is for your players, coaches, assistant coaches, trainers, etc.), anyone your school intends to be on the field in the bench area. Nonparticipants ARE NOT ON THE FIELD. For rounds with ticket sales, any additional tickets needs must be purchased. “Faculty Supervisors” are in the stands with parent, student, fan sections for supervision (they are not in the bench area). All 30 (or less) participants in the bench area MUST BE ROSTERED. The bench area IS NOT for Board Members, Faculty Supervisors (who we need in the stands supervising), JV and lower-level non playing athletes, etc.

PLAYING RULES

All playoff games will be conducted according to the 2025-2026 National Federation Flag Football Rules (previously distributed to all CIF-SS Girls’ Flag Football coaches), except where superseded by the CIF-SS Blue Book, or this bulletin.

HOME/AWAYS TEAMS

The home team will use the bench area as well as begin the competition to the left from the vantage point of the scorers’ table. The away team will use the bench area as well as begin the competition to the right from the vantage point of the press box.

OFFICIALS

The CIF-SS Office will assign officials for all flag football playoff games. Fees for officials will be:

Single Game (Playoff Rounds) -- \$83.00 each official, during all playoff rounds

Championship Final -- \$92.00 each official

Upon request, the host school will be provided the names of the officials by a representative of the CIF-SS Office.

GAME BALLS

Participating teams will furnish their own balls for pre-game warm-ups and practice sessions. It will be the responsibility of the host team to provide an official game ball (Wilson), as specified in the National Federation Rules, and per CIF Southern Section contract. **All playoff contests must be played using the Wilson ball.** The CIF Southern Section will furnish the Wilson ball for all Championship Final games.

Overtime Procedure

If the game is tied in the end of regulation, there will be a 3:00 minute period between the end of the game and the beginning of the first overtime period. The head coach from each team will join the referee in the center of the field for a coin toss where the winner of the toss will have the choice of offense or defense to begin the overtime period. The loser of the coin toss will have the choice of which end zone will be used for the overtime period. The end zone chosen will be used for all overtime periods until a winner is decided. In each over time, each team will have the opportunity to possess the ball. Each team will have 4 downs to score from the 20-yard line. All turnovers and extra points are 'live ball' and may be returned for a score. In a single overtime period, if, after scoring, a team causes a turnover, the game is over. At the start of the second overtime period, the team who was on defense to begin the first overtime period, will be on offense to begin the second overtime period. This rotation will continue for all overtime periods until a winner is determined.

After the second overtime period (beginning in the 3rd overtime period) all teams must attempt for a two-point try from the 10-yard line (unless the spot of the ball is moved by foul).

FLAGS

- A one-piece flag belt without any knots.
- One flag on each hip (2 flags total)
- Flag size 2” wide by 15’ length. (A flag with no more than 5% variability will be legal).
- Flags MUST be removable from the belt.
- Flags may not be altered in width or length (from their original manufacturer size) and may have no tape on them.

An unaltered flag belt of the same single solid color, with two flags of the same single solid color and a minimum flag dimension of 1 ½ inch by 14 inches. No article of clothing may cover the flag or belt. The belt must be worn in such a way that one flag is located on each hip. (Note: State associations may determine the style of flag used and flag measurements (may not be below minimum)).

PANTS, SHORTS OR SKIRT

Pants, shorts or skirts which shall not have pockets of any type, exposed drawstrings, belts and/or belt loops. **The color of the pants, shorts or skirts shall be the same single solid color that clearly contrast that with the color of the flag and flag belt.**

ADMISSION CHARGES

- A. Preliminary Rounds -- As per Article 1, Section 143 of the CIF-SS Blue Book, there will be no admission charged for games, except upon petition to the Commissioner's Office, by the principals of the schools involved. If written permission is granted, the prices are to be \$12.00 for Adults/Students without high school I.D., \$6.00 for Children/Students with proper high school I.D., and \$6.00 for children 13 & under.
- B. Championship Finals – Game schedule and admission prices for the finals will be as follows:

Fred Kelly Stadium – Friday, November 7 OR Saturday, November 8

Divisions will be assigned specific game times on Monday, November 3rd no later than 12:00 p.m.

Ticket Prices

\$14.00 Adults

\$7.00 High School Students (w/HS ID)

\$7.00 Children (13 & under)

Through the CIF-SS partnership with GoFan, all championship tickets will be made available online for digital purchase and presented electronically at the event gate for entry.

All seating at Fred Kelly Stadium will be general admission (first come, first served). This will allow the fans of competing schools to have an equal opportunity for seats. Schools are responsible for securing their own valuables. Valuables should not be left unattended. Each team should designate someone to secure those valuables and keep them in their possession at all times.

AWARDS

The following awards will be given during the playoffs:

- A. Championship Plaques - All first place teams.
- B. Runner-up Plaques - All second place teams.
- C. Championship Patches - 18 individual patches for members of all championship teams.
- D. Championship T-shirts - 18 t-shirts for members of all championship teams.
- E. Medals - 18 individual medals for members of all runner-up teams.
- F. Certificates - Individual participation certificates for members of each team participating in the playoffs are available at CIFSSHome (www.cifsshome.org), under the Forms tab.

Each member of a team participating in the CIF Southern Section playoffs can receive a CIF SOUTHERN SECTION PARTICIPATION CERTIFICATE. These certificates will be printed by your school. The document is in a "type-in" PDF format and can be found on CIFSSHOMe.

CHEERING SECTIONS

Fan/Student cheering sections are encouraged to cheer and support their own team and should display proper sportsmanship with respect to the opposing team and the game officials. They are expected to follow the following guidelines and failure to do so may lead to removal from the contest and/or forfeiture of the contest.

1. No noisemakers (horns, bells, victory bells, sirens, chimes, wooden blocks, balloons, thunder sticks, etc.). Megaphones may only be used by the school's uniformed cheer squads.
2. Cheering devices such as rally towels, pom poms and pennants are acceptable when used within the bounds of good sportsmanship.

3. It is the expectation that cheering section behavior will be monitored by the assigned school staff of the school that they represent. All improper behavior/language should be addressed and corrected immediately by school staff supervisors.
4. Face painting is acceptable from the neck up only and will not include any inappropriate letters or symbols. Assigned school staff shall monitor their cheering sections in regard to face painting.

CONTEST FINANCES

- A. If permission is granted to charge admission, the gross profit will be split equally between the schools, with the visitor paying its own travel expense and the host team paying the game expense.
- B. Concessions and Programs -- In all games except the finals, the host school reserves the right to handle programs and concessions as a separate venture, and need not share the profit, or expect the visiting school or CIF-SS, to share in any loss.
- C. Championship Finals -- When managed by the CIF-SS, all receipts will revert to the CIF-SS, who will pay game, facility, and award expenses.

PROTESTS OF PLAYOFF CONTESTS

By action of the CIF-SS Council at its March 1983 meeting, protests of playoff contests involving CIF State Flag Football rules will no longer be entertained following the conclusion of the contest.

Coaches may direct questions to the game officials as they pertain to a possible misapplication of the rules in accordance with the CIF State Flag Football rules governing that sport. No protest may be carried forth once the contest is completed.

Coaches are encouraged to carry CIF State Flag Football rulebooks with them for all playoff contests. Schools will still have the opportunity to protest a contest, in accordance with Southern Section Rule 1111, as it pertains to use of an ineligible player, or violations of any CIF-Southern Section rule in connection with the contest.

Rosters & Scores:

- Complete schedules are to be submitted to CIFSSHOME prior to each season.
 - Update scores following every contest direct to CIFSSHOME
- Additional directions on accessing CIFSSHOME are included in this document.

TV/Web/Radio Rights:

Any TV or streaming webcast (video or audio) or radio transmission of a CIF-SS playoff or championship event requires a contract and rights fees through the CIF-SS office prior to the contest. The only 'exceptions' are: Games broadcast via The NFHS Network, Spectrum Sports Net, Spectrum.

'Official' Championship Souvenirs:

The exclusive vendor for CIF Southern Section Championship souvenirs (t-shirts, scarfs, pins, beanies, hats, etc...) is our long-time partner *CIF T-shirts*. These are the official items sold each year per sport. You are likely familiar with their annual shirts at the finals. You can order team and individual items through them at www.ciftshirts.com.

Official Ball Required:

Only the approved official ball in each ball sport may be played by either school during CIF-SS playoff contests. Violation of this rule will result in loss of your next home playoff game. The current Official Ball list for each sport is included and available at www.cifss.org in the "Resources" drop down. This policy has been in effect since 2002.

Gatorade Only:

Only Gatorade jugs, cups, bottles, ice chests may be used or visible during any CIF-SS playoff contest. (No Powerade, Body Armor, etc). The only acceptable alternative is a plain-wrap or Igloo labeled products. This rule does not apply to the actual liquid distributed to athletes. This policy has been in effect since 1995.

CIF-SS on Souvenirs:

The 'CIF Southern Section', 'CIF-SS', 'Southern Section' and 'CIF' marks and logos are registered trademarks with the State of California. Schools may only use the CIF Southern Section marks on rings, patches and banners, by doing business with a CIF-SS licensed vendor. **Schools may only use the CIF Southern Section marks on apparel and other souvenir items exclusively through ciftshirts.com. Schools creating items with CIF-SS registered marks from a non-licensed vendor will face sanction and/or will be required to purchase any unsold shirts/items at the Championship Final.** A list of the currently licensed vendors for these products is included and regularly updated on www.cifss.org.

Please note: The use of only "CIF" is strictly prohibited per the State CIF registered trademark. The "CIF", is not just the CIF Southern Section. Only those teams in State regionals, bowl games and individual sport finals actually qualify to use CIF without Southern Section attached. Any such use must be approved in advance by the CIF State office.

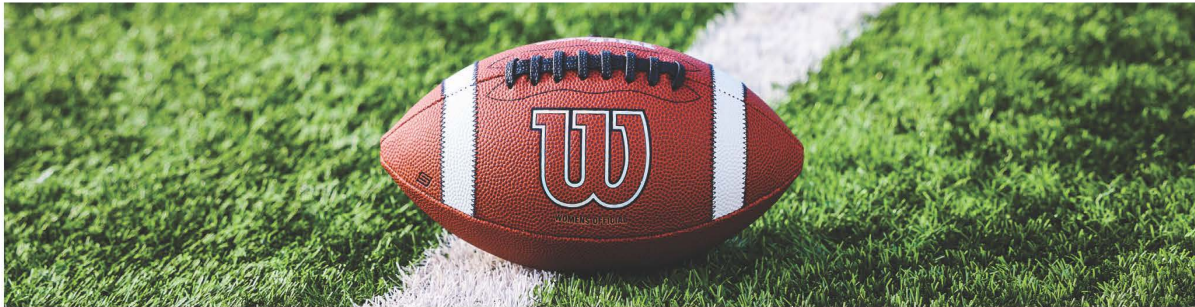
Host Site Requirements:

- Playoff Tickets:** (This pertains to revenue sports of basketball, football and volleyball): It is mandatory to sell tickets for admission to all CIF-SS playoffs and championship contests. Through the CIF-SS partnership with GoFan, all playoff tickets will be made available online for digital purchase and presented electronically at the event gate for entry. Patrons can purchase in advance via gofan.co, via private links made available by the participating schools or via QR code at the entry gate of the playoff event. All playoff revenue will be sent directly to CIF-SS. Both the host and visiting schools will be required to submit a financial/expense report following each playoff game in an effort to receive reimbursement for game expenses and revenue share split in the case of a profit game.
- CIF-SS/FORD Banner:** It is a requirement of each host school (including off-site) that the CIF-SS/Ford Championship banner be displayed at every playoff home game in football and the gymnasium sports post football season (or on the electronic signage where schools/venues do not display banners). If you need a banner please contact jackieg@cifss.org
- Gatorade:** It is a requirement of each school use only Gatorade product/jugs/cups/squeeze bottles during CIF-SS championship events. No other competitive product shall be used. Water can be placed in Gatorade merchandise.
- PA Announcements:** As a host of a CIF-SS playoff contest, the CIF-SS announcements take precedence over the host school's messaging and must be read in entirety at each playoff contest. Home schools are the host of a CIF-SS event in the playoffs. For contractual requirements, please read all the provided PA's each contest. PA's for each sport can be found on cifss.org under the designated sports page.

CUSTOM AWARDS/ RINGS/BANNERS/APPAREL SOUVENIRS USING CIF-SS:

Schools often seek to create custom patches, gym banners and championship rings that include both the school and CIF-SS marks/logos/names. Example: ‘ACME BOYS BASKETBALL 2022 CIF-SS CHAMPIONS’. Schools may create these items using CIF-SS marks only through a CIF-SS licensed vendor.

CIF-SS ‘registered’ trademark: The “CIF Southern Section”, “CIF-SS”, “Southern Section” and “CIF” marks and logos are registered trademarks with the State of California. Schools may only use the CIF Southern Section marks on rings, patches and banners by doing business with a CIF-SS licensed vendor. Schools creating items with CIF-SS registered marks from a non-licensed vendor will face sanction and/or will be required to purchase any unsold shirts/items at the Championship final if similar non-licensed items appear at the contest. A list of the currently licensed vendors for these products is included and regularly updated on www.cifss.org.

Please note: The use of only “CIF” is strictly prohibited per the State CIF registered trademarks. Only those teams in State regionals, bowl games and individual sport finals actually qualify to use CIF without Southern Section attached. Any such use must be approved in advance by the CIF State office.

CIF-SS vendors who are licensed to create custom items for schools that include CIF-SS:

Championship Patches (circle shape) Playoffs or Prelims, Finals Patches (shape of a shield) for participation in Cross Country, Track & Field or Swimming Finals, Masters Patches (oval shaped) for participation in a Masters Track & Field or Wrestling event and Wrestling Dual Meet (rectangle shaped) are sold “ON-SITE” by the CIF-SS vendor.
